Parking lot

Hopefully by the time this is published, the Parking Lot restoration project at a cost of \$42,000 to our members will be 100% complete, on time and on budget. Parking lot disruptions and inconveniences are virtually unavoidable especially for a building like the BAYT where daily activity is present from 6am-11pm.

Safety for our members, visitors and guests using the parking lot is our highest priority. Freshly painted lines will contribute to making our parking lot safer. There are other items to be completed hopefully before the school year begins as well. It's an ongoing collaboration between the BAYT and Eitz Chaim.

One of the main considerations in repairing the speed bumps and lines in our lot was to provide a safe environment in our large parking lot. Last year, there were a couple of close calls with children being struck. That got the leadership's attention.

Just this past Thursday, we had several incidents which reaffirm our decision to enhance our speed bumps and repaint the lines. Aron Rosenberg, (we wish him a refuah shlema for surgery last week) one of our security guards, was almost struck by a vehicle traveling at an abnormal speed. Not too long afterwards, a person on the phone also traveling at high speed passing over the speed bumps with complete disregard for all the people in the lot at the time. And then, there is my favourite of a person entering from the parking lot of Eitz Chaim, jumping the curb and onto our parking lot and going diagonally across the entire lot at high speed heading to the Clark Avenue exit, avoiding the Yorkhill/Clark light. Enclosed you will find an image of the vehicle we are trying to identify. I would like to have this person charged with Trespassing and Reckless Driving. These three incidents occurred in one day. It is one thing to hear about such occurrences, it is another to see it on video. I can assure you, that I am going to do everything in my power to stop this. It is an accident waiting to happen. Besides the speed bumps and lines, there is more to be done. We need more cameras. We need to install cameras at both gates which have licence plate identification capabilities.

We understand the speed bumps have caused our members and guests some grief last week as they were not built for low undercarriages, but the bumps have now been lowered and lengthened and we will install SLOW warning signage, but ultimately calming the traffic and preventing people from using the lot as a short cut is our highest priority.

Wishing each and everyone one of you a meaningful fast on Tisha B'Av and may the Beit Hamikdash be restored speedily in our day.

Must one who is ill fast on Tishah b'Av?

Technically, one who is ill is always exempt from fasting on Tishah b'Av. "Illness" includes fever and stomach pain, if it exceeds minor pain and the standard symptoms of fasting. However, the standard practice is to fast on Tishah b'Av even when ill, unless one feels the pain is extreme, or one is facing danger.

In a year when Tishah b'Av is pushed from Shabbat to Sunday, one who is ill may refrain from fasting, even if the pain is not extreme.

Note that an adult needs to recite Havdalah before eating; one who is only drinking water does not recite Havdalah. It is appropriate to use beer, coffee or tea for Havdalah on Tishah b'Av, rather than wine or grape juice. *Besamim* are not used. A candle is not used, unless Havdalah is performed on the night of Tishah b'Av.

Why does Parshat Devarim always fall out on the Shabbat before Tishah b'Av?

The Sages when organizing the yearly order of Parshiyot made the rules so this would occur. But why?


Midrash Eichah Rabbah (1,1) explains that three prophets who prophesied using "Eichah," 'How': Moshe, Yeshayahu and Yirmiyahu.

Moshe said 'How can I alone bear your care, burden and strife?' (Devarim 1,12 our Parsha). Yeshayahu 'How did the [faithful city of Yerushalayim] become a harlot?' (Yeshahu 1,21 our Haftarah Shabbat Chazon), and Yirmiyahu 'How does she [Yerushalayim] sit alone?' (Eichah 1,1).

Rabbi Levi in the Midrash compares this to a noblewoman who had three friends. One saw her in her tranquility, another in her debauchery, and the last in her disgrace.

But what does that mean? Each of these prophets saw Bnei Yisrael fall and stumble from a different state and in different ways.

When mourning the destruction of the Beit HaMikdash, we can't just look at it from one perspective. We need to take into account the words of each of these great prophets that they received from G-d and use them to better understand how exactly and what went wrong each time so we can learn the lessons and work towards rebuilding our future.













PROTOCOLS WHEN TISHA B'AV IS A NIDCHE (POSTPONED) TO SUNDAY

- One should daven Mincha early on Shabbos, so as to eat Shalosh Seudos after Mincha. We will have two Mincha minyanim: 2:00 PM & 6:00 PM
- One must conclude all eating before sunset (8:34PM)
- One may eat whatever foods one would normally eat at Shalosh Seudos; there is no special egg and bread this year. There is no Shalosh Seudos in shul please eat at home.
- Upon the conclusion of Shabbos (9:20 PM), one should say "Baruch HamavdillBein Kodesh L'Chol" (Blessed is He who divides between Holy and Mundane)
- One should then remove leather shoes and don non-leather shoes
- One may then drive to shul, where we will daven Maariv (followed by Eicha) at 9:40 PM
- Before Eicha, we will recite the bracha of "Borei Me'Orei HaAish" on a candle. This is the only part of Havdala that we perform this Motzei Shabbos. An abridged Havdala consisting of "Borei Pri HaGafen" and the bracha of Hamvdil is recited on Sunday evening, after the fast, without a candle or besamim. One who breaks their fast on Tisha B'Av should recite this abridged Havdala before eating.
- On Sunday night (going into the 11th of Av) haircuts, laundering and music are all allowed. Meat and wine should not be consumed until Monday morning with the exception of wine/grape juice for Sunday night Havdala
