PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Nitzavim-Vayeilech

Last Shabbat was so electric with our Scholar-In-Residence, Rabbi Breitowitz, the Rosh Yeshiva of Darchei Torah. Thank you to everyone who supported the congregational klddush and shalosh seudos. We look forward to welcoming the Rosh Yeshiva again next year.

Best of luck to all the children and grandchildren who began school and university this week. The BAYT was exceptionally alive with much activity on Tuesday, the first day of school, as Bais Yaakov Thornhill began their first day on our third floor. A huge thank you to Jesse Armogida and David Lithwick for all their hard work preparing the school in time and simultaneously working on the mikvah

renovation. I'm told that traffic was quite busy the first day, but we are confident that it will sort itself out after a few days of school.

As you can see, the Eitz Chaim/Kollel renovation is in preparation mode as a fence was erected late last week. The access path through the condo housing project to the BAYT unfortunately had to be closed as the fencing blocks the pathway for safety and security purposes. Please note that for the duration of the construction the path will be closed and will be reopened upon its completion.

This Sunday afternoon, the BAYT property will be very busy with two large-scale events. One begins at 1PM and expected to be completed and cleared from the parking lot by 5:45PM. The parking lot will then be opened for the Eitz Chaim/Kollel ground-breaking

ceremony. We ask our members who are attending the ceremony or coming to daven to walk to shul if possible as parking will be a premium. If you drive, we urge people to use the Clark side of the parking lot first and a section will be reserved on the Clark side for those attending Mincha/Maariv both at plag and regular times. There will be security at both gates to ensure the safe passage for everyone.

Many of you sent us a notification regarding a \$10,000 grant regarding the Ontario Anti-Hate Security and Prevention Grant 2023-24 since it was announced. Thank you for looking out for the BAYT. The Security Committee, the office and the Executive moved quickly to apply for the grant. We were notified this week that application was approved. Yishar Koach to all. The money will be well spent.

This is going to be a very special Shabbos as we welcome the UJA President and CEO Adam Minsky who will be addressing our community on Shabbos morning about "Unlocking Our Collective Potential: How Orthodox Leadership is Pivotal to Our Community's Future".

On Shabbos afternoon, there will be a panel discussion where Adam will be joined by Daniel Held, Executive Director of the Julia and Henry Koschitzky Centre of Jewish Education, Susan Jackson, Vice President Volunteer Talent Management and Israel and Overseas at UJA Federation of Greater Toronto, Daniel Ages, Regional Manager Community Security Preparedness and our Rav titled, "The Challenges and Opportunities Confronting the Jewish People: A Conversation With UJA Leadership". I am so grateful that they are joining us for Shabbos. This will be a unique and amazing Shabbat opportunity and we hope that you will take advantage of the outstanding programs that we have planned.

Federation does so much for the Toronto Jewish community. Almost every member of the BAYT is a beneficiary of UJA's support. One example is that this year around \$15 million is earmarked for the Jewish Day School system (Associated, Eitz Chaim, CHAT, Darchei, Tiferes, Netivot, Or Chaim and Ulpana and more). You will hear much more about that, including the tuition subsidies that have been secured with endowments. 

Blessings of the Shema Part 2: The First Blessing

The first blessing before the Shema, both in the evening and in the morning, relates to God's mastery over nature. The morning blessing focuses on the creation of light. The evening blessing emphasizes the cycle of day and night. According to the Talmud, each blessing must mention the themes of the other. Consequently, each blessing begins with an introductory section that mentions both day and night and concludes with a final statement about the specific theme of that time. The morning blessing concludes with yotzer hameorot (Creator of luminaries). The evening blessing concludes with hama'ariv aravim (who causes the night to fall). This structure

emphasizes G-d's unified mastery over all aspects of the universe. In this way it is an introduction to the Shema.

The thematic requirement raises a halachic question: What if one accidentally switches the introductory section of one blessing with the other? The Talmud indicates that this is acceptable since each introductory section includes references to both day and night. Therefore, substituting the nighttime introductory section in the morning, or vice versa, does not significantly deviate from the essential themes of the blessing. As long as the correct concluding statement is recited, the blessing remains effective. However, the Shulchan Aruch stipulates that this only applies if the person promptly corrects themselves and also recites the appropriate introductory section for that time of day. Otherwise, the blessing must be repeated.

What is the meaning of the verse "The secret things belong to Hashem our God; but the things that are revealed belong to us and to our children forever, that we may do all the words of this law."

Devarim 29:28)?

Targum Yerushalmi (an Aramaic translation of the Torah from Israel in the time of the Mishnah) elucidates that G-d knows who sinned in secret and punishes them, but for open offenses we are responsible to establish laws.

Rabbi Avraham Ibn Ezra agrees and says one cannot explain 'that the secret and the revealed things belong to G-d and we only need to observe the words of the Torah. Now this interpretation has no head or foot.

Why can't we simply observe the laws of the Torah without a law system? Because the Torah contains Mitzvoth to adjudicate. There are Mitzvoth between man and G-d which G-d can reward or punish us for as seen in the previous verses. But there are also Mitzvoth between man and man for which we are responsible to resolve. Each of these responsibilities is part of the Torah and G-d wants us and our children to be part of that system together with all of Bnei Yisrael, Nitzavim HaYom Kulchem, all of us staring together.
