# PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE—A VALUE OF LAND

A huge Yashar Koach to our members who completed and made a Siyum on masechet Kiddushin and Seder Nashim last Monday night. Thank you to Rabbi Leshner and Rabbi Rothbart maggidei Shiur of the BAYT Daf Yomi. On to the Bava's which will take just over a year. A very special Mazel Tov to Toby Berkel who joined Daf Yomi at Kiddushin and just completed his first masechet. I look forward to his siyum in 7 1/2 years. It's never too late to join and you actually may learn something.

Talking about learning, I wanted to inform those who are learning Tzurba M'Rabanan for the past three years, have just begun volume 16 (Hilchot Shabbat) have a great opportunity to listen to Rabbi Shalom Rosner who will be giving a podcast shiur reviewing the weekly Shabbat topic. The podcast series will be ongoing for about two years and is titled "Tzurba Hilchot Shabbat". Thank you to our former member Daniel Safran who does the design and typesetting for the Tzurba which is beautifully laid out and makes it easier to learn the Talmudic sources through modern day halachic applications.

Last week, we launched our first campaign where the funds we raised were to assist the moshav of Naveh. Not surprisingly, in 4 days we reached our goal of \$50,000 to provide mental health assistance for the children. Thank you to all who participated. The Sisterhood will be launching a fundraiser for Israel in the coming days.

Last week I was in London and was able to have dinner with my cousin Gideon Falter, the founder of Campaign Against Antisemitism, and catch up on the situation in the UK. Most of you are aware of the situation there before the War in Israel began (as he has spoken at the BAYT on several occasions), but Gideon described how the situation has dramatically heightened to another level since the massacre. Huge antisemitic rallies have been growing larger and larger each week. Last Saturday an estimated crowd of over 125,000 people rallied against Israel. While having dinner on October 31st, the protestors took over a major train station during rush hour with over 5,000 people, stopping commuters from traveling. The Jewish community in the UK has its hands full to say the least and clearly the mayor and police are not enforcing the laws.

Then I made my way to Zurich and was fortunate to have Shabbat dinner with the community Rabbi of Zurich, Noam Hertig and his family. It was great to hear all about the Jewish community, not only about what is currently going on in Zurich and Switzerland like trying to get an eruv up, Beit Din, Education and many other community challenges like Covid and government assistance for Shuls and schools. In Zurich last Thursday a pro Israel rally was held where approximately 1,500 people gathered in town all holding yellow umbrellas. It was quite the scene. An added bonus was to see our very own Charly and Nathalie Piwko. Charly lained on Shabbat too! I was fortunate to be sitting next to Jacques Lande in shul who is the ICZ President, responsible for the Rabbinat, Security, Culture and Library of the Zurich community. Jacques and I are paid the exact same salary, except his term is four years.

Disappointingly, the Main Sanctuary renovation will not proceed in January as the Capital Improvement Committee was unable to select and secure delivery of key raw materials like carpeting, tiling and fabric for the seats. It is unknown exactly when we will be able to proceed but as soon as they have more to report, I will let you know. The committee of David Lithwick, David Vodiano and Jack Feintuch worked so hard to try to get the project completed this year and I know it was not for a lack of effort that the timing is delayed. I am very grateful for their huge commitment. On a positive note, the Mikvah renovation continues to move beautifully forward. The extensive reno will take longer than expected, but almost all the materials are on site and completion is expected to be sometime in January.

The BAYT Chesed Committee is in need of men to visit men. A Bikkur Cholim what's app group has been created and I ask our male membership to sign up and find some spare time to help some men in our community who are in need of visitation.

Tuesday night the BAYT was the venue for a citywide Night of Tefilot to a capacity crowd that overflowed from the Perlis Hall into the lobby. Thanks to the Security volunteers and Shomrim for ensuring everyone's safety and security.

Security concerns across the globe remain high. Please remain vigilant and aware of your surroundings at all times. The BAYT's Safety and Security Committee will be implementing some additional measures to increase security over the next few weeks. For one, you will have to pull the parking lot door when your fob unlocks the mechanism - sorry no more hands free!

In recognition of Remembrance Day, on Shabbat, we will recite a special tefillah. The tefillah will be led by our very own Captain Rabbi Dr. Noteh Glogauer, Staff Officer to the Division Chaplain, 4th Canadian Division HQ/Joint Task Force (Central). Jewish Canadians joined the military in remarkable numbers, with more than 17,000 of them serving in uniform during WWII. An estimated 450 died serving Canada. Jews constituted 1.5% of Canada's population in 1940, but provided 2.6% of its aviators, 1.4% of its soldiers, and 0.7% of its sailors.

This Friday night, the first Leil Limmud begins. Please choose a speaker or location that inspires you to learn Torah together within our community.

Parent and Child learning begins this motzei Shabbat, one hour after havdallah. Great opportunity to spend quality time with your children and grandchildren.

Sunday, November 12 at Queen's Park there will be a rally where we will march for Israel, March to Free Hostages, and March Against Antisemitism. In Washington, DC on Tuesday November 14 we will march as well. You can take a bus from Or Chaim for \$120 pp including Bus and meals. You can fly. There is talk of a charter flight.

This week we will read Chayei Sarah and the story of Avraham paying a huge sum for Ma'arat Hamachpelah to bury his wife, our mother, Sarah. Avraham uses precise language and multiple key words to ensure that there will be no doubt about the validity of acquisition of this unique property which will be forever binding. Ephron and Bnei Cheit never really valued the land otherwise they would never have sold it. No different than Eretz Yisrael today. Only when Bnei Yisrael have worked the land, thrived in it, prospered in it and bring the intangible kedusha to it, does the world want to take back what is rightfully ours. They will never be able to make it blossom because it is the result of the holiness and the sanctity which the Jewish people bring to it, something that they could never achieve. Only the jealousy remains throughout the entire world which drives them to have such hatred of our people. That should bring comfort to us, as great a price as Hashem judges us to pay, buried deep in our souls, we know what we are really fighting for. Am Yisrael Chai.

# BEIT MIDRASH ZICHRON DOV

## INTRODUCTION TO THE LAWS OF SHEMA

### Latest Time for the Evening Shema

As we mentioned last week, the time for reading the evening Shema is dictated by when people sleep. According to the position of Raban Gamliel, this continues until the first lights of dawn (alot hashachar). In the Talmudic era, people started waking up at this time. However, people didn't wake up at the same instant. Rather, there was a range of time between dawn and sunrise (henetz hachamah) where some people were asleep and others were awake. Rabbi Shimon Bar Yochai held that because some people are still sleeping during this period, one can still recite the evening Shema. The basic halachah follows Raban Gamliel, but we rely on Rabbi Shimon's view in times of duress.

Therefore, if one is incapacitated and can't recite the Shema throughout the night until after dawn, one can still recite it until sunrise. Examples of incapacitation include illness, or being drunk. This leniency does not apply if someone intentionally incapacitated themselves. For example, if one started drinking shortly before dawn.

When reciting the Shema after dawn, one should recite the blessings for the Shema except for Hashkivenu and the following sections in the siddur. This is because Hashkivenu is a prayer for before going to sleep, and even though some people are still sleeping after dawn, no one is going to sleep at this time.

## D'VAR TORAH

Where was Yitzchak during the burial and mourning for his mother Sarah? Why didn't he react like Avraham?

Rabbeinu Bachya explains that surely Yitzchak cared deeply for his mother Sarah who lovingly doted upon him. Instead, Yitzchak likely wasn't even told about the death of Sarah at this point because of the fear that he wouldn't be able to handle the fact that Sarah had died after hearing the news of his Akeida, binding and almost being sacrificed to G-d. Rabbeinu Bachya also notes that Yitzchak has been missing since the return from the Akeida last week.

The Targum Yerushalmi explains that he was learning at Yeshivat Shem v'Ever immediately after the Akeidah for the next three years. But why wouldn't they tell him about his mother's passing?

There is another possibility: Yitzchak was present and heard about the death of Sarah, but took the loss so hard that he was unable to be involved in the burial or any other elements of the mourning process. Everyone mourns differently, and perhaps Yitzchak simply needed his time alone to process his feelings.

It appears that he is hit so hard by her death that he isn't comforted even three years later, and it takes Rivka's arrival to have him finally be comforted. Only then can Yitzchak finally return from the field from his bitter prayers and mourning.

Everyone reacts to grief and traumatic experiences differently and it is important to properly support the individual. Whether it be by being there for them or finding the right person or professional to aid them. May we know only happiness, and may our actions and reactions properly honour those who came before us.

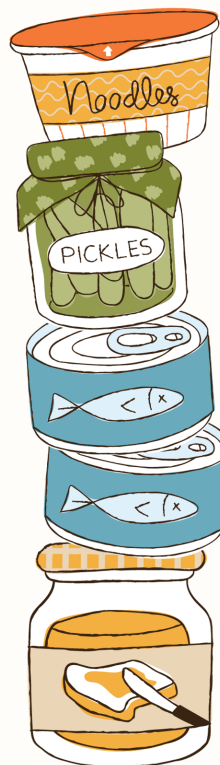
