PRESIDENT MESSAGE:

A few years ago, my friend Yossi Klein HaLevi spoke in Toronto. A traditionally centrist Zionist, Yossi had been engaged in a loud sidebar with a Jewish NDP supporter whom I met on a few occasions. After, Yossi lamented to me, "These kinds of Jews drive me crazy!" When I asked if I should not bother to engage this person, he said, "Absolutely not! Keep on trying."

It is easy to have conversations with people whom we agree. It is easy to have a conversation and tell someone they are wrong and walk away. It is the difficult conversations that can be worthwhile even when ending in disagreement so long as two sides engage with respect, honesty, and integrity.

Last week, Annette and I attended a pluralistic gathering in Forest Hills, three kippot out of forty or so guests. Parents described difficult conversations over the pressures their children face every day in public schools and universities from students, teachers, and professors regarding Medinat Israel.

Anti-Israel discourse often lacks respect, honesty, and integrity. Misguided characterization of the State of Israel as a neo-colonial project. Assertions the Arabs should not suffer for the sins of Korban Europe. Or hyper-focus on the inevitable consequences of Israel's never-ending need to defend itself with force. Civilians die in war, not just combatants, no matter how well trained and disciplined the army.

The religious significance of the State of Israel to the Jewish people never comes up. In Behar, we learn about the laws of the sabbatical and jubilee years as well as laws pertaining to the sale of real estate in Eretz Israel. All mitzvot that we can only perform in Eretz Israel. Fortunately, thanks to their Jewish education, our children can stand up for themselves and the centrality of Eretz Israel to their religiosity. They can readily determine which difficult conversations to engage and which to walk from. But as Annette and I heard, too many Jewish children cannot. They lack a meaningful Jewish education, a meaningful Jewish upbringing and inevitably a lack of understanding of Eretz Israel.

Next week, Emunah Canada will honour me for my service to you over the past two years. Truth be told, you stepped up for your BAYT. Emunah honours me, but I honour you. My term as President may be winding down but our work never ends. As Past-President, I will make Kiruv a priority at BAYT. Bringing our lesser observant Jewish neighbours into our BAYT is good for our shul, the Jewish people and Medinat Israel.

I normally daven Nusach Ashkenaz. Which tachanun should I say when I am in a Nusach Sephard minyan?

As a rule, one should not deviate visibly from the minyan in which one davens. Therefore, one who is davening in a Nusach Sephard minyan should recite viduy, and the Thirteen Attributes of Divine Mercy, as they do.

For the same reason, one who normally davens Nusach Sephard, but who is currently in a Nusach Ashkenaz minyan, should recite viduy quietly and should not strike the chest in a way that will be visible.

The same rule applies regarding the order of sections in Tachanun on Mondays and Thursdays; one should not differ visibly from the rest of the minyan.

When one of our brothers in Bnei Yisrael falls on hard times we are commanded to strengthen him so that he can live with us. (Vayikra 25:35) But why are the next two verses about usury and charging interest?

Rashi explains that we must help the person before they fall completely. It is akin to an overladen donkey, where while the donkey stands upright, a single person is sufficient. But once the animal has collapsed not even five people will be able to make it stand again.

Rashi continues based on Bava Metzia 60b-61b that the next two verses repeat Neshech and Ribit, usury and charging interest, to make two prohibitions because people are very much drawn to making money in this fashion, and will only be stopped by fear of G-d.

In fact, the most profitable customer for credit companies and loan sharks alike is this individual who is slightly down financially. They continually will rack up interest and debts, constantly padding their rich lenders pockets.

We must take a moment to notice those around us, perhaps ask our friends and neighbors how we can help. Catch them before they fall, so that our brothers can proudly live with us.


