PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Last year at this time, members were returning to shul but I vividly remember that at the beginning of Elul there was a significant increase in attendance in all minyanim. The Shabbat that really stood out in my mind, was the one where we welcomed the Rosh Yeshiva of Darchei Torah, Rabbi Eliezer Breitowitz as our scholar in residence. The energy was electric and it was a magnificent Shabbat, filled with ruach, setting the tone going into the Yamim Noraim. It is an honour to welcome Rabbi Breitowitz back to the BAYT this Shabbat and I hope you take advantage of the many opportunities he will be speaking throughout Shabbat, including the drasha in the Main Sanctuary.

Next week, we will be hosting a very special Shabbat program which has been in the works since the beginning of the year. We will be hosting for Shabbat the UJA President and CEO Adam Minsky who will be addressing our community on Shabbat morning about "Unlocking Our Collective Potential: How Orthodox Leadership is Pivotal to Our Community's Future".

Now before you all make clever remarks, I am impressed by their spouses knowing that there was an important leadership meeting for our kehilla, and they attended. So a huge thank you to the unsung heroes of the BAYT and in this case, Esther and Deena. May you continue to celebrate many more happy years together and I promise that I will not schedule an exec meeting on your anniversary next year.

Last Friday morning during renovations in the mikveh, the power was shorted which affected many places around the building on Shabbat, including bathrooms, the aron kodesh, the Mizrachi Milevsky and more. Thanks to David Lithwick and his father-in-law who restored power on Sunday and all returned to normal.

I was reminded this week of a story about David Ben-Gurion meeting John F. Kennedy in the early 1960's. President Kennedy says, "it's really hard to be president of the United States. I'm the president of 190 million citizens!" And Ben-Gurion replies, "No, it's much harder to be the prime minister of Israel. I'm the prime minister of 2.3 million prime ministers!" The facilities staff are instructed to take instructions from the office, the Rabbis and the Vice Presidents. There is a reason for this. There is always a lot going on in the Shul. The connection is strong and yet they had to move on. As I was listening to Aliyah as she tried to take deep breaths and speak, the love of the Shul was so ingrained and clear. I kept thinking that that is how I wish every member felt about the BAYT and then I know my job and Rav's would be done. I offered Rabbi Bellino to visit the BAYT and invited him to daven from the Amud. He is an excellent Ba'al Tefillah with a superb voice. One other quick note about that Shabbat. It turns out that the mohel (and doctor) was a congregant in San Diego with a young Rabbi some thirty years ago, our very own Rabbi Korobkin. We had much to speak about over Shabbat and we both enjoyed the unique atmosphere of the Sixth Street Shul.

And finally, a special Mazel Tov to Melanie and Adam Emanuel who were blessed with a boy this week!



How is it possible that Bnei Yisrael were only given "a heart to understand, eyes to see and ears to hear to this day" (Devarim 29:3) after forty years full of miracles and G -d's protection? Why didn't they realize it sooner?

Rabbeinu Bahye (13th century Spain) points to this verse as the source for the Rabbinic teaching that it can take up to forty years to fully understand what your teachers taught you.

R' Moshe Chefetz (17th century Italy) in his commentary Melekhet Machshevet explains that we cannot truly appreciate miracles while they are still happening in front of us. When we get used to supernatural occurrences, we begin to degrade by thinking they are simply part of nature and not something wondrous. After forty years of livings miraculously with G-d's help and protection we habituated ourselves to this new normal, and only when it has passed can we appreciate how awe inspiring it truly was.

It is easy to overlook the miracles around us every day, and simply attribute it to nature or the status quo. But when we recognize our reality as being directly influenced by G-d, put intentionality into our prayers and blessings, we can reach a new plane of existence of recognition of G-d.

Rabbi Menachem Gold and Rabbanim, Askanim, and friends of Rabbi Gold from his Ner Yisrael and Congregation Bnai Torah days



Rabbi Dr. Sholom Gold was a native of Williamsburg, NY, where he attended Yeshiva Torah Vodaath. He continued his learning at Yeshivas Ner Yisroel in Baltimore and at the Ponevezh Yeshiva and Chevron Yeshiva in Israel. He received his rabbinic ordination from Chief Rabbi Isaac Halevy Herzog and from HaRav Yaacov Yitzchak Ruderman, in addition to receiving a doctorate in Talmudic Letters from Ner Yisroel. In 1959 Rabbi Gold founded the Ner Yisroel Yeshiva College and Congregation B'nai Torah in Toronto. In 1971, he accepted the position as spiritual leader of Young Israel of West Hempstead. He built one of the first eruvin in North America, which quickly became a model for communities worldwide. In 1982 the Golds fulfilled their dream of making aliyah, where Rabbi Gold was the founder and Rav of Kehilat Zichron Yosef of Har Nof, Jerusalem, and founder and dean of the Avrom Silver Jerusalem College for Adults. His memoir, Touching History, is a modern classic in the history of 20th century Jewish America.




