#### PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

#### **The Deep Meaning of Terumah**

Having been away, and coming off a long weekend, I was not planning on writing a message this week. But after our office meeting this week, I came away motivated to share some thoughts as we enter into Adar and Nissan.

We were discussing whether or not to sell hand shmura matzah out of the BAYT when this year's price was disclosed. I truly almost lost my lunch. I could not believe my ears. And my first thought was how could hand shmura matzah become so expensive. We know that the factory in Montreal had a fire a few years ago and their capacity was greatly diminished, but I would have thought that the lost capacity would have been restored by now, but apparently not. While I don't know the exact details, I think it is my obligation to warn our community that hugely inflated (rightly or wrongly) prices are about to be unleashed on the observant community. And we have been feeling the price pressures way before this. All food products have been steadily climbing for past two years with no end in sight, but this Pesach may be the most financial pressure we will feel in my lifetime. Can it get worse? I thought that last year.

It is difficult to address this, as we are about to celebrate Purim in just over a week's time and every year, we want to make Purim the most enjoyable holiday of the year, but I feel that I have to warn the community that we should begin our shopping very early and get guidance from our Rav on where we will be able to save money (i.e. what needs a Pesach hechsher and doesn't). Maybe BAYT members should consider a drive down to Buffalo if prices there are significantly less. I know the Rav is working on getting less expensive hand shmura matzah and he will broadcast that as soon as he has confirmation.

Keeping kosher should not be a financial burden. Not long after I became President, I was at a shiva house and one of the visitors asked me what I was doing about keeping the kosher prices down. I didn't realize it was a function of the BAYT President, but I did realize that some people do hope the leadership will help with kashrut pricing.

In the meantime, no better parsha to share a thought about this matter than with this week's Terumah. The Torah opens with a double lashon of "Hashem spoke to Moshe..." and "Speak to the Children of Israel and let them take for Me a donation, from every man whose heart motivates him you shall take My donation." The Or HaChaim says that Moshe was to speak to Children of Israel to collect donations (three) for the Mishkan using the word daber, this language as an expression of taking leadership and authority.

There is the first Terumah of the communal offerings in the Beit HaMikdash which were funded by the annual contribution of the Biblical half a shekel. No matter how much or little one earns, all are expected to give equally. The contribution had to be made each year before the end of the month of Adar. Beginning on the 25th of Adar, the courts would seize collateral from those who had failed to donate by that time. The second Terumah of a half shekel which contributed towards the sockets of the Mishkan.

Then there is the third Terumah which has no set amount, but an amount which is a voluntary donation motivated by the heart.

Why does Hashem say to Moshe "and let them take for Me"? Hashem clearly does not need our Terumah. I think Hashem is trying to motivate us, to give from our hearts. Look around us and see how truly fortunate we are with all the blessings that Hashem bestows upon us. We are always trying to emulate Hashem, by being compassionate and being motivated by our heart. To give what we can afford. And in fact, if we are not motivated by our heart to give, we should not be making a contribution at all. I am appealing to our community to contribute generously for the mitzvah of Matanot l'Evyonim for Purim and Maot Chittim for Pesach from the heart.

This past weekend is an excellent example of doing a mitzvah and not having to cost any money. Maybe that is one of the greatest mitzvah's we can do. Giving the gift of life and feeding those who look over our safety. I can't think of a better Terumah.

Thank you to all the people who participated in the BAYT Blood Donor Clinic in memory of Batsheva Yeres a"h. Big thank you to Esty Yeres and Dr. Jack Lefkowitz for organizing this important mitzvah. Over 75 units of blood were donated.

We had a wonderful time bringing dinner to the fire station on Family Day. It was a great feeling to thank the men and women who put their lives on the line everyday to keep us safe. Special thank you to Lindsay Kochman for organizing this very important event. I know the fire crew were very appreciative. Also, the fire staff were constantly reminding us to check our smoke detectors in our homes and ensure that they are working working properly. Great piece of advice and I urge our membership this weekend to test the fire detectors on both floors with your children present.

Finally, this past Motzei Shabbat, the BAYT hosted the annual Avot u'Banim for the entire community which was attended by over 1,200 fathers and sons. Yasher Koach!



May I fulfill matanot la'evyonim and mishloach manot by sending them in advance?

Matanot la'evyonim: Because matanot la'evyonim are meant to pay for Purim needs, some authorities say they should be received on Purim, lest the money be spent in advance. Also, some contend that the gift is meant to recall the events of the original Purim, and therefore it should be received on Purim itself. However, most authorities rule that one may deliver matanot la'evyonim in advance, thus ensuring that indigent people will have the means to arrange a Purim feast. One certainly may send the money to a distribution agent in advance, for distribution on Purim day.

One who cannot find needy people on Purim may designate matanot la'evyonim and hold the money until the opportunity arises to give it to an appropriate recipient.

Mishloach manot: Some authorities understand that the purpose of this mitzvah is to increase our goodwill toward each other on Purim itself. Therefore, mishloach manot should be sent, or at least received, on Purim itself.

Why does G-d need to give such exact details for the Mishkan? Why not give more artistic and religious freedom to worship?

The construction of a physical structure to serve G-d is in and of itself surprising, considering the fact that the Second of the Ten Commandments warns against making idols or physical images to serve G-d. The abundance of information and specificity about the Mishkan, its shape and its utensils, indicate G-d limiting our options while simultaneously giving us the added physical support to properly serve G-d.

But then why do we need a physical space to serve G-d if it is so problematic?

Rabbi Don Yitzchak Abarbanel explains that the divine intent behind the physical construction of the Mishkan is to combat the idea G-d forsook the earth, that His throne was remote from humanity in heaven. Now that G-d commanded Bnei Yisrael to physically make a dwelling in the form of the Mishkan, there is no doubt that G-d dwells amongst them and is ever present.






