PRESIDENT MESSAGE:

By the time you read this (noon Friday), the official slate for next year's BAYT Executive Committee and Board will either be acclaimed or contested. You will note old and new names on the official slate this year. Finances and governance continue to be paramount with 4 CPA nominees (and me a fifth as past president). One of the CPAs, Yaakov Adatto, has been serving on the budget and finance committee with outgoing treasurer Jonathan Hames. Howard Wasserman has been 'apprenticing' with outgoing Gabbi David Kaplan. Craig Guttmann (not a CPA), co-chair of our fundraising committee, has made sure the bean counters had beans to count.

As a covenantal people, serving others is what Jews do. We do not think about it. We just do it. 'Shkoach to all the nominees as well as the Nominations Committee (Michael Mammon, Mitch Silverstein, Aliza Gershuni, myself, and chair Zac Kaye).

Starting with the Mayflower, Americans fancied themselves as a covenantal people. Reference to the Israelites and Torah are commonplace in the writings of the Pilgrims (many of whom were anti-Semites), our Founding Fathers and the speeches of every single President since. As Rabbi Jonathan Sacks z'l wrote on this week's parsha, "covenantal politics is moral politics, driving an elemental connection between the fate of a nation and its vocation. This is statehood as a matter not of power but of ethical responsibility."

As an American, lifelong Republican and licensed gun owner, I mourn the demise of civil political discourse and compromise in the United States. If the American covenant with one another is anything other than words mimicking our Torah, enough is enough. Mass shootings in schools, supermarkets, synagogues, churches, or masjids are not OK. Doing nothing is not OK. And in the 50 years since Roe v. Wade, Congress could had legislated on women's rights one way or another but did not. President Obama had a filibuster proof Congress in 2009. Nothing. When it comes to individual rights, it is risky business to leave the law of the land up to the nine unelected individuals who serve as lifetime justices on the United States Supreme Court.

Ontarians vote for a new Provincial Parliament this Thursday. Fulfill your covenantal responsibility. Vote.

I normally sit for kiddush and stand for havdalah; what do I do when Shabbat leads into Yom Tov, so that havdalah is part of kiddush?

The berachah of havdalah within kiddush adopts the posture of the kiddush in which it is recited. Those who normally sit for kiddush should sit for this berachah of havdalah, too, and those who normally stand for kiddush should stand for this berachah of havdalah, too.

Also: one should not intentionally overflow the cup of wine which will be used for this combined kiddush and havdalah. Rabbi Shlomo Zalman Auerbach explains that one goal of overflowing the cup is as a sign of blessing for one's livelihood, and that is inappropriate during Yom Tov.

<u>D'VAR TORAH</u> <u>BY RABBI METZGER</u>

G-d guarantees that if we follow all of the mitzvot, that we will have peace in the land. But why does it also say 'no sword shall cross your land' (Vayikra 26:6)?

Rashi explains based on the Halakhic Midrash Sifra that even though it seems unnecessary that no sword will enter your land, it means that armies will not even pass through your land to wage battle with a different nation. But what is so bad about an allied army passing through?

Ralbag, Rabbi Levi ben Gershon, a French Rabbi and philosopher from 13th century France elucidates that there is still damage or fear that can befall the people. An army passing through can quickly turn into a hostile force.

In fact, King Yoshiyahu refused entry to Pharaoh Necho who sought to do battle with Babylon based on this verse. Thinking that the Jews were sufficiently righteous to merit no army crossing Israel, King Yoshiyahu made a tragic mistake which led to a war with Egypt and King Yoshiyahu's death.

G-d willing, one day we will merit to have no sword cross our land in Israel. Until that day we must strive for peace because every sword can be double edged.
