May I eat in a room which is normally used for davening?

Halachic respect for a shul prohibits eating in spaces which are dedicated for davening. However, there are exceptions, including the following:

People who learn Torah regularly in a shul may eat in that room while learning, if leaving to eat would take time from their studies;

A *seudat mitzvah* may be held in a shul, but most authorities require that the meal not be lavish;

A community which has a great need to feed people in a shul temporarily, may do so, if they are outside of Israel;

Caretakers may eat in a shul while carrying out their duties.

Forbidden Dark Magic

Why can't we do magic? What makes it so hated that it is called an abomination? Is it so bad to wish to be like the illustrious Harry Potter or the mythical Merlin?

The great rational theologians such as Rabbi Saadia Gaon, Rambam, and Rabbi Levi ben Gershon believe that it is impossible for there ever to have been true magic, and any magic they are performing is just a trick. Rambam takes umbrage at all those pulling the wool over others eyes, leading them astray through sleight of hand. Rambam places the prohibition within the laws of idolatry, as both of these actions lead us away from G-d.

The more mystically minded amongst our sages, such as the Ramban, believe that magic is in fact theoretically possible. So then why can't we go to Hogwarts?

While G-d may have created the world with these mechanisms in place, deviating from the natural order that G-d intended is an anathema. Stealing an item instead of paying, when both are possibilities, is also termed an abomination.

When we meet problems in life we must take the proper path even if it is challenging, and not look for magical shortcuts.



Preparation for the Yamim Nora'im can be stressful in the best of times. Its early arrival this year, the start of the fourth wave and, of course, BAYT membership renewal, present a convergence of challenges we can handle. But we need your cooperation and patience. Hopefully, this update will give our members some needed clarity.

- 1. We expect to open ticketing registration early next week.
- 2. We expect to e-mail tickets on Thursday, September 2.
- 3. The office plans to be open for ticketing matters on Sunday, September 5.
- 4. We expect about 1,000 people to daven with us, similar to last year. Of that, approximately 300 members have expressed their preference to daven outside.
