PARSHA MATTERS - by Rabbi Taylor

Malki Tzedek, who is acknowledged as the king of a Shalem and a priest, met Avraham with food and wine upon his triumphant return from battle. Malki Tzedek praised Avraham, declaring, "Blessed is Avram to the Supreme G-d, who owns heaven and earth." Numerous commentators have sought to explain why Malki Tzedek chose to describe G-d specifically as the one "who owns heaven and earth" in this context. Why did he refer to Hashem this way in his congratulatory blessing to Avraham?

Rabbi Moshe Wallner of Budapest suggests that this description speaks of the ideal of combining heaven and earth, of merging the physical and spiritual realms. Just as G-d resides in the heavens but is directly involved in all worldly affairs down to the minutest details, similarly, we are to strive to combine the realm of spirituality with mundane, worldly affairs. The Torah describes Malki Tzedek as "a priest to the Supreme God", a term which perhaps suggests a spiritual quality that keeps a person withdrawn and apart from ordinary, worldly matters. When Avraham returned from a successful military campaign, Malki Tzedek marveled at Avraham's ability to combine the spiritual and worldly realms, to live a life of lofty ideals which are practically applied to mundane pursuits. This ability was highlighted when Avraham waged a successful war. Despite being a renowned spiritual leader, Avraham took up arms and went out to battle when this was necessary to rescue innocent captives. He understood that spirituality demands not disengagement from the world's problems, but rather active involvement and efforts to help solve them. Malki Tzedek humbly acknowledged that whereas his own life of spirituality was withdrawn from worldly affairs, Avraham succeeded in achieving spiritual excellence by applying his spiritual ideals to solving real world problems. Avraham's spirituality was not a life of seclusion in a protective environment of sanctity, but rather a life of intensive engagement in world affairs, working to bring holiness to those affairs.

Therefore, Avraham was declared to be blessed to the Supreme God who owns heaven and earth. Avraham embodied the ideal of "konei shamayim vaaretz," the model set by G-d Himself of merging the heavenly and earthly realms. He teaches us that spirituality is to be applied to, and not kept away from, the real world, and is specifically intended to enhance our worldly affairs, not to isolate us from it.



Rabbi Dr. B. Barry Levy began teaching Bible, Hebrew, and cognate subjects at Erna Michael College of Yeshiva University in 1969 at the age of 24. He received semicha from YU in 1971, and he completed his PhD at NYU in Ancient Near-Eastern Languages in 1974 with an analysis of a unique Vatican manuscript of the Palestinian Targum, Neofiti I. As Ba'al Koreh he has memorized much of the Torah text. Professor at McGill University from 1975 until retirement in 2017, Levy taught more than 50 different courses in three faculties, chaired the Jewish Studies Department, was Dean of the Religious Studies Faculty, and directed the Jewish Teacher Training Program. He has lectured all over the world. Levy is the author of Planets, Potions and Parchments, Fixing God's Torah: The Accuracy of the Bible Text in Jewish Law and the forthcoming Jewish Masters of the Sacred Page, a History of the Migra'ot Gedolot.
