PARSHA MATTERS - by Rabbi Jared Anstandig

MOSHE OR NOACH?

Obviously, we are in no position to evaluate and compare Biblical Heroes. Both Noach and Moshe enjoyed a deep relationship with the divine that far exceeds our wildest dreams. Nonetheless, Rabbi Meir Simcha HaKohen Dvinsk (Parashat Noach, 24) explores the differences between these two individuals and highlights an important distinction.

He notes that there are two methods of serving Hashem:

מי שמייחד עצמו לעבודתו יתברך ומתבודד One who dedicates oneself to the service of God and isolates

ויש מי שעוסק בצרכי צבור ומבטל עצמו בשביל הכלל And there is one who engages in the needs of the community and nullifies oneself for the group

One would think, the Meshech Chochma writes, that the one who isolates, who separates from the community and devotes all his or her time to God, surely would reach a higher level. Indeed, in many religions, the isolated monk represents the highest levels of piety and sanctity.

However, when we look to the Text of the Torah, we find the reverse. Moshe began his life being referred to as an " "איש מצרי," an Egyptian man" (Shemot 2:19). Over time, as Moshe worked on behalf of Bnei Yisrael, he transformed himself into an " ", איש האלוקים," a man of God" (Devarim 33:1). Noach, on the other hand, began his life as an " איש צדיק" a righteous man" (Bereshit 6:9). But, through his isolation from the world and selfish focus on himself and building his ark, ultimately reduced himself to an " איש האדמה" (Bereshit 9:20). The ideal, Meshech Chochma concludes, is to be like Moshe – to be of service to others, as opposed to oneself.

Of course, self-care is essential; one cannot pour from an empty vessel. There is an appropriate time and place for self-focus. Still, the Torah makes clear with its descriptions of Noach and Moshe that the greatest actions we can do are for the sake of others and for our community.

We are currently surrounded by initiatives that allow us to give of our time, energy, and resources, for the collective good of our community, on a local level and on a global one. May we be able to use our talents and abilities to serve others and, like Moshe, to achieve the appellation of "Men and Women of God."





Rabbi Dr. B. Barry Levy began teaching Bible, Hebrew, and cognate subjects at Erna Michael College of Yeshiva University in 1969 at the age of 24. He received semicha from YU in 1971, and he completed his PhD at NYU in Ancient Near-Eastern Languages in 1974 with an analysis of a unique Vatican manuscript of the Palestinian Targum, Neofiti 1. As Ba'al Koreh he has memorized much of the Torah text. **Professor at McGill** University from 1975 until retirement in 2017, Levy taught more than 50 different courses in three faculties, chaired the Jewish Studies Department, was Dean of the Religious Studies Faculty, and directed the Jewish Teacher Training Program. He has lectured all over the world Levy is the author of Planets, Potions and Parchments, Fixing God's Torah: The Accuracy of the Bible Text in Jewish Law and the forthcoming Jewish Masters of the Sacred Page, a History of the Migra'ot Gedolot.
