# PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

## "And you shall tell your son..."

As you know, we are in Israel with the mission which began on Tuesday. I will leave it to the Rav to report on the mission, but I wanted to share with you our experience on Sunday. It was a massive roller coaster of a day that summarizes life in Israel as we passed over 100 days since the war broke out. We continue to pray for the safe release of our hostages and may Hashem protect our brave chayalim. First, we attended the shiva house of Reserve Sergeant Major David Schwartz z"I, a 26 years old resident of Elazar, husband of Meital (Gitler) and the son of Sara and Yair. He was a combat soldier in the 8219th engineering battalion, of the 551st Hatzei Ha'esh (Arrows of Fire) formation. He fell in battle in the southern Gaza Strip. The Gitler family is well known for their chesed as the founders of Leket, for which the BAYT raised over \$50,000 for in November.

Then we attended the shiva of my sister-in-law, Reva Guttmann whose mother Barbara Kresch z"I had passed at the age of 88. Barbara was a Polish Holocaust survivor who miraculously lived below ground in a bunker from the age of 4 with her parents, grandparents, and four uncles and some cousins, eleven in all, for six years. They all survived.

In the evening, we attended the wedding of Zach and Dalya Brown, children of Jeffrey and Annette Brown, which had ruach that was simply impossible to describe. Many of their friends are in battle and were granted twenty-four hours leave to join in the simcha, traveling from all over Israel. They danced until almost one in the morning when they had to vacate the hall, but before departing we sat and benched followed by Sheva Brachot. Many had to be back on their bases first thing in the morning. Just a typical day in Israel. A loss of a neshama way too early. A loss of a Holocaust survivor. The beginning of a new family. Impossible not to shed many tears as we faced the true lifecycle of our mishpacha.

Two of my Seforim still remain AWOL, but I would like to thank Rabbi Lesher who bought for me the second volume of Shabbat by Rabbi Tzvi Yosef Rimon. Thank you so much! HOWEVER, both Seforim still remain at large. Please keep your eyes open on Shabbat so I can pay it forward. However, my volume 1 Daf Yomi size of Bava Kama still leaves my library with a hole. Please check inside the pews in front of you and see if you can locate it for me. I appreciate your assistance.

On Tuesday, York Regional Police announced multiple, serious charges—including two counts of assault—against an individual who targeted four Jewish community members walking home from synagogue. The suspect, who was on a bike, acted in an intimidating manner toward the victims, including spitting on them and making antisemitic statements.

We applaud Toronto Police Services and York Regional Police for their continued work to keep our community safe. We cannot overstate the importance of rapid reporting. If you ever experience a criminal act, such as threats, harassment, or any other concern related to your personal safety, please call 911 right away. When safe, call UJA Community Security at 416-635-5600. A special thank you to our Mayor Steven Del Duca for his no nonsense and unwavering approach to dealing with antisemitism from day one.

Whenever grants and matching grants from the Federal and Provincial government become available the BAYT always submits requests. Without fail we are always successful, and we put the funds towards critical security infrastructure. The last grant we applied for was a SIP grant – a matching grant up to \$100,000 available specifically for security for houses of worship. The BAYT leadership was prepared to invest \$200,000 which would have upgraded our security cameras and gates which are urgently needed. Given the current security situation and past success at obtaining grants, you would have thought that we would be a shoe in for this particular grant. Last week we were notified that we were denied because so many organizations had applied. Communicating with other shuls in the country we quickly realized that the majority of shuls in the group that applied had also been denied the grant. So, I contacted our MP Melissa Lantsman who responded immediately and was shocked. We wanted to know how many other places of worship had been granted a SIP grant. Melissa jumped on it and the result was a formal letter to the government, the media and an op-ed in the National Post last Thursday. Surprisingly we found out that many other places have been awarded the grant If we are rejected, we may have to appeal to the BAYT members for important upgrades. I will keep you updated on this matter because our security is really at risk.

The congregation would like to express its condolences to Melissa Lantsman who lost her father, Michael, this past week.

Thank you to Mark Mietkiewicz, Adult Education Chair who works tirelessly and it's no surprise that this past motzei Shabbos we had our annual Movie Night. It was extremely well attended, and the movies were amazing. Shout out to Shloimie Romberg for assisting Mark. We hope to improve the experience with a bigger screen and better sound system as I'm told we may have another movie night in the near future. Mark is looking for assistance with Adult Education so if you can please contact Mark.



# **BEIT MIDRASH ZICHRON DOV**

## INTRODUCTIONS TO THE LAWS OF SHEMA BY RABBI ADAM FRIEDMANN

#### Mistakes When Reading the Shema

The pesukim within each paragraph of the Shema must be read in the proper sequence, even after the fact. But changing the sequence of the paragraphs themselves, even though this is not ideal, is still effective. These two rules explain the halachah in cases where a person makes a mistake when reading the Shema or loses focus and is unsure about which parts they have already read:

If one knows they made a mistake within a paragraph, they should go back and read from the beginning of the pasuk where the mistake was until the end of that paragraph. Mistakes in this context include substituting or leaving out words If one knows they just finished reading one of the first two paragraphs, but isn't sure which one, they should continue from the beginning of the second paragraph (vehaya im shamoa). This is only true if they can't remember saying any of the words that are particular to the second paragraph and if the doubt arises before starting the third paragraph.

If one finds themselves saying the word "uchtavtam" but isn't sure if it's the one from the first paragraph or the second paragraph, they should continue reading the first paragraph. If one has already started saying "lema'an yirbu yemeichem" from the end of the second paragraph, then they should continue from there.

Right after Moshe warned Pharaoh about the impending plague of locusts and the destruction that will follow, Pharaoh's servants say to him, "How long will this be a menace to us? Send these men out and let them worship their God. Before long everyone will know Egypt is destroyed!?" (Shemot 10:7)

Why does Pharaoh ignore the desperate plea of his constituents? Doesn't what they say make perfect sense? What makes Pharaoh so stubborn?

The first answer that comes to mind is because G-d hardened Pharaoh's heart, but that only occurs at the end of the plague (10:20).

Pharaoh initially gave in, asking Moshe "Who will be going?" Moshe answered everyone - young and old, sons and daughters, sheep and oxen must serve G-d for our festival. Pharaoh denies this possibility, saying that only the men should go and instead opting to let the locust descend on Egypt.

Pharaoh cannot be persuaded to change his mind, to recognize the value of each and every member of Bnai Yisrael no matter their age or gender. Fixed in his wicked ways, Pharaoh persists and places his people on the path to ruin. Understanding when it is time to fight back, and when every voice counts is why Israel is still here and Pharaoh merely part of the past.


