PARSHA MATTERS by RABBI ELLIOTT DIAMOND

BACK OR FORTH

When our kids were young, we enjoyed reading a book together called "Go Hang A Salami, I'm A Lasagna Hog". It's a strange name for a book, right? What may not be obvious when you first read the title is that the name is, in fact, a palindrome. What's that?

A palindrome is a word that runs both ways—literally. The original Greek meaning of the word is "running back again," from "palin" meaning "back" or "again" and "dromos", from the Greek verb meaning "to run." Don't take my word for it. Check out the title yourself to confirm it. While palindromes may be curious oddities of language, in the context of this week's Torah portion it becomes so much more.

As part of the proscribed census process, the Almighty instructed each person to give a half shekel coin. All the coins would then be counted to ascertain the necessary census information. In Hebrew the verb used in the verse is "ונתנו" which means "and they shall give" referring to the donation of each person's half shekel. It's important to notice that in the original Hebrew in the Torah the word is ונתנו

There are no coincidences in Hashem's world and the message is unmistakable. When we open our hearts and reach out to the people who need our support and help because that's the right thing to do, our efforts will be returned to us as blessings. The structure of the word contains the blessing of our giving.

Simply put, we get what we give.





One of Israel's most visible rabbinic figures, he regularly appears on Israeli television and radio, and lectures to a wide range of audiences.
