ANSWERS TO FAQ

FRIDAY NIGHT

If making early Shabbos:

- One may only light Shabbos *licht*/make Kiddush/accept Shabbos **AFTER** *plag* (6:42 PM).
- Daven Mincha before *plag*. Daven Kabalas Shabbos & Maariv after *plag*.

If making late Shabbos:

- Light at candle lighting time (7:38 PM).
- Mincha should be completed by *shkia* (sunset-7:58 PM).
- Daven Maariv after *shkia*.
- All should repeat Shema after *tzeis* (nightfall-8:58 PM).
- After Shmoneh Esrei, one may say “ויכולו”. It’s best to say it together with someone. If you have no one else to say it with, one may say it alone but should have in mind that they are not saying “testimony about ה’”, rather they are reciting *pesukim* of the Torah.
- After “ויכולו”, one must skip to “עלינו”.

SHACHARIS

- There is no requirement to read the Parsha on Shabbos, but it’s a nice thing to do.
- One should skip both paragraphs of “יקום פורקן” and the מי שברך.
- One may say ברכת החודש.
- There is no “אב הרחמים”.

MOTZA’EI SHABBOS

- One may only begin the new שנים מקרא ואחד תרגום on Motza’ei Shabbos.
