PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Laws are Meant to be Followed

I would like to thank the hosts and speakers this past Shabbat for the final Leil Limmud of the season. Thank you to Danny Rosenberg for speaking and hosting, Sharon Fixler for speaking and Colin and Sharon Kramer for hosting, Ken Stollen for speaking at the Conservatory, Yisroel Idels for speaking at the home of Aubie and Sue Diamond, and finally Chaim Oliver for speaking at the home of Yoni and Eli Colman. Yishar Koach to all and I truly hope that the kehilla enjoyed an evening of divrei Torah and socializing. The Leil Limmud is a wonderful program started by Rabbi Scot Berman many years ago and we appreciate Elaine Genesove and Mark Mark Mietkiewicz for continuing to organize this amazing BAYT event.

Last week, kein ayin hora, we had four smachot on Shabbat. Two Bat Mitzvahs and two Bar Mitzvahs. That was beautiful! Smachot are beautiful, even if the announcements are longer. That did not include all the other Mazel Tov's, births and engagements, vorts and upcoming weddings. 

Adam S. Ferziger is professor in the Israel and Golda Koschitzky Department of Jewish History and Contemporary Jewry at Bar-Ilan University and holds the Rabbi S.R. Hirsch Chair for Research on the Torah and Derekh Erez Movement. He is a senior associate at the Oxford Centre for Hebrew and Jewish Studies, University of Oxford and co-convener of the annual Oxford Summer Institute on Modern and Contemporary Judaism. His research focuses on the history of religious responses to modern and contemporary life in Western Europe, North American, and Israel.

He is the author or editor of seven books, including Exclusion and Hierarchy (University of Pennsylvania Press, 2005), Jewish Denominations (Melton Institute – The Hebrew University of Jerusalem, 2012), and his monograph, Beyond Sectarianism (Wayne State University Press, 2015), was the winner of the National Jewish Book Award.

In parallel to his academic career, Adam Ferziger was a congregational rabbi in Kfar-Sava, and has dedicated over thirty years to performing weddings and providing religious services to a wide spectrum of Israeli Jews in a meaningful and nonjudgmental manner.

The Talmud says that as part of the Purim feast, one must "levasumei" until he does not know the difference between "Cursed is Haman" and "Blessed is Mordechai". In various contexts, the word "levasumei" means to become sweet or joyous. Some halachic authorities ruled against this statement, but Rambam codified it, saying to drink wine to the point where one becomes shikor (a word with a spectrum of meanings) and falls asleep. This is also brought in the Shulchan Aruch.

However, halachic authorities prohibit any drinking which a) is dangerous for the drinker or others, or b) leads to a state in which one loses control to the point of trespassing Halachah and/or desecrating Hashem's Name. Rambam himself equates people who gather in order to become intoxicated with people who gather unclothed and soil themselves in public. More recently, Rav Chaim Margaliyot wrote, "One should eat, drink and be happy on the holiday, but not draw himself after meat and wine and laughter and lightheadedness, for laughter and lightheadedness are not joy, but empty celebration and foolishness. We are not instructed in empty celebration and foolishness, but in joy which includes service of the Creator."

A moderate path, approved by the Rama and Mishneh Berurah, is to drink minimally at the Purim Seudah, and then fulfill the state of intoxication by taking a nap after the meal.

Worth noting: Adults in the presence of young children should be extremely careful in drinking more heavily than is normal. Immature children cannot differentiate between when adults are in control and when they are not, cannot comprehend the dangers associated with alcohol, cannot accept the idea that adults can do what children are not permitted to do, and cannot understand the difference between Purim and the rest of the year.

After the religiously uplifting and awe-inspiring revelation at Har Sinai why does the Torah quickly transition to laws relating to property and damages? Why wait more than 70 verses before returning to holidays where we connect to G-d?

Ramban explains that these laws correspond to the tenth of the Ten Commandments, Lo Tachmod, "you shall not covet" so we can realize what is ours versus that which belongs to our friends and neighbours.

Continuing down this path, Ramban quotes a Midrash that all of the Torah hangs on Mishpat, on laws. Namely, our ability to properly observe laws of commerce and contract, even if at first they seem mundane.

Part of receiving the Torah is accepting the rules and responsibilities that come along with it. We can't simply take the spirituality without understanding the holistic effect it should have on us and every aspect of our lives. Connecting to G-d through the Torah should illuminate every facet of our lives and society, no matter where we stand.
