

Bat Mitzvah Program Expectations

We are certain that your desire to participate in the BAYT Bat Mitzvah program is an indication of your understanding of its importance to the development of your Bat Mitzvah. We have an expectation that each Bat Mitzvah will actively take part in each area of the program with the utmost Derech Eretz. The following procedures have been put in place to serve as reminders of our expectations and to clearly define the consequences involved if the expectations are not met.

- Participants are expected to arrive and be picked up on time. Session leaders are not responsible to wait with your child if her ride is late.
- The Bat Mitzvah are expected to act with proper Derech Eretz towards the Rav, teacher, or session leader, as well as to each other. If a Bat Mitzvah does not show the proper respect to the program, or leader of the program, her parents will be contacted and asked to pick up the participant early, and she will forfeit her opportunity to attend the following session. If this occurs more than once, this participant may be asked not to return to the program.
- Cell phones must be put away out of view before each class begins.
- Sessions are generally held on Shul property. Classrooms will be left in good conditions at the end of each session. Participants will treat Shul property with the respect it deserves.
- Participants will stay only in areas where classes are held, and not congregate in other areas of the Shul.
- Participants are expected to remain in the classrooms for the complete session and actively take part in all areas of the program.
