HALAKHIC CORNER

Q: In what language should the Haggadah be recited?
A: The Mitzvah of *Sippur Yetziat Mitzrayim* (telling over the story of the Exodus) is not just about reciting the Haggadah, but understanding what one is saying as well. The 16th Century Ashkenazik halakhic authority, the Rema, therefore writes (OC 473:6) that although the Haggadah is written in Hebrew, it should be recited in a language that everyone understands. If one wants to recite it in Hebrew, then they should explain what is being said. He then goes on to quote the Ri Me'Lunadri who would follow the practice of reciting the Haggadah in a different language so everyone could understand it. The *Mishna Brura*, authored by Rav Yisrael Meir Ha'Kohen Kagan (1839-1933) notes (473:62) that the minimum amount that one must hear/understand is Kiddush, and from "Rabban Gamliel Omer" until after we drink the second cup of wine. Rabbi Shimon Eider writes (*Halachos of Pesach*, pg. 218) that the reason why it is so important to understand the Haggadah is because *Yetziyat Mitzrayim* testifies that G-d not only created the world, but constantly supervises every aspect of it. It is therefore one of the foundations of our belief in G-d.

Shabbat HaChodesh & Rosh Chodesh Nisan

Note: Adapted for davening individually at home

- On Shabbat HaChodesh we **do not** say *Av HaRachamim* before Musaf.
- On Shabbat HaChodesh we **do say** *Tzidkatcha Tzedek* at Mincha .
- On Rosh Chodesh we don't say *Lamenatzeach* between *Ashrei Uva Le'Tzion*.
- Throughout the month of Nisan we omit *Av HaRachamim* before *Musaf*, except on Achron Shel Pesah and Shabbat Mevarchim Rosh Chodesh Iyar. We omit *Tzidkatcha Tzedek* on Shabbat Mincha throughout the month of Nisan, and we do not say *Tachanun* the entire month. We do, however, say *Lamenatzeach* between *Ashrei Uva Le'Tzion* .
