PRESIDENT MESSAGE:

Some things are not worth arguing about. We all know the world is round, like a meatball (remember that Loonie Toons cartoon?). But even given uncontroverted facts, you and I may see things different. No, the world is flat like a pizza! Bruins/Leafs. Conservative/Liberal. Republican/Democrat. Within our shul, we have varied views on about everything.

Society used to celebrate our differences. Late US Supreme Court Justices Antonin Scalia (conservative, Catholic) and Ruth Bader Ginsburg z'l (liberal, Jewish) were close, respectful friends off the bench even though their legal opinions were polar opposite one another. The late Democratic Speaker of the House, Tip O'Neill, would enjoy a post-adjournment cocktail with about any willing Republican or conservative Democrat. Not so much anymore.

Rabbi Lord Jonathan Sacks z'l wrote on Parshat Emor, "People looked up to as role-models must act as role-models. If clothing is labelled 100% wool, am I obligated to have it checked for shaatnez?

The Shulchan Aruch (Yoreh Deah 302:2) addresses a case in which a merchant informs a customer that a wool garment is not stitched with linen. The Shulchan Aruch rules that even if the merchant doesn't realize that this is a meaningful issue for the customer, one may not rely on the merchant's words. Also, in our own day, Rabbi Yirmiyahu Kaganoff (http://rabbikaganoff.com/when-is-it-not-shatnez/) points out that even an accurate label "does not tell anything about the button-threads, backing, linings, ornaments, loops and fillings."

Due to both of these concerns, halachic authorities rule that one must check clothing if a significant minority of that type of clothing is shaatnez. Rabbi Moshe Feinstein notes that our practice is to check even if only a small minority of that type of clothing is shaatnez. Determining what percentage of a particular type of clothing is apt to be shaatnez requires practical knowledge of the field, and is beyond the scope of this article.

Halachic authorities disagree regarding trying on clothing in a store, where there is a significant possibility that the clothing may be shaatnez.

Why did the son of Shlomit bat Divri of the tribe of Dancurse G-d? (Vayikra 24:10)

People don't simply on a whim start cursing and blaspheming. But what set him off?

In the Midrash Vayikra Rabbah 32:3 (quoted by Rashi) there are two explanations:

Rabbi Berachya (Amoraic sage from Israel) explains that he was unable to understand how we could serve the twelve Lechem HaPanim (showbreads) described in our Parsha to G-d if it has been sitting out for more than a week before being consumed. Shouldn't we offer G-d fresh bread?

Rabbi Chiya says that his anger arose when he tried to camp amongst the tribe of Dan but was rejected and then lost in court because his father was an Egyptian, and spots in the camp followed the father, not the mother.

Both versions give a reason for anger or confusion about how G-d runs the world, but it is important to properly deal with said anger not simply turn around and curse G-d. Often the world around us is seemingly incomprehensible, we must calmly seek the answers to better understand G-d, wherever that may take us.






