

# PARSHA MATTERS - by Rabbi Sam Taylor

The Torah says famously that after the creation of light, 'It was evening and it was then morning, the first day'. Rabbi Zev Wolf of Strikov writes that nighttime symbolises times of darkness, gloom and pain. Morning represents times of redemption and salvation, periods when we feel Hashem's kindness shining upon us. The way we transition from evening to morning, the Rebbe of Strikov writes, is through אחדות, through אחדות, unity and harmony among the Jewish People. Our enemies capitalise on our divisiveness and strife but when we transcend our differences and join together, we cannot be defeated; we can turn the thickest darkness into the most brilliant light.

When children don't get along, the parents withdraw. Parents prefer not to get involved in their children's fights, so they just step aside, and leave the children to figure it out themselves. This is true also of Hashem, our Father in heaven, and He hates to see His children fight with one another. When we do, He steps aside, and we are left alone without His assistance and protection. But when we join together, and live with harmony, helping and caring for one another, He is with us, and He brings us from the darkness of evening to the light of morning.

It must be emphasised that unity does not mean uniformity. We can be both different and unified. We do not need to do the same things or think the same way in order to attain unity. Unity means that we work together and care for one another despite our differences, that we do not allow our differences to divide us. This is what we are seeing now during our current crisis. The IDF soldiers courageously defending the Jewish State come from all different backgrounds, both political and religious, but they are unified, working closely together out of a sense of mutual commitment and a shared sense of mission. Across the Jewish world, too, Jews of all kinds have come together to show their much needed support for our brothers and sisters in Israel, and to assist in whichever ways they can. The beautiful unity we are witnessing is what will lead us from the darkness of pain and anguish to the light of redemption and joy.




## **LETTERS TO CHAYALIM - Soldiers in Israel**

**Rabbi Dr. B. Barry Levy** began teaching Bible, Hebrew, and cognate subjects at Erna Michael College of Yeshiva University in 1969 at the age of 24. He received semicha from YU in 1971, and he completed his PhD at NYU in Ancient Near-Eastern Languages in 1974 with an analysis of a unique Vatican manuscript of the Palestinian Targum, Neofiti I. As Ba'al Koreh he has memorized much of the Torah text. **Professor at McGill** University from 1975 until retirement in 2017, Levy taught more than 50 different courses in three faculties, chaired the Jewish Studies Department, was **Dean of the Religious Studies Faculty**, and **directed** the Jewish Teacher Training Program. He has lectured all over the world. Levy is the author of *Planets, Potions and Parchments,* Fixing God's Torah: The Accuracy of the Bible Text in Jewish Law and the forthcoming Jewish Masters of the Sacred Page, a History of the Miqra'ot Gedolot.
