# PARSHA MATTERS - by Rabbi Sam Taylor

We read the story of Moshe communicating to the Israelites, regarding the construction of the Mishkan. Rashi notes that this occurred the day after Yom Kippur, when G-d announced His forgiveness for the sin of the golden calf. The Kli Yakar insightfully notes that this is not the only event which Rashi tells of having occurred on the day after Yom Kippur that year. In Parshat Yitro, Rashi writes that it was also on this day that Yitro observed Moshe judging the people and suggested that he appoint other judges.

The Kli Yakar explains that settling financial disputes was a necessary prerequisite for the construction of the Mishkan. People would be called upon to donate large sums of materials with which to build the Mishkan, and it was therefore vitally important to ensure that all the riches in each person's possession were truly their legally owned property. The Mishkan could not possibly be built with stolen or improperly obtained goods, and therefore Moshe needed to first settle all legal disputes before the people could begin bringing materials for the Mishkan. Additionally, the Mishkan was to serve as a place where the entire nation would assemble in peaceful, harmonious devotion to G-d, a goal which could not be achieved as long as there were lingering feelings of friction and resentment. Moshe judged the people in order to create an aura of peace and harmony, so that the nation would then be worthy of G-d's presence.

The Kli Yakar's insight reminds us of the need to maintain priorities in religious life, and to address the more basic matters in our communities before striving for loftier spiritual goals. Before the Israelites could begin undertaking the exalted task of constructing a Mishkan where the divine presence would reside, they needed to first eliminate, to whatever extent possible, friction among themselves. In our lives, too, we must give priority to our basic obligation of living in peace with our fellowman. Only once an aura of goodwill prevails can we then lift ourselves to the next level of working to bring the Shechina into our midst.
