

SAFETY NOTICE

EVACUATION PROCEDURE FOR SHABBAT/YOM TOVIM



Reasons for Evacuations could be -

- Fire
- Power Outage
- Moving People to Safety

Although we would ideally want to have "wardens" appointed to guide everyone out the building, unlike schools or offices where the core group is static our shul with the multitude of minyanim particularly on a Shabbat we are dealing with a fluid situation.

The evacuation model we are working with is as follows

Everyone's cooperation is necessary to Evacuate safely and speedily. Safety-Security Members are to take charge of the area they are in and guide persons out the area. Once an area is CLEAR the Safety-Security Members should proceed to exit the building and make sure that all others have done so as well. As the last persons exit the building advise the **Evacuation Leader** who will be standing by the island at the Parking Lot Entrance Doors

- When a Fire Alarm or Instruction to Evacuate is heard everyone should move quickly to
 the nearest designated exit point do not run or push proceed down/up the stairs to
 exit the building and then move to the Safe Evacuation Areas along the east side (601
 Clark) and south side (Eitz Chaim) of the parking lot DO NOT CONGREGATE IN FIRE
 LANE
- DO NOT use Elevators
- DO NOT gather your belongings
- DO NOT try locate your children the Youth Department will take care of children in designated Youth programs
- When a Fire Alarm is pulled ALL Exit doors unlock
- The first persons reaching a door leading to an exit should hold open the door and stand clear to speed the exit of those behind them until relieved by a Safety-Security Team Member
- Once Safety-Security Team members reach the door they should take over from the lead persons that were first at the door
- Once everyone has safely evacuated the area Safety-Security Team Members should report to the Evacuation Leader to indicate that the area they left is CLEAR
- Persons needing Assistance should move to the closest stairwell landing and remain there
 until assistance can be provided advise the Safety-Security Team member who will report
 details to the Evacuation Leader to arrange for assistance
- Re-Entry to the building will be determined by the **Evacuation Leader** in consultation with the Authorities (Fire Department, Police etc)






MAIN LEVEL

- Perlis Hall exit past washrooms down stairs to York Hill OR through Clark Entrance Doors







May I sit on a tree-swing on Shabbat?

There is a biblical prohibition against breaking off any part of a plant on Shabbat. To prevent accidental violation of this law, the Sages prohibited any use of the body of a tree on Shabbat. [However, one may simply touch the trunk of a sturdy tree, if the tree won't move.]

"Use" includes climbing up, placing items into, attaching items to, or removing items from, a tree. For example, one may not remove a frisbee which lands in a branch or tree-house, even if one could do so while standing on the ground.

The prohibition also includes use of items which are attached to the tree, such as swings or treehouses. However, one may use items which are one step removed from a tree. Therefore, one may lie in a hammock or sit on a swing which hangs from a peg which is, in turn, attached to a tree. But even this use is prohibited if it would shake or shift the tree.

(Shulchan Aruch Orach Chaim 336:13; Magen Avraham 336:2, 15; Aruch haShulchan Orach Chaim 336:16, 339:2-3; Mishneh Berurah 336:63; Shemirat Shabbat k'Hilchatah 26:11-17)

<u>D'VAR TORAH</u> BY RABBI METZGER

How are we supposed to relate to people who we disagree with? Those who have seemingly, or outright wronged us?

In a short sequence of only two verses (Vaykira 19:17-18) we receive six different Mitzvot: 1) not to hate our brethren 2) to rebuke our fellows when they err 3) not to embarrass anyone 4) not to take revenge 5) not hold a grudge 6) to love every member of Israel.

Rabbi Moshe Alshech (16th-century Tzfat) explains that although we may feel that our fellow Jews have committed a wrongdoing, we should not feel animosity towards them in our hearts. Instead, we should rebuke the offending party, telling them our thoughts. Obviously, this should be done sensitively in a way that will not embarrass them, and that they will not hold it against you. If they respond brazenly, you should not take revenge or hold a grudge because they may accept your words and become your friend again, so you will be able to love your fellow, viAhavta leReacha KaMocha.

Here we see a model for how to dispute and debate perceived wrongdoing. We must discuss what we have seen in a forthright manner, not simply hide our thoughts in our hearts until they develop into grudges, revenge, or hatred. This is no small task, but is necessary to love our fellows as ourselves.


