Peticha	Opening and/or Closing the Ark
Sefer Rishon	Carrying the 1st Torah
Sefer Sheni	Carrying the 2nd Torah
Sefer Shelishi - Sefer Arba Asar	Holding a Torah during Kal Nidre
Rimonim	Placing the bells on the Torah
Ets Haim	Holding the Torah while it is being undressed and dressed
Gelilah	Undressing and dressing the Torah
Hakamah	Lifting the Torah to be shown to the Congregation
Mashlim	Next to last person called to the Torah (Kaddish and Memorial Prayers are said)
Haftarah	(Kaddish and Memorial Prayers can be said)
Seganim	Standing by the Rabbi/Reader during services
Nerot Kippur	Lighting the candles prior to Kal Nidre service
Ner Tamid	Lighting of the perpetual lamp following Neila
Chatan Torah	Person called up on Simchat Torah to conclude the reading of the Five Books of Moses
Chatan Bereshit	Person called up on Simchat Torah to begin the reading of the Five Books of Moses
Ma'im Kohanim	Hand washing for Kohanim
Peticha Et Sha'are	Open ark for Cong. Blessing of prosperity for the year ahead
Yimloch Adonai	Song announcing the return of the torahs to the ark

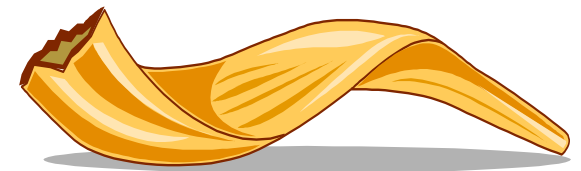
