Childcare and youth services will run simultaneously, with service length based on the age of each group. Our service leaders will meet the children in their childcare rooms.

To provide the appropriate state-mandated ratios and the safety, quality care, and positive experience we all want for our children, **Prior Reservations Are Required.** **This is a safety issue in order to confirm that we have appropriate staffing.** We encourage you to register early so we can properly plan our space needs and caregivers. Please contact the OVS office with any questions. **Completed forms must be received by OVS by Monday, August 23, 2021.**

**For infants and toddlers, please bring diapers and a favorite toy.** Children will be placed in childcare rooms according to age. Parents will not be allowed into the rooms (except the infant room) during services, except when dropping off their children and then picking up their children to leave. When parents come into the classrooms, it disrupts the routines of all the children in the classroom. Please feel free to peek through the windows at any time. No food is to be brought into the rooms.

Please enter through the main entrance even if you will be dropping your children off prior to joining the adult service. For security reasons you will not be permitted to enter through the side doors. We will continue to update our Synagogue Entrance Guidelines on our website and in our weekly emails and encourage you to review them prior to coming to OVS.
