





I had a dairy meal, and want to have meat now. What must I do in between?

The requirements depend on the kind of dairy food one has eaten:

- After drinking dairy liquids, just rinse out your mouth; many people also wait at least 30 minutes.
- After eating solids (other than aged cheese), eat a solid pareve food that will clean the mouth, or brush your teeth. Then rinse out your mouth, and wash your hands or check them for dairy particles. Many people also wait at least 30 minutes.
- After eating aged cheese, wait as you would wait after eating meat before eating dairy. For good articles by the OU defining "aged cheese", see http://bit.ly/cheesewait and http://bit.ly/oucheese.

Authorities debate whether one may eat dairy and then meat in the same meal (following the protocol outlined above), without reciting a closing berachah for the dairy. For more on this issue, see the OU's "Halacha Yomis" on the topic at http://bit.ly/dairymeat.

The Levites replaced the firstborn of Israel to serve as guardians of the Mishkan, and the 273 extra firstborns needed to pay five silver shekels apiece. (Bamidbar 3:47) How did Moshe choose them?

Rashi quotes the Gemara in Sanhedrin 17a that Moshe was concerned that some firstborns might protest about the fairness of needing to pay to redeem themselves. Therefore, Moshe wrote 22,000 slips of paper being written "Son of Levi" and 273 with "five shekels" mixed them up, and had each firstborn draw from the lottery.

Why did Moshe spend so much time and energy? Couldn't he have simply assigned people?

Rabbi Menachem Meiri (13th century France) explains that everyone should be exceedingly careful to avoid feelings of jealousy between friends even if they are a great philanthropist or divinely ordained prophet who leads the people like Moshe.

Bamidbar is also called the Book of Numbers because of the various censuses contained within. No matter how large our community grows, no matter the amount, it is crucial to ensure that everyone feels represented. It is incumbent upon each of us to go out of our way to include individuals no matter how small the matter may seem.




