President's Message:

We all know the story. Hashem called out at the burning bush to appoint Moshe messenger of the Jewish people to Pharoah. Unsure and lacking confidence and courage, Moshe begged, "Please my Lord, I am not a man of words." "I am cumbrous of speech and tongue." Even after Hashem's admonition that He was the source of the words that came from the mouth of man, Moshe did not want to be the one.

In June 1858 as the debate over slavery intensified, Louisiana Senator Judah Benjamin (the second Jew to serve in the US Senate) engaged in a heated exchange on the Senate floor with Mississippi Senator Jefferson Davis over a misunderstanding involving weapons procurement. Benjamin, a brilliant orator and accomplished litigator had zero military experience. Davis, on the other hand graduated West Point had served as US Secretary of War. Davis made Benjamin look like a fool. Incensed and insulted, Benjamin uncharacteristically sent Davis a note challenging him to a duel. Davis knew better then to battle with a lesser-trained fellow Southern senator. Davis apologized.

Davis and Benjamin went on to become closest of allies, albeit on the wrong side of history. Benjamin's oratory fueled the flames of succession. Davis became President of the Confederate States of America appointing Benjamin first as attorney general, secretary of war and then secretary of state of the Confederacy. After the war, Benjamin and Davis went their separate ways. Benjamin covertly left the United States for England where he quickly ascended to the highest ranks of England's bar. In London, he authored Benjamin on Sales, a masterful treatise on the American, English, and French laws of contracts cited by attorneys to this day.

Judah Benjamin's life illustrates the power of our words, good and bad. Acknowledged as the finest orator in Washington DC. Highly sought after as an attorney (the most expensive one in America). The first Jew nominated to the US Supreme Court (he declined). And later, leader of a government formed to preserve slavery. Benjamin's best words brought him fame and fortune. But his tarnished spot in American history is that as the spokesman of the Confederacy.

All too often our words serve other than good intentions. We speak ill of one another, behind each other's backs. Like Moshe at the burning bush, we fear face to face conversations. We speak but don't listen. We share one side of the story without acknowledging every story has at least two sides.

Our words can build. Our words can divide. May we have the courage and wisdom to use our words wisely.

What berachah do I recite before eating a salad that contains croutons?

Regarding croutons baked for use in a salad, one could contend that the appropriate berachah would be mezonot, because such croutons are not the mainstay of a meal. Such croutons would be similar to the dry cracker which early halachic authorities termed pat haba'ah b'kisnin. One would recite a mezonot for this kind of crouton.

However, croutons in restaurants are often recycled from unused bread, via toasting. Such croutons retain their original berachah of hamotzi, as bread. [Note, though, that one who will eat less than an egg-sized volume of bread (croutons or otherwise) should not recite al netilat yadayim when washing.]

There is some debate regarding the status of deep fried croutons; one should endeavour to eat these croutons as part of a bread-based meal.

A "New" King?

How did we end up as slaves in Egypt if Yosef was vizier? Shemot 20:8 explains that "there was a new king over Egypt who didn't know Yosef"? Can one forget the savior of their nation?

While the simplest explanation of the verse is that it is a simply new king, (Rashi quoting Sotah 11a), Onkelos translates it as a new king who did not uphold Yosef's decrees. But which decrees did Yosef make?

Yosef's first law is that in exchange for being saved from the famine, all Egyptians must continue paying 20% in taxes to Pharaoh. Undoing this law, a terrible economic decision on a national scale could explain why he suddenly felt extremely financially threatened by the Jewish people.

Another potential law proposed by Yosef is that the Jewish people should live in Goshen as shepherds separate from the Egyptians. Pharaoh's repealing this decree and forcing assimilation led to friction then hate.

Whichever law Pharaoh hastily repealed, ultimately led to the enslavement of the Jewish people. When looking at laws and customs enacted by previous generations, we often only see the flaws. We cannot forget history and must make sure to weigh options and repercussions fully.




