May I apply sunscreen on Shabbat?

There are two potential reasons to prohibit sunscreen on Shabbat:

1. One may not smear a cream on one's skin on Shabbat, and
2. One may only use medicine on Shabbat in limited circumstances, and sunscreen may be viewed as medicinal.

Despite these two concerns, one may use a spray-on sunscreen or a pourable liquid oil:

The prohibition against smearing only applies to materials which start out in a solid or semi-solid state, and are smeared with intent to coat a surface. [In a case of great need, even a cream might be permitted because it is absorbed in the skin. However, this would require a case-specific ruling from a halachic authority.]

According to most halachic authorities, sunscreen is not "medicine", since it is routinely applied by healthy people. Further, sunscreen is meant to prevent a health problem, not to cure one.

Of course, it is important to observe the biblical imperative to guard one's life; the risks involved in over-exposure to sunlight are well-known.

Why do Bnei Yisrael do Semikha on the Leviim, rest their hands on their heads, as part of the conferral process?

Rabbi Shmuel Bornsztain (1855 –1926), the second Rebbe of the Sochatchov Hasidic dynasty, in his work Shem MiShmuel explains that whenever Semikha is done it begins with someone who is more respected and honoured raising up the one being leaned upon. Such as when Moshe does Semikha on Yehoshua, resting his hand upon him to transfer the mantle of leadership, or when Smeikha is conferred upon Dayanim, judges. But then how are Bnei Israel doing so to the Leviim?

Rabbi Bornsztain continues that Bnei Israel are mentioned five times in this section corresponding to the five books of the Torah, showing our closeness to G-d. Bnei Yisrael gave the Leviim the role with the Mida of Ayin Tovah, a good eye, generously. By graciously granting this to the Leviim, Bnei Yisrael enable the Leviim to raise them up as well. The daily jobs of the Leviim included in the Mishkan of leading songs in the Mishkan, which can raise everyone together. We must all act like Bnei Yisrael and elevate ourselves with Ayin Tovah.



Dianna Roberts-Zauderer holds a PhD in Religion and Jewish Studies from the University of Toronto. She is the author of *Metaphor and Imagination in Medieval Jewish Thought: Moses Ibn Ezra, Judah Halevi, Moses Maimonides, and Shem Tov Ibn Falaquera* (Palgrave Macmillan: 2019). She has previously worked as a radio documentary producer, journalist, and Shoah Foundation interviewer.

Alexander Green is a Visiting Associate Professor at SUNY, University at Buffalo in the Department of Jewish Thought where he also serves as Buffalo Community Jewish Educator. His research is on medieval and early modern Jewish philosophy, ethics and the history of biblical interpretation. He is the author of two books: *The Virtue Ethics of Levi Gersonides* (Palgrave, 2016) and *Power and Progress: Joseph Ibn Kaspi and the Meaning of History* (SUNY Press, 2019). He is also co-editing *Jewish Virtue Ethics* with Geoffrey Claussen and Alan Mittleman which is forthcoming with SUNY Press.
