President's Message

Our COVID-19 task force met this week to consider recent updates to the Provincial reopening plan. Most relevant to BAYT would be our ability to remove capacity limits applicable to our minyanim if we voluntarily adopt Ontario's vaccine certificate mandate. While attendance is gradually increasing week after week, our minyanim are ordinarily within capacity limits. BAYT will not voluntarily choose to join the optional Provincial mandate.

If we project exceeding 250 persons in the Main Shul, due to a bar or bat mitzvah or aufruf for example, BAYT will plan for each scenario on a case-by-case basis with the host family and our Religious committee.

Weddings and other catered events at BAYT are already subject to mandatory vaccination confirmation. To the extent a chuppah for example exceeds the 250-person capacity limit in the main shul, existing vaccination confirmation protocols for catered receptions should enable us to lawfully permit more than 250 people at the chuppah. Again, BAYT will address each simcha on a case-by-case basis.

Yes, COVID-19 cases continue to decline in Ontario and in York Region. But there is a but. As of Wednesday evening, a total of five schools in all of York region were in COVID-19 outbreak status with 41 total cases reported. Four of the five were Jewish schools with 37 reported cases. The fifth school is a public school. This is a reality, not a criticism. COVID-19 remains a public health concern particularly in our tight knit community. While some members believe BAYT is too wooden with our COVID protocols, just as many believe we should voluntarily adopt the Provincial vaccine mandate. With no known COVID transmissions in a minyan at BAYT, we believe our protocols work and will stay the course.

A few Executive and Board member have been working with our office staff on a few initiatives. Here is a who is who and who does what in our office.

- ♦ Avital is our director of administration. She oversees all office functions. Avital is working with Shimon to map and document our office work-flow processes.
- ♦ Karen is our operations supervisor. She coordinates the scheduling and staffing of all events, including catered events and minyanim, at BAYT. Karen works approximately a four-day week.
- ♦ As you already know, Terry is our full-time number cruncher and overseer of all things business related.
- ♦ Shimon has been a jack of all trades but will be focusing more of his time on communications including e-mail and social media management. Shimon is currently working with Chuck English and Sara Silverman on a social media plan.
- ♦ Atara is our membership coordinator responsible for member management including renewals (which will have a hard close November 30 so she can focus more on providing service to renewed members). Atara works half-time.
- ♦ Melanie works part time and is responsible for our weekly bulletin and special projects.
- ♦ Sarah works part time and works on a never-ending list of special projects. Both Melanie and Sarah assist Atara with membership related tasks.

Our Human Resources committee and I have been meeting with our office team to identify work flows that require additional focused resources. We believe we may need two additional staff members in the office and are currently working on job descriptions and factoring the needs into our 2022 budget which is on the desk of our budget and finance committee.

What berachah is recited for potato kugel?

Standard recipes for potato kugel include potatoes, onions, eggs and oil, as well as flour. Despite the presence of flour, halachic authorities rule that the berachah for potato kugel is not mezonot; only a relatively small amount of flour is used, and it is present only to bind the potato together.

The correct berachah depends on the state of the potato:

- Where visible chunks of potato are present, the berachah is ha'adamah.
- Where the potato has been ground into flour, most authorities rule that the berachah is shehakol.
- Where the potato is shredded or grated, so that strips of potato are present, opinions vary; the majority view is to recite ha'adamah.

Where was Yitzchak during the burial and mourning for his mother Sarah?

Rabbeinu Bachya explains that surely Yitzchak cared deeply for his mother Sarah who lovingly doted upon him. Instead, Yitzchak likely wasn't even told about the death of Sarah at this point because of the fear that he wouldn't be able to handle the fact that Sarah had died after hearing the news of his Akeida, binding and almost being sacrificed to G-d. Rabbeinu Bachya also notes that Yitzchak has been missing since the return from the Akieda last week.

Targum Yerushalmi (Aramaic translation find out more on Wednesday night @8:15pm) on 22:19 explains that he was learning at Yeshivat Shem v'Ever immediately after the Akeidah for the next three years but why wouldn't they tell him about his mother's passing?

Midrash haGadol posits that Yitzchak was taken to Gan Eden, meaning he was no longer on this plane of existence.

There is another possibility: Yitzchak was present and heard about the death of Sarah, but took the loss so hard that he was unable to be involved in the burial of other elements of the mourning process. Everyone mourns differently, and perhaps Yitzchak simply needed his time to process his feelings alone.
