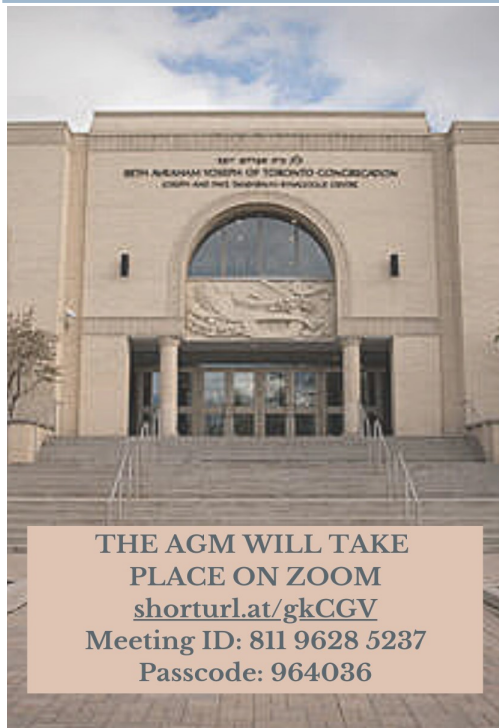

# PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

## When G-d Began Creating...

What an amazing fifty plus day journey it has been since the beginning of Elul! Thank you to everyone for injecting so much ruach into the BAYT. I have heard much positive feedback and it is very much appreciated. In the coming weeks, the High Holiday Chair, David Vodiano, will be preparing a post high holiday report, but David intends to survey the membership and get your feedback. Some members have verbally or via email shared their input already, but we would like to get the entire membership's feedback. We will limit the survey to key questions that will hopefully improve your davening experience, locations, starting time and services provided for the children, just to give you an idea of what we will be asking. There will be a separate Young Families survey too.

A special thank you to Moishe Posner and his kiddish team, Michael Ohayon, Shari Vodiano, Yonatan Aboudi, Jesse Nathanson, Andy Gelberger and Hershel Recht. They served something like ten tonnes of potato kugel alone.

I would like to thank Rebbetzin Leora Leshner for delivering the Women's Simchas Torah Shiur. We have noted that we require a larger venue for next year, Baruch HaShem. I wanted women to have the opportunity to attend Shacharit, including Hallel and then the shiur. I was not sure we would be done with Hallel by 10am, as we started davening at 9am this year. I should not have postponed the Women's Shiur in my announcements on Shemini Atzeret. I have learned a valuable lesson. I apologize for changing the time.

Now we return to our daily routine, but hopefully with a rejuvenation of our spirituality which includes learning more Torah, more serious davening, more activities, more volunteering and more socializing in the BAYT community.

### How early in the morning may I put on tefillin?

We do not put on tefillin unless there is sufficient daylight to recognize a casual acquaintance from several feet away; this time is called "*misheyakir*". Some explain that we wait until *misheyakir* because visibility is a core requirement for tefillin; others say we wait until *misheyakir* lest someone don tefillin earlier and fall asleep while wearing them. The BAYT calculates *misheyakir* as one hour before sunrise.

One whose work requires him to begin davening before *misheyakir*, and who is unlikely to fall asleep, may don tefillin without a berachah as early as necessary. After *misheyakir* he should recite the berachah and touch the tefillin.

One who will need to complete the entire davening before *misheyakir* should don tefillin for davening without a berachah, and find a later time to don tefillin with a berachah, repeating Shema, even late in the day. If putting on tefillin later would be impossible, significant authorities permit reciting a berachah even before *misheyakir*.
