PARSHA MATTERS by RABBI DIAMOND

BREAK A LEG!

While many people recognize these words as the appropriate phrase to say to someone about to perform on stage, never should these words be spoken to a Jew about to sacrifice and eat the Pesach sacrifice. In this week's Torah portion of Bo, the Torah is unequivocal about the prohibition to break any of the bones in the Korban Pesach. However, what is not so clear is the reason why not.

One explanation that resonates with contemporary relevance is offered by the great Torah scholar, the Chasam Sofer (Rabbi Moshe Schreiber). He suggests that bones symbolize the essential, bare minimum of a living organism. The skeleton constitutes the most minimal level of physical existence, even if it is bereft of excess muscle, fat and flesh. We are all too familiar with the haunting photos of concentration camp survivors who, when finally liberated, appeared to be living skeletons. But they were alive.

The Chasam Sofer explained that the miraculous Exodus from Egypt illustrates the fact that although the Jewish people may have been reduced to bare bones as a result of brutal and persistent enslavement and degradation and may have even appeared to be on the brink of complete annihilation, their bones "never broke".

Throughout history, it may have seemed that the Jewish people have come close to being destroyed and eliminated from the family of nations.

We may have suffered from the attacks, but our national bones were never broken. On the night that we observe and celebrate our redemption from the slavery of Egypt, we are instructed not to break a bone in the sacrifice because Hashem will never allow a fracture in the skeleton of the Jewish people. Am Yisrael Chai!


