

President's Message

These are exciting times at BAYT.

Our members are returning to BAYT in greater numbers day by day and week after week. Please review our new davening schedules and venues.

Next week, Mizrachi Canada programming kicks off. Please join us this Sunday morning for a Zoom town hall to learn more.

Also, next week, a new daily daf yomi starts after the 7:15AM minyan in the Steven Speisman boardroom. Thank you Michael Stavsky for your generous sponsorship and leadership.

Ideas for additional learning opportunities? Send us a note.

Our COVID committee continues to explore adjustments to our protocols. We hear your concerns from perspectives of being too cautious to not enough. Keeping minyanim safe and in one venue at the same time week after week is paramount. No easy task, particularly on Shabbat when BAYT is buzzing with at least six morning minyanim. We considered some minor changes last week and this week but feel compelled to stay the course for now. Here's why....

Our first task is to migrate the Chuppah Garden minyanim indoors. A new fully vaccinated Shabbat minyan is planned in partitioned Perlis Hall, starting the same time as the to-be-hibernated outdoor minyan.

Ordinarily, the partition between the Turk Family Beis Medrash and Rebbetzin Judy Taub Hall will be kept open every day and on Shabbat to ensure social distancing and capacity limitations. Our plan is to keep our growing Young Adults and Young Families minyan in the combined Turk/Taub, and Youth groups close by in the West Wing. The Hashkama, High School boys and JLIC minyanim also have homes on the ground level. Smachot may require adjustments to venues as is the case this Shabbat.

This week saw weekday over weekday increases in new COVID cases and the seven-day moving average. Fortunately, hospitalizations remain low and well below projections. But we need to remain vigilant as public health data indicates L4J remains a COVID hotspot. As of November 3, nine schools and three daycares in all of York region were in COVID-19 outbreak status reporting 83 cases. Three Jewish schools and two Jewish day cares reported 67 of the 83 total cases.

WEEKLY HALACHAH BY RABBI TORCZYNER

May I wear gloves when holding a Torah during an aliyah in an outdoor minyan in cold weather?

The Talmud (Pesachim 57a) condemned a kohen who covered his hands with silks when serving in the Beit haMikdash. Rashi explained that the kohen was wrong because a kohen must hold the vessels directly in his hands; the silks constituted an interruption. Tosafot argued that the issue was disrespect; covering his hands conveyed the message that the service was dirty and distasteful. This teaches two possible reasons to avoid using gloves to hold a Torah:

- Wearing gloves may convey disrespect for the Torah (Tosafot);
- When reciting the berachah for an aliyah, we customarily hold the Torah's atzei chaim (wood rollers), and we would not want an interruption (Rashi).

Despite the above, most halachic authorities rule one may wear gloves for warmth when holding the atzei chaim of a Torah:

- First, the cold weather makes clear that the purpose is protection, not disrespect.
- Second, the custom of holding the atzei chaim (1) may allow for a glove's interruption, and (2) is custom rather than strict law.

The only restriction is that the gloves must be clean and dignified; work gloves, for example, would be inappropriate. The same is true for gloves worn during any part of davening.

What does it mean when Rivka went to search out G-d? LiDrosh et Hashem? What did Rivka do to solve the pain of fighting fetuses in her belly?

Targum Onkelos explains that Rivka went to seek out an Ulpan, teaching, from before G-d. Rivka is answered directly in the next verse with a prophecy from G-d.

Similarly, Rabbi Saadia Gaon in his Tafsir, Arabic translation of the Torah (to hear more about it join us Wednesday @8:15pm tiny.cc/translated), posits that she sought a Yediya, to know what precisely G-d had in mind.

Targum Yerushalmi offers that she went to the Beit Midrash of the Great Shem to pray to G-d for mercy.

Rashbam suggests that Rivka went to the prophets of her time to see if they could help.

Ultimately, whether Rivka went to seek G-d directly, or went to pray at a Beit Midrash or to a prophet for help, G-d rewarded Rivka with an answer to her inquiry and search for G-d with a prophecy about her unborn children's fate. May we merit to find the answers we seek, just like Rivka did.

The Friedman Classroom
