# PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

# **Belief in Hashem**

What does it mean to truly believe in Hashem? Each and every day I face challenges and make decisions. In the famous lyrics of Rush's Freewill, "If you choose not to decide, you still have made a choice". This week's Parsha is the ultimate lesson to gather all the inner strength I had to overcome a long time fear and decided to make a choice.

Last week, on the very last day of my trip in Israel, I overcame a fear that I have had for over 19 years. I had finally gotten on a bus, No. 18 from the German Colony in Jerusalem to journey to the Yitzchak Navon train station and then onwards to Tel Aviv to visit my children and grandson. I'm not sure I ever thought I would be able to overcome my anxiety to what really should be such a very simple accomplishment... to get on a bus or train in Israel.

Deep in the cortex of my brain was fear and having to relive one of the most difficult days of my life. It started with a phone call from my brother, Avraham, that Yechezkel (Scotty) Goldberg z"l was murdered in Jerusalem travelling on Egged bus No. 19 which was bombed that morning on his way to work. Yechezkel was a casual friend of mine and close friend to several of my close friends. Tragically, Yechezkel was 41 and left behind his wife, Shifra, and seven children, Chana, Esther, Shoshana, Yitzchak, Eliezer, Yaakov Moshe, and Tzvi Yehoshua. Chezki dedicated his life to helping teens at risk (survivors of childhood emotional, physical and sexual abuse) and had articles published. Yechezkel was the brother to our members Dr. Ronn Goldberg and Marla Figdor and other siblings Chaim, Nesya, Kira and mother Ruth, ad meah v'esrim.

Yechezkel lived in Beitar Illit and was a close friend and neighbour to my brother and sister in law, Avraham (Mark) and Reva. So his murder was very heavy and no longer could I get on a bus without thinking about Yechezkel. I'm not exactly sure what enabled me to gather the strength to finally do what I did, but this week's Parsha somehow played in my mind, probably because I say this pasuk each and every day, יו and they had faith in Hashem. I thought I had complete faith in Hashem. Now, I do feel like I overcame a fear and put my complete trust in something as simple as putting my foot forward to get on a bus in Israel. Yechezkel's Yahrzeit was last week on the 6th of Shevat. May Yechezkel Shore ben Yaakov Moshe's neshama have an aliyah.

Just as disturbing to me is the murder this past week in Neve Yaakov of seven holy Jews hanging out after shul. It would never have dawned on me, that I should ever fear going to shul. That would never happen. (Interesting how my brain compartmentalizes.) In fact, the attack strengthens me. And I hope our community too. As you know, the BAYT Executive and Board take security very seriously and we do our best to protect our community, but our strength and resolve must always be rooted in ייאמינו בהי. We mourn the loss of Eli Mizrahi 48, Natali Mizrahi, 45, Ilya Sosnaski, 26, Raphael Ben Eliyahu, 56, Irina Korolova, 59, Shaul Chai, 68 and Asher Natan, 14. We pray for the injured to have a refuah shlema.

Congratulations to our Adult Education Co-Chairs Elaine Genesove, Mark Mietkiewicz and a special thank you to our MC Richie Stoll for your leadership to once again host our very successful BAYT Trivia night as well as make all the questions. And a big thank you to our BAYT students assisting with scoring: Des Rucker, Ezra Spodek and Eitan Steinfeld along with Leora Stoll. A tremendous amount of effort, passion and love goes into trivia night and it was displayed. It was a great evening had by all. Yasher Koach! For dessert, we celebrated our gabbai, Eddie Jesin's 60th birthday. Mazel Toy!

Big shout out to our very own Jesse Nathanson, Brotherhood President, who was one of the keynote speakers at the all-day event H3 Toronto which is a frum business and halacha networking group helping community members out in business. It was held at Copper Creek last week and I'm sure next year it will be even bigger. Stay tuned.

Finally, on Monday evening, I attended the Kurt Rothschild z"l azkara at Shaarei Shomayim, where the former Chief Rabbi Yisrael Meir Lau was supposed to attend and pay special tribute. At the very last minute he had to cancel, and in his place the current Chief Rabbi of Israel Rabbi Dovid Lau addressed the community. The Chief Rabbi of Israel cleared his calendar and came all the way to Toronto to pay tribute to Mr. Rothschild who was larger than life. Listening to all the amazing things Kurt had accomplished in one hundred and one years is monumental. Each and every one of us is an indirect or direct recipient of his chesed. Whether it's the spectrum of schools in Toronto, or the yeshivot and seminaries in Israel, hospitals, universities and much much more, Kurt was a Gadol haDor (giant of our generation). I found the evening so inspiring and realized how much I should be doing for our community and Israel. May Gershon ben Mordechai's neshama have an aliyah.

Parshat Beshalach means Shabbat Shira with our choir. I hope you join us in the Main Sanctuary, as we elevate our tefillah through song. I heard it may be cold this Shabbat, but I am confident your hearts will be warmed.

Tu b'Shevat is Monday February 6. There is a custom of eating fruit, and particularly fruit associated with Israel, on this day. Here are some of the laws of reciting Shehechiyanu for new fruit:

One who sees a seasonal, newly available fruit, and feels great joy at seeing it, recites the berachah of Shehechiyanu. One whose personal joy is not that great should not recite Shehechiyanu.

## When?

Technically, one recites Shehechiyanu even when seeing newly available fruit. However, we generally recite Shehechiyanu only upon eating; this is when most people feel the greatest joy.

We recite Shehechiyanu before reciting borei pri ha'eitz. One who eats many types of new fruit at the same sitting should recite one collective Shehechiyanu.

## Which fruit?

Fruit which is available via import all year still warrants a Shehechiyanu when it begins to grow locally and one eats it for the first time, if the local fruit is fresher or better, inducing joy.

Fruit which is available during two distinct times of the year, with at least one month of non-availability between them, warrants Shehechiyanu when the fruit becomes available and its presence induces joy.

We avoid reciting Shehechiyanu on fruit produced via a prohibited cross-species graft.

We do not recite Shehechiyanu on underripe fruit, even if it is somewhat edible.

We do recite Shehechiyanu on cooked fruit.

Note: Post-shemitah fruit coming from Israel may require proper tithing. Shemitah fruit has rules of its own. Please consult Rabbi Korobkin for detailed information.

Why didn't Bnei Yisrael sing at the first Seder night? What inspires everyone to sing along with Moshe to say Az Yashir?

On Seder night, the fifteenth of Nissan, Bnei Yisrael are eating their Korban Pesach but they are not yet free. While they are having their Seder the tenth plague, Makat Bechorot, the Plague of the Firstborns is going on. They are still in Egypt.

Not only that, but they are still afraid of Pharaoh and the Egyptians. When they see Pharaoh and his chariots pursuing them they cry out to G-d, asking why did he take them out of Egypt to die in the desert? Are there not enough graves in Egypt? (Shemot 13:10-12)

Until Bnei Yisrael witnessed G-d directly quashing Pharaoh and his armies by Kriyat Yam Suf, the Splitting of the Sea, they could not truly shake the fear they had of the Egyptians.

Sometimes there are barriers we aren't even conscious of that are holding us back from truly singing and giving thanks to G-d. While we may not always have an epiphany as Bnei Yisrael did at Yam Suf, we can relive our ancestors' experience and sing along with them.





Adam S. Ferziger is professor in the Israel and Golda Koschitzky Department of Jewish History and Contemporary Jewry at Bar-Ilan University and holds the Rabbi S.R. Hirsch Chair for Research on the Torah and Derekh Erez Movement. He is a senior associate at the Oxford Centre for Hebrew and Jewish Studies, University of Oxford and co-convener of the annual Oxford Summer Institute on Modern and Contemporary Judaism. His research focuses on the history of religious responses to modern and contemporary life in Western Europe, North American, and Israel.

He is the author or editor of seven books, including Exclusion and Hierarchy (University of Pennsylvania Press, 2005), Jewish Denominations (Melton Institute – The Hebrew University of Jerusalem, 2012), and his monograph, Beyond Sectarianism (Wayne State University Press, 2015), was the winner of the National Jewish Book Award.

Raised in Riverdale, New York, he is a graduate of SAR, Ramaz, YU (BA, MA, Semihah) and Barllan (Ph. D). He and his wife Dr. Naomi Ferziger have lived in Israel since 1987, where they brought up their children and are now proud grandparents. In parallel to his academic career, Adam Ferziger was a congregational rabbi in Kfar-Sava, and has dedicated over thirty years to performing weddings and providing religious services to a wide spectrum of Israeli Jews in a meaningful and nonjudgmental manner. In June 2022, he and his wife returned to Jerusalem.


