PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

October 13, 2023—Bereishis

I had written my message over a week ago with the thought that following chag it would be ready for the office given that it's a short week due to the Thanksgiving Holiday. That all went out the window from Shabbos/Shmeni Azeres morning. We were all devastated by the bits of news that trickled out of Israel over Shabbos. As Shabbos ended and Simchas Torah began, it became more and more apparent that Israel had suffered an unimaginable loss. Since Yom Tov ended, we've been glued to news and family in Israel trying to make any sense of where we find ourselves.

Constantly, we think about our family and friends who have been called up for duty and the medical volunteers who are trying to get over to assist with the multitude of loss of life and injuries sustained. We try to wrap our heads around what to do next and process what has happened. We try not to share the pain with our children and grandchildren. And of course, we ask ourselveshow do we move forward. What is Hashem asking of us?

Tefillah. The Rav and I decided that we should have a Kinnus Tefillah which we had right after Yom Tov. Who would have thought that the Main Sanctuary would've been so full an hour after chag? But the community came out and we davened and sang together. Monday night, the Jewish community gathered at Mel Lastman's Square and key members of our political leadership, like Premier Doug Ford, MP Melissa Lantsman, MPP Laura Smith, Mayor Steven Del Duca and more shared our grief and promised to lead in the world arena with moral clarity, while some unbelievably danced for political gain. And we, the BAYT community, will continue to gather to build strength and daven. While we have bent, we will never break. With Hashem's help, we will prevail. We always do. In recent history, we have after the Intifadas and the Yom Kippur War.

I received some beautiful emails and texts from non-Jewish friends that have been very comforting. I share one that was sent to the BAYT:

My name is Greg Hoover and when I lived in Ontario, I owned a construction company named Aries Construction Management. Many years ago, through a structural engineer I considered a friend Mr. Oskar Zaretsky, I was introduced to and engaged by Mr. Joseph Tanenbaum to build Beth Avraham Yoseph.

During the construction I learned much about the history, customs and values of the Jewish people, and developed a great respect for your history of struggle to simply practice your religion. I am not Jewish but come from a heritage of Mennonites who were also driven out of Europe to America and then at the time of the American War of Independence relocated to Markham and Stouffville Ontario, all because of their religion.

With what has just happened I wanted to express my condolences to any one there who has lost family or loved ones in Israel from this cowardly raid by the sub-human people that live next door to the Holy Land. In my opinion they are no better than the Nazis were and deserve to be treated the same way.

I am very sorry about what has been done to you and I pray for God's help in defeating these barbarians. Stay Strong!

Unfortunately, that was not the only tragedy our community suffered. Tragedy struck Thornhill last Wednesday afternoon when 9 year-old Atara Cohen z"l of the Lubavitch community died in an accident with a delivery vehicle. Hatzolah EMTs, first on scene within two minutes, tried their best to save the little girl with an ambulance en route. Sixteen York Regional Police officers also responded.

On Thursday, YRP Inspector Ahmad Sahlia for 4th District (everything west of Bathurst Street) reached out to his old friend and our Past President Jeffrey Brown asking if YRP could do something for the family. Jeffrey and Ahmad met back in 2013 when Ahmad was a detective assigned to an investigation in our neighborhood. Jeffrey offered to take Inspector Sahlia to the shiva house. Attending shiva with Ahmad and Jeffrey were YRP Deputy Chief Paulo Da Silva from Aurora, 4th District Superintendent Graham Beverly, 2nd District (east of Bathurst including BAYT) Superintendent Ian Hill and 2 District Inspector Lindsay Newlove.

Our heartfelt gratitude to the Hatzolah volunteers, York Regional Police and York Regional Paramedics who selflessly serve our community. We send our condolences to the Cohen mishpacha. May Atara's neshama have an aliyah.

As I mentioned in my last message, I would like to recognize those that played such a meaningful role in the success of the High Holidays and today I pay tribute to our shalichei tzibbur. It is difficult to express how grateful I am to all of them for their dedication. It takes a lot of time to prepare and it showed. They were amazing. They have been painting and refreshing many of the walls around the entire building. It was great coming up the stairs from the south side into the hallway and inhaling the smell of fresh paint walking into the Main Sanctuary. They are far from done, but look around as every week more and more maintenance is constantly being done to keep the building fresh.

Outside the main entrance of the BAYT, Jesse took down the sconces, repainted them, changed the transformers and bulbs and now after all these years they work again. Vayehi Or!

A huge thank you to the other Jesse, Jesse Nathanson for his incredible dedication over the past 7 weeks for all the kiddushim. You have no idea how hard he worked. Day after day, non-stop. Just like Air Canada... five years ago.

A few people on a Security team who I thanked in the last bulletin were inadvertently missed. We thank Miriam Snowbell, Roberto Hausman, Roberta Newman and Josie Wolfson for your amazing dedication to the safety of our members! Yasher Koach.

It has been eight years since the Capital Campaign began and five years since the campaign was completed. The Capital Improvement committee comprised of David Lithwick, Jack Feintuch and David Vodianoi have done a fantastic job with all the renovations to date, but there is one more project to complete with the funds remaining and that is the actual Main Sanctuary. For many reasons, it is the mandate of the executive and board to complete the Main Sanctuary with the funds remaining as soon as possible. Last week, the board approved the budget for the renovation, which will take 6-8 weeks to complete, scheduled to begin in January as we have no smachot booked in that time period. This is all contingent on the materials being available on time to meet the tight timeline. If we cannot have the materials on time, we will delay an entire year. So, here's to hoping the vendors can meet our timeline. By completing this project, we will move on to donor boards which are long overdue and the freshening up of the Perlis. There is always much to be done at the BAYT.

Other positive news to report, we received our permit for the mikvah renovation and we were exactly at the point we needed to be in order to proceed but required the permit or the project would have come to a halt. A huge thank you to the committee Richie Idels and Gila Martow in assisting us to keep this important and exciting project on time and on budget.

In the near future, you will hear more from our Constitutional Committee as several important amendments will be put forward to the membership including reducing the size of the board from 31.

I remarked to the Rav during Parshat Ha'azinu that it is probably the least learned parsha given where it falls out. Even the Rabbis miss it for divrei Torah, because of Shabbat Shuvah and there are many more topics to discuss. And now we start from Bereishis. Of course, Bereishis is addressed during drashot but given its timing as well, it is probably the second least studied parsha following the High Holidays, Sukkos, Shmeni Azeres and Simcha Torah. It is such a rich and fascinating parsha. Studying Beresihis over the past few weeks made me wish that I lived in the middle of nowhere. That would enable me to gaze at the stars and planets and dream about the creation of the world, visualizing the world coming into being from nothingness. Now that would be a cool scene to experience on instant replay. Can you imagine a reporter trying to interview Hashem just before Shabbos starts, after creation of the world? "I tried to reach out to Hashem for a comment but G-d was unavailable for comment as he was busy dealing with the Chet of Adam and Chavah meting out their punishment. He promised he would be available after Shabbat". That was how my message was to finish, but I have to add one more thought. It is in Bereishis where after such a magnificent creation that should bewilder all of us, we are introduced to murder. As human beings, we suffer the emotional loss knowing that a loss cannot be undone. It is permanent, cemented and generations lost for eternity. As a child of a Holocaust survivor, I have witnessed the family tree grow from those who have been blessed to carry the torch from Har Sinai. The loss is profound and overwhelming. May we be comforted among the mourners of Jerusalem and Zion; May Hashem watch over and protect our precious chayalim; May Hashem protect those who have been kidnapped and May Hashem bring peace to all of Israel. Amen.

This Shabbat, our Rav will lead the kehilla with Tefillat Zahal. It is a moment you will not want to miss.


Why is it so important that the Torah begins with the creation of the world? Couldn't the Torah simply have started with the first Mitzvah?

This question is famously cited in the first Rashi on the Torah, in the name of Rabbi Yitzchak from the Yalkut Shimoni. The answer is expanded by Rashi as follows: If the nations of the world would one day say, "Israel, you are thieves for taking the land from the seven Canaanite nations!" We will in turn respond, "The earth belongs to G-d and He created it and He can give it to or take it away from whoever he sees fit."

On Shabbat/Shemini Atzeret morning Hamas terrorists crossed the border into Israel and began attacking innocent Israelis, murdering whoever they could reach, Jew and non-Jew alike. Hamas and their supporters pretend that they are reclaiming land that was 'stolen' but they are simply using that as an excuse to murder innocents. G-d decides who the land of Israel belongs to.

When we read Breishit, I had just lifted the Torah for Hagbah and was elated to begin reading the Torah anew. But as we returned the Torah to the Ark, someone came in and informed our early minyan that a war was happening down south. When I heard the first siren Shabbat morning in Israel, it was as we began to daven mussaf, before we knew the extent of the ongoing tragedy. While the faint siren wasn't even for the region of Israel we were in, we could no longer celebrate, instead we could only pray for the safety of our fellow Jews.

There are no answers to be given in war, but we must continue to support each other and Israel, just as G-d always has and always will.

IS MY TORAH THE SAME AS YOUR TORAH?

A GRAPHIC HISTORY OF AN EVOLVING TORAH TEXT

The Torah scroll has a long history of accurate transmission across thousands of years. How is it that any assembled group of 'kosher' scrolls are likely to show distinct differences in the text of Numbers 10:35-36? How could scrolls show varying designs and locations for the "inverted Nuns" (the hebrew letter 'NUN')? Sholom will present the rabbinic texts about the "inverted Nuns" and trace their development through 2500 years of scribal evolution, printing and Rabbinic discussion.


Sholom earned his Master's Degree from McGill University, focusing on the History of Jewish Interpretation of the Bible. His research focuses on the graphic representation of the "inverted Nuns" in the Torah and the literature about them. Over the last 40 years, he has collected, translated and annotated documents about the markings and has a large collection of images from libraries and synagogues around the world.
