President's Message:

There is much to reflect on now that Elul, Rosh Hashanah, and Yom Kippur are behind us. Elul feels so long ago now, but I never had an opportunity to share some thoughts on our Shabbaton with UJA. I am very grateful to Adam Minsky, Daniel Held, Daniel Ages and Susan Jackson for sharing their personal time with us. Much was discussed with more to digest, but if I could emphasize one major issue for the BAYT community, it is the Orthodox leadership in Federation and specifically education. Our schools are the recipients of over \$15 million a year. It is critical that we have a voice in how the money is distributed, but more importantly ensure that it continues. It is amazing to me that UJA Toronto is the only Federation in the world that supports Jewish education. It is not a guarantee that this will continue forever and that is why someone from the BAYT community should roll up their sleeves and get involved. If you would like to get involved, please be in touch with the Rav or myself.

Adam told an amazing story about Barry Sherman z"l who was open about being an atheist, but a supporter of Jewish education. Adam asked Barry, "Why?". Barry believed that his generous predecessors had decided long before he got there that Jewish education was an important priority to the leadership and far be it from him to challenge their wisdom. That says a lot about Barry and Honey, may they rest in peace. We received a beautiful note from Adam and I wanted to share it with you:

"I am very grateful to you (the Rav) and to Craig for your leadership in creating a special UJA Shabbat at the BAYT. You offered us an exceptional opportunity to share our message with your congregation. The thoughtfulness with which you organized our Shabbat together, the warmth with which we were welcomed and the kindness you both showed us are really appreciated. In particular, both of your remarks emphasizing the importance of supporting our collective efforts to strengthen our community were exceptionally important for us. You told me that I would have "the BAYT Shabbat experience". What a meaningful experience it was!"

With Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur behind us, and as we look forward to Sukkos, I have to take this opportunity to thank quite a few people who have been so instrumental in the success of the Yamin Noraim. 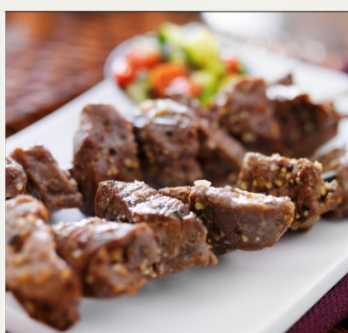

IS MY TORAH THE SAME AS YOUR TORAH?

A GRAPHIC HISTORY OF AN EVOLVING TORAH TEXT

with Sholom Eisenstat

The Torah scroll has a long history of accurate transmission across thousands of years. How is it that any assembled group of 'kosher' scrolls are likely to show distinct differences in the text of Numbers 10:35-36? How could scrolls show varying designs and locations for the "inverted Nuns" (the Hebrew letter 'NUN')? Sholom will present the rabbinic texts about the "inverted Nuns" and trace their development through 2500 years of scribal evolution, printing and Rabbinic discussion.

Sholom earned his Master's Degree from McGill University, focusing on the History of Jewish Interpretation of the Bible. His research focuses on the graphic representation of the "inverted Nuns" in the Torah and the literature about them. Over the last 40 years, he has collected, translated and annotated documents about the markings and has a large collection of images from libraries and synagogues around the world.

When Entering and Exiting BAYT

- ◆ Please cooperate with the instructions and requests of Safety Team volunteers, security guards and police.
- ◆ BAYT is private property. All persons and their belongings are subject to search upon entry to BAYT property. Entry can be denied if consent is not provided. Have your belongings open for search by the time you get to the doors.
- ◆ Have your High Holiday admission ticket displayed for entry. Proceed ONLY to the minyan for which you signed up.
- ◆ Only enter and exit through the designated doors where volunteers or Security personnel are stationed. All emergency exits are alarmed and will signal Vaughan Fire Department.
- ◆ Avoid congregating in and around the shul.
- ◆ Don't distract Safety Team volunteers, BAYT employees, security guards and police from focusing on our collective safety and security.
- ◆ Safely greet unfamiliar guests and offer your assistance.
- ◆ If you see something, say something. Remain aware of your surroundings.
- ◆ Report suspicious persons, bags or parcels to a Safety Team volunteer, facility crew member, security guard or BAYT Executive member. Do not open unattended bags.
- ◆ Weapons of any kind, whether licensed or not, are prohibited at all times. Police will be summoned if anyone is found to have a weapon.

In and Around BAYT

- ◆ Report suspicious persons or vehicles to a Safety Team volunteer, facility crew member, security guard or BAYT Executive member. Try to remember license plates, descriptions, location, description of driver, make and model, colour, etc.

In the Event of a Physical Threat or Attack

- ◆ BAYT has procedures in place that have been coordinated with York Regional Police. Alert Safety Team volunteers or guard. Failing which call 911.
- ◆ Follow instructions of Safety Team volunteers & facilities crew, security guards or police.
- ◆ If instructed to evacuate BAYT do so immediately – DO NOT look for family members OR take personal belongings.
- ◆ Move as fast as possible to Designated Safe Area along perimeter fence of Parking Lot or where instructed. DO NOT block Fire Lanes around BAYT.
- ◆ Do not pull a fire alarm in the event of a threat or attack.

In the Event of a Fire Alarm

- ◆ Follow posted emergency evacuation procedures.
- ◆ Be aware of the closest fire exits and exit routes.
- ◆ Children in youth programs will be evacuated by youth leaders.
- ◆ Do not congregate near the entry doors or Block fire lanes. Evacuate to Safe Evacuation areas along perimeter fence of the parking lot.
- ◆ Do not re-enter BAYT until given the all clear by BAYT leadership.

In the Event of a Medical Emergency

- ◆ Notify a gabbai or Safety Team volunteer. Each minyan has designated physicians and some EMTs and Certified First Aid Responders.
- ◆ Procedures are in place to call and direct first responders and access BAYT medical equipment.
- ◆ Stand back. Allow first responders to treat the patient.
- ◆ Keep hallways and access points clear.
