INTRODUCTION TO THE LAWS OF SHEMA BY

Why Do We Read the Third Passage of the Shema?

The Shema is composed of three passages. The first two include references to speaking about the mitzvot, which is the biblical basis for the mitzvah of reciting the Shema. Presumably, this is why they are recited. The third passage is primarily about the mitzvah of tzitzit and doesn't include such a reference. In that case, why is it part of the Shema?

Some authorities take the view that reciting the third passage is only a rabbinic requirement. The Talmud indicates that the Sages instituted this recitation. They chose this passage because aside from reminding us about all the other mitzvot, it also includes tzitzit and warns us not to entertain heretical, licentious, or idolatrous thoughts. In addition, this passage is used to fulfill the unrelated mitzvah of remembering the Exodus from Egypt every day and night.

Other authorities hold that reciting the third passage is a biblical requirement. According to Rabbi Yosef Dov Soloveitchik, this is because accepting G-d as our sovereign ruler is a fundamental goal of the Shema. This is only possible if we recognize the basis for G-d's claim on us, that He redeemed us from slavery in Egypt. According to this view, remembering the Exodus from Egypt is intrinsically linked to the mitzvah of reciting the Shema.

Why should we keep Kosher? Why do the details of Kashrut appear immediately after the commandment not to hurt ourselves or shave our heads in mourning? Rabbi Dovid Zvi Hoffman explains based on the first words of this section "Banim Atem La-HaShem Elokeichem", you are children to HaShem your G-d" we were warned on the one hand not to harm the body, and on the other hand not to defile ourselves by consuming forbidden foods. Kashrut isn't simply to distinguish us from those around us as an ascetic practice like the priest caste of many societies and cultures. Rather, the Torah ascribes to the forbidden foods an effect on man, which endangers his holiness and purity. Israel's role is to be a Mamlechet Kohanim viGoy Kadosh, kingdom of priests and holy nation. In order for them to always be worthy of fulfilling this role and to avoid any interference with the fulfillment of this role, Israel was only allowed to eat certain foods, which were permitted by the scriptures.

We are all given the opportunity when we eat to not only fill our stomachs but to follow G-d's directions as His children. Every meal can fulfill a mission of G-d and bring us together as His children, Kosher and as brethren, kaasher Tziva HaShem, as G-d commanded.

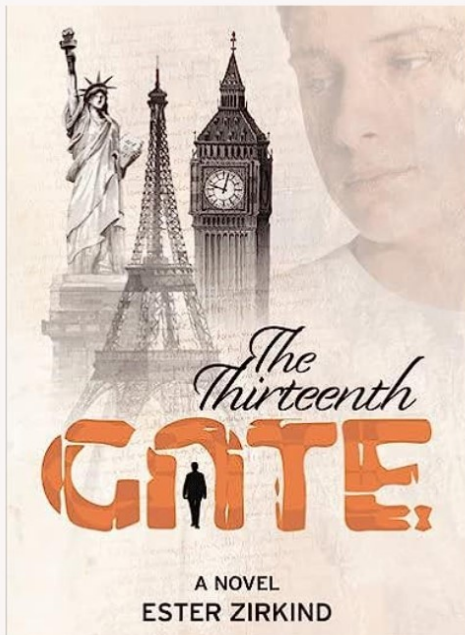

Rabbi Dr. Sholom Gold was a native of Williamsburg, NY, where he attended Yeshiva Torah Vodaath. He continued his learning at Yeshivas Ner Yisroel in Baltimore and at the Ponevezh Yeshiva and Chevron Yeshiva in Israel. He received his rabbinic ordination from Chief Rabbi Isaac Halevy Herzog and from HaRav Yaacov Yitzchak Ruderman, in addition to receiving a doctorate in Talmudic Letters from Ner Yisroel. In 1959 Rabbi Gold founded the Ner Yisroel Yeshiva College and Congregation B'nai Torah in Toronto. In 1971, he accepted the position as spiritual leader of Young Israel of West Hempstead. He built one of the first eruvim in North America, which quickly became a model for communities worldwide. In 1982 the Golds fulfilled their dream of making aliyah, where Rabbi Gold was the founder and Rav of Kehilat Zichron Yosef of Har No'f, Jerusalem, and founder and dean of the Avrom Silver Jerusalem College for Adults. His memoir, Touching History, is a modern classic in the history of 20th century Jewish America.
