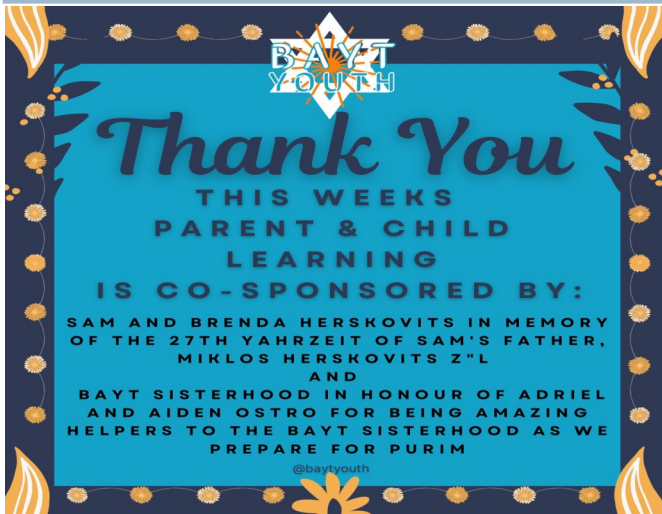



May I feed wild birds on Shabbat Shirah (February 4th)?

There is an old custom of leaving grain or bread for birds on Shabbat Shirah, the Shabbat when we read Parshat B'shalach in shul. The custom is linked to the parshah; some suggest it is a reward for the birds' song of praise for Hashem at the Sea, while others link it to a midrash that birds thwarted Datan and Aviram by eating decoy manna they had scattered on Shabbat.

Some modify this custom, insisting that the birdfood be left out before Shabbat. This is because the sages forbid feeding wild animals on Shabbat, due to the strain involved. On Shabbat, one may only feed animals which depend on us for food.

Other authorities defend the practice of putting out food on Shabbat Shirah itself, arguing that there is no real strain involved in throwing small pieces of bread. They also note that some early authorities read the gemara to permit providing food for any creature if food is scarce – as it is in the winter. They also suggest that this is permitted because we are not really doing this in order to feed birds, but for the sake of our own custom. Finally, some suggest that because this is for a mitzvah-related purpose, that overrides the concern for strain.

D'VAR TORAH

How did Bnei Yisrael react to G-d's performing the Ten Plagues and punishing Egypt? G-d tells Moshe that he has hardened both Pharaoh and his servants' hearts in order to increase the miracles so that we can retell it to our children and grandchildren. (Shemot 10:1-2) But what emotions were Bnei Yisrael feeling at the time?

Honestly, we don't know precisely how the average Israelite felt, because Bnei Yisrael are silent during the plagues. Last we heard they complained about the increased workload (5:21), ultimately refusing to listen to Moshe's reassurances from G-d because of their 'shortness of spirit and the hard work.' (6:9) We know they are terrified before the Red Sea splits when Egypt is chasing them, when they say 'are there not enough graves in Egypt that you took us out to the desert to die? Didn't we tell you we'd rather be slaves than die in the desert?' (Shemot 14:10-12)

In the interim, Bnei Yisrael were likely afraid, hopeful, and nervous all at the same time. Regardless of how they felt, they followed G-d's commands such as Korban Pesach. (Shemot 12:28, 35, 50) Despite an uncertain future and internal turmoil, they observed G-d's will, proving their mettle and setting the stage for their children and grandchildren.

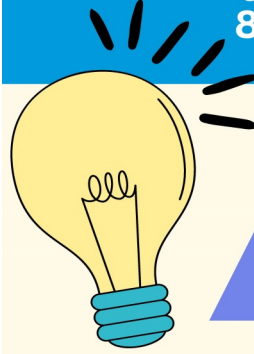
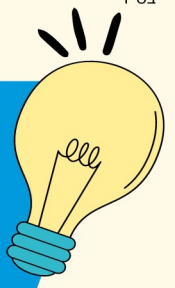

WITH RABBI PROFESSOR
ADAM FERZIGER



SHABBOS, FEBRUARY 17-18

Adam S. Ferziger is professor in the Israel and Golda Koschitzky Department of Jewish History and Contemporary Jewry at Bar-Ilan University and holds the Rabbi S.R. Hirsch Chair for Research on the Torah and Derekh Erez Movement. He is a senior associate at the Oxford Centre for Hebrew and Jewish Studies, University of Oxford and co-convenor of the annual Oxford Summer Institute on Modern and Contemporary Judaism. His research focuses on the history of religious responses to modern and contemporary life in Western Europe, North American, and Israel.

He is the author or editor of seven books, including *Exclusion and Hierarchy* (University of Pennsylvania Press, 2005), *Jewish Denominations* (Melton Institute – The Hebrew University of Jerusalem, 2012), and his monograph, *Beyond Sectarianism* (Wayne State University Press, 2015), was the winner of the National Jewish Book Award.

Raised in Riverdale, New York, he is a graduate of SAR, Ramaz, YU (BA, MA, Semihah) and Bar-Ilan (Ph. D). He and his wife Dr. Naomi Ferziger have lived in Israel since 1987, where they brought up their children and are now proud grandparents. In parallel to his academic career, Adam Ferziger was a congregational rabbi in Kfar-Sava, and has dedicated over thirty years to performing weddings and providing religious services to a wide spectrum of Israeli Jews in a meaningful and nonjudgmental manner. In June 2022, he and his wife returned to Jerusalem.
