#### **President's Message**

'Twas a good week. I nervously attended my first in person conference in over two years with around 30 attorneys and CPAs from across Canada and the US. I missed the first two days to tend to a bunch of BAYT matters that took back burner to the October 15 US tax deadline. On Tuesday, we discussed some of the legal considerations related to mandatory employer vaccine policies, primarily Ontario driven with a sprinkling of British Columbia, Manitoba, and North Carolina law mixed in. While the state of the law seems strongly pro-employer, COVID presents significant and not so ancillary or inexpensive human resources challenges.

Our discussion included a policy question: Is it efficient or fair for the sovereign to push mandatory vaccine enforcement down to the private sector? Could University Health Network's recent decision to deny transplants to patients who are not fully vaccinated be extended to OHIP? (Apparently not from both a Charter rights and political perspective). In the US, we surmised private health insurers could theoretically influence public health policies by raising premiums on those who are unvaccinated.

l bring this to your attention simply to illustrate the challenges BAYT faces related to COVID-19 are commonplace everywhere. I look forward to life (and a presidency) beyond COVID-19. On a more positive note, we are moving forward with several important initiatives:

This week, the Board approved an agreement with Mizrachi Canada to bring an exciting, regular schedule of educational programs into BAYT starting next month. In the next little while, we will tell you more about the agreement and how it benefits BAYT, Mizrachi Canada, and our communities.

Vice Presidents David Vodianoi and David Lithwick invested significant time and energy to secure studies, quotes, and financing from five companies to replace our original, frail, and leaky roof. The Board approved of their diligence and recommendations. Work begins shortly.

You may have noticed new LED lighting installed throughout BAYT, a Board approved initiative also driven by David Lithwick and partially funded with grant money.

On the dark side (no pun intended), you may have noticed some of the parking lot lights are not working. Our two Davids traced the problem to corroded wiring and are working on a fix.

In 2019, Past President Zac Kaye addressed the long overdue need to educate our Board members on matters pertaining to fundamental principles of good governance. COVID postponed the program Zac identified, but the need remains. This week, we took steps to move forward with this most important initiative. This needs to become an obligatory first order of business for all future Boards. Thank you Zac!

We have been advised changes to Ontario laws affecting not-for-profit organizations took effect this week after more than a decade of delay. Having previously been counselled of the need, a group of our attorney members has agreed to draft a conflict-of-interest policy to present to the Board. Stay tuned.

We just added two young CPAs to our Budget and Finance committee. Our in-house number cruncher, Terry Rubenstein and the committee started work this week on a budget for 2022. Since May, Terry has upscaled our internal financial reporting capabilities. He migrated BAYT to Quick Books Online from a 10-year-old desktop version running on Windows 7. In the process, Terry implemented internal account groupings based on our audited financial statements. This sets the stage for consistent monthly financial reporting and a streamlined, more efficient annual audit.

After delays beyond their control, the Technology committee advises significant progress has been made bringing high speed fibre into BAYT to support our new VOIP phone system, our network, and our security infrastructure.

On any given Shabbat, BAYT is buzzing! Our Young Adult, Young Families initiatives and Youth programs are thriving and generating new member engagement. A big yasher koach to our Young Adult, Young Family, Youth and Religious committee volunteers.

Thank you to all the volunteers and staff who make everything happen, for you.

#### Should a Jew wear a poppy for Remembrance Day?

It is certainly appropriate for a Jew to demonstrate gratitude to the Canadian armed forces, by memorializing those who lost their lives in defense of others. This fulfills the mandate of *hakarat hatov* (recognizing the good provided by others) and *darchei shalom* (promoting a peaceful society).

The Torah's prohibition against *chukot akum* ("accepting the protocols of the nations") does not apply; that law prohibits clothing which may stem from idolatry, but the poppy's source is clearly not idolatrous.

One who will attach a poppy on Shabbat should be careful to follow the rules regarding "stitching" on Shabbat, being careful not to pass the straight pin through the garment more than once.

#### Be Our Guest

Why did the angels readily agree to Avraham's invitation but respond so coldly to Lot?

Rashi quotes Breishit Rabbah that we can decline an invitation from someone who is lesser in stature, but one should not readily decline an invitation from a great person.

Chizkuni explains that they were able to catch on to the local law against having guests by Lot's strange manner of speech, placing sleeping before washing their feet, and once they realized that it was illegal, they had no desire to stay anymore.

A close reading of the verses reveals two different attitudes towards guests. Avraham ran excitedly over to them, bowing to them, and asked very nicely and politely for them, making only a small request to join for a short rest and a bite of bread. Comparatively, Lot appeared to be doing so begrudgingly, not running over and making an overly grand request that causes them undue pressure. The angels could tell that Lot didn't truly want them, and could sense his hesitancy.

When hosting guests, it is important to be like Avraham, welcoming warmly and making the honoured guests feel at home. Only when our guests know that we are enjoying their company have we truly fulfilled the mitzvah of Hachnasat Orchim.
