**Why does a woman need to bring korbanot, offerings, after giving birth?**

The Sefer haChinuch points out that the purpose of bringing the offering isn't because of having done something wrong that needs atoning for, rather it is an opportunity given by G-d. ## BAYT COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

*BAYT's COVID-19 Protocols incorporate Health Canada and Province of Ontario guidelines by reference.*

### Signing Up for a Minyan at BAYT

Members wishing to attend a minyan at BAYT should sign up in advance via SignUp Genius. Minyanim are open to members only. Please only sign up people from your household. When you sign up to attend a minyan at BAYT, you expressly agree to strictly follow BAYT's COVID-19 protocols without exception. Other shuls' protocols are not relevant to your decision to attend a minyan at BAYT. Please cancel your sign up and do not attend minyan if you are unable to attend for whatever reason.

### While Attending a Minyan at BAYT

- Wear a face covering such as a non-medical mask (see below).
- Do not congregate with others during or after davening. Come to BAYT to daven and please leave quietly. The serving of any food or beverages (e.g., Kiddush Clubs) is not allowed at this time.
- Do not crowd when leaving BAYT. Please leave the building single file and socially distanced 2 metres apart. Once outside BAYT, please walk away from the doors so others can leave quickly and safely.
- Avoid touching doors and door handles. Doors through which you need to pass are open. Please do not touch the doors, as you may cause them to close. If a door is closed, please let the facilities staff know.
- Sit in designated seating. In the main shul, sit only in seats marked with green tape on back of the seat. Please do not sit alone in a group of green taped seats. Do not move chairs around in other minyanim.

### When Not To Sign Up for or Attend a Minyan at BAYT

1. You or a "close contact" are awaiting a COVID test result;
2. you were in "close contact" with someone who tested positive for, or who has any symptoms of COVID-19;
3. you were in "close contact" with anyone in self-isolation (even if asymptomatic) including anyone in your household. This includes children in self-isolation due to a COVID-19 case in school or a carpool;
4. you have been outside of Canada within the past 14 days;
5. you were around others (e.g., workplace, other minyan or gathering) and did not practice proper social distancing and/or masking, even once, within the past 14 days; or
6. you feel unwell or have any acute illness, even if you or your doctor do not believe you have COVID-19.

### "Close Contacts" Include

1. Someone with whom you have been within 2 metres for more than 10 minutes;
2. Someone who lives in your household or provides care to you;
3. Someone with whom you have had close physical contact including a handshake; or
4. Someone who accidentally coughed, sneezed or spit on you while talking with you.

If you or a "close contact" have any common symptoms of COVID-19, please get a COVID test, STAY HOME, self-isolate and advise "close contacts" with whom you were in close physical contact with in the prior 48 hours to monitor their health and to self isolate. Do not sign up for a minyan.

### Face Coverings (Such as Non-Medical Masks)

The Province of Ontario Emergency Order requires the use of "a face covering (non-medical mask, such as a cloth mask) in public indoor spaces and whenever physical distancing is a challenge." with limited exception. Upon entry into and while inside BAYT everyone should wear a face covering such as a non-medical mask, including the ba'al tefillah (who leads prayers) and ba'al korei (who laysns from the sefer Torah).

Health Canada advises that a "non-medical mask or face covering" should:

- fit securely to the head with ties or ear loops;
- maintain its shape after washing and drying;
- be made of at least two layers of tightly woven material (such as cotton or linen); and
- be large enough to cover the nose and mouth completely and comfortably without gaping.

# ANNOUNCEMENTS

Any type of plastic face shield or mouth/nose covering by itself does not replace a face covering or mask because it does not completely cover the nose, mouth and chin with a barrier that prevents spread of respiratory droplets. If you choose to wear either a plastic face shield or mouth/nose covering, you also need to wear a mask made of at least two layers of tightly woven material large enough to completely cover your nose and mouth without gaping.

The sole purpose of BAYT's COVID-19 Protocols is to keep our members and guests as safe as possible while at BAYT. Accordingly, BAYT cannot permit exceptions to our COVID-19 Protocols including our masking requirements.

## **Family and Guests Returning to or Entering Canada (even if partially or fully vaccinated)**

Travellers returning to Canada must quarantine for 14 days whether arriving by air or road, whether they have been vaccinated, had a COVID infection or a negative COVID test result. Canada Border Services Agency (CBSA) advises all travellers upon entry to Canada that they must completely isolate during their 14-day quarantine period from anybody else in their household. If complete isolation is not possible, they are advised that other household members must also quarantine for the entire 14 days.

If you have anyone in your household returning to or entering Canada from abroad who are or will be in mandatory 14-day self-isolation, please do not sign up for or attend a minyan at BAYT unless they are completely isolated from the rest of your household for the entirety of the 14 days quarantine period. This applies even if he/she has been vaccinated, had a COVID infection or a negative COVID test.

## **Common Symptoms of COVID-19 Per the Ontario Ministry of Health**

- fever (feeling hot to the touch, a temperature of 37.8 degrees Celsius or higher) or chills
- cough that's new or worsening (continuous, more than usual)
- barking cough, making a whistling noise when breathing (croup)
- shortness of breath (out of breath, unable to breathe deeply)
- sore throat, difficulty swallowing
- runny, stuffy, or congested nose (not related to seasonal allergies or other known causes or conditions)
- lost sense of taste or smell
- pink eye (conjunctivitis)
- headache that is unusual or long lasting
- digestive issues (nausea/vomiting, diarrhea, stomach pain)
- muscle aches
- extreme tiredness that is unusual (fatigue, lack of energy)
- falling down often
- for young children and infants: sluggishness or lack of appetite.

If you really have to think about it, you should stay home.

## **Report Illness and Positive COVID Test Results to BAYT Immediately**

If you attended a minyan at BAYT, please let us know immediately if you receive a positive COVID-19 test result or if you have symptoms of COVID-19 and are awaiting a test result. BAYT will notify York Public Health of positive COVID cases brought to our attention. Two or more positive COVID test results among attendees of one minyan at BAYT can result in declaration of a legal "outbreak" by York Region Health mandating ALL persons who were in attendance self-isolate for 14 days, even those who practiced proper social distancing and masking.

## PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

This week's double parsha on tzara'at, or leprosy, of things and stuff may not be inspiring or informative to many of us. But with COVID, maybe this year is different. Perhaps Tazria/Metzora can remind us of the consequences when things go awry within Klal Israel.

Earlier this week, Rabbi Korobkin co-authored a message urging our Kehillah to stay together as the pandemic continues, particularly with regard to our schools. Whether religious or political, the "fissures" the Rav wrote of are real. The consequences of those fissures could have devastating short-term and longer-term impact. Chronic illness. Loss of a loved one. And neighbours who refuse to speak with one another because they disagreed over COVID. This is why I worry more about the physical and spiritual health of our kehillah than I do about our finances. The Crisis campaign demonstrated you will step up to support BAYT.

COVID has the potential to strike any of us or destroy all of us, particularly at BAYT where we come from many diverse backgrounds and hashkafot. When we physically gather at BAYT, we may also unknowingly bring along our workplaces and our children's schools. While each may have COVID protocols more or less stringent than BAYT, public health authorities view our protocols as "exemplary." To the best of our knowledge, no one has, and no one should ever contract COVID at BAYT. B'li ayin hara.

Israel seemingly has COVID under control, more due to mass vaccination than compliance with public health orders. Here in Canada, we do not yet have that luxury. Until we get more shots into more arms, only you and I can prevent COVID from morphing into a modern day tzara'at. While our protocols allow us to hold minyanim in the midst of a pandemic, they should not tear us apart from one another or from our neighbors. We all feel the pain of the fissures within our kehillah. We should also consider the potential for friction with our neighbors. How would they respond to you and me, visibly observant Jews, if BAYT itself were to be identified as a COVID hot spot?

Last Wednesday evening, we awaited clarification whether houses of worship would remain open during the enhanced shut down. The first provincial announcement was unclear and York Region initially announced no. I had thought to myself we could use the pause; keeping our BAYT open is stressful. But on the other hand, I too am one of those who counts on a daily minyan. By 10PM, we learned we could remain open.

Roll forward, Friday morning April 16. One of the provincial public health leaders messaged me that BAYT's updated COVID guidance is 'terrific' but cautioned L4J is 'the VOC capital of York Region.' Once again, we await further word from Premier Ford. Stay tuned.

Among other things, I know how some of you feel about our COVID protocols (or in the eyes of some MY COVID protocols). And I know how you feel when we, er, I make a mistake, protocol related or not. No one suggested the Presidency would be a pre-game warm up for a popularity contest. But no one hinted, like Tazria/Metzora, this role would uncover volumes of invaluable, albeit not always pleasant, lessons learned. Perhaps these lessons will have made it all worth it once we collectively defeat COVID. Until then, please hang in there with an extra sense of vigilance.

### May one play shuffleboard on Shabbat?

First: There is a general question as to whether and when sports are an appropriate Shabbat activity for adults, but that is beyond the scope of this paragraph. However, even where sports are acceptable, shuffleboard raises a particular question as do bowling, marbles and all games involving rolling or sliding an object along a flat surface.

One who intentionally levels a dirt surface on Shabbat violates a biblical prohibition against either construction (indoors) or plowing (outside). Therefore, on Shabbat one may not play a game which involves rolling or sliding an object along a dirt surface, lest one intentionally even out the surface.

Of course, contemporary shuffleboard is played on a paved surface. However, onlookers who see someone playing a game on a paved surface may not realize that it is only permitted because of the pavement, and may assume that it is permitted on all surfaces. Therefore, playing such games on an outdoor paved surface is also prohibited. Some halachic authorities do permit playing such games on a paved, indoor surface, though; for practical questions, please consult the Rav.

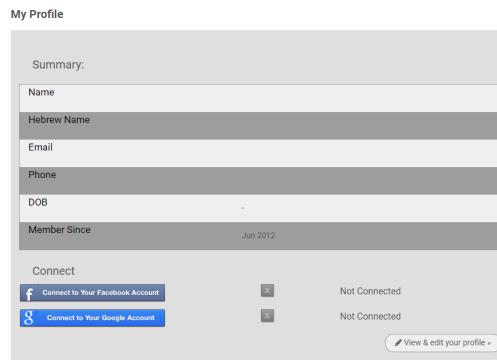
