Talmud Yerushalmi

It was an honour to participate last week at the Siyum Talmud Yerushalmi in Miami, held on the 84th anniversary of Kristallnacht. This Siyum coincided with the completion of the Hebrew and English versions of the Talmud Yerushalmi by Mesorah Heritage Foundation (Artscroll) and was graciously sponsored by the Schottenstein's as well as all the other visionaries who made this dream come true. This was a monumental achievement. The 11th cycle of this Daf Yomi began this week on the 20th of Cheshvan, November 14. You can complete the cycle in just over 4 years! The newly released Daf Yomi size Gemara and the digital version were released at the siyum. Berachos volume I and II are available for free download with the Artscroll app. There are wonderful resources available, including audio on the AllDaf.com app and DafYerushalmi.com to complement the Artscroll Yerushalmi.

Many excellent articles can be found on line for an in-depth background of the challenge to restore the Yerushalmi, but Hersey Zelcer's article published in Hakirah is an excellent start: https://hakirah.org/Vol%201%20Zelcer.pdf

The history of the Daf Yomi Yerushalmi began in 1980, at the Knessia Gedolah, where the Moetzes Gedolei HaTorah adopted the initiative of the Gerrer Rebbe, Rabbi Simcha Bunim Alter zt"l (known as the Lev Simcha) and instituted the Daf Yomi cycle of the Yerushalmi. Artscroll and its team of talmidei chachamim and many generous donors seized the opportunity to unlock this hidden treasure and make it available to every lew desiring its vast riches.

It was an honour to meet Rabbi Gedalia Zlotowitz, President of Artscroll and son of the renowned founder Rabbi Meir Zlotowitz zt"l. I invited him to the BAYT to be a scholar in residence in the near future. Please let me know if you would be interested in sponsoring this event, which I am sure would be momentous.

MESSAGE FROM A MEMBER

Part 2 - The Journey to Opatow Begins

The beginnings of Jewish settlement in Opatów date back to between the 14th to 16th century according to the Apter Yiskor Book published in 1966. From the second half of the 18th century, Opatów became an important center of Hasidism.

In 1939, Jews constituted more than half of the city's population - approx. 5,800 people. Over the first years of the war, Opatow grew to an estimated 8,000 Jews, growth that was driven by forced migrations.

On October 22, 1942, the Germans force marched an estimated 6,500 inhabitants of the previously established ghetto to the railway station in Jasice, from where they were transported to the Treblinka camp and murdered.

70 people, my father amongst them, were separated to be part of a work group responsible to empty the Opatow Ghetto of all possessions. 40 of the 70 were murdered in the Opatow Jewish Cemetery after completing their "cleanup" task. Those who remained were taken to a town called Sandomierz.

About 350 members of the Jewish community of Opatów survived the Holocaust. Unfortunately, some were murdered when they returned to Opatow, after the war.

Our day of experiencing the various journeys of our Opatow ancestors began on the morning of Sunday, October 23, 2022.

We started by visiting the Lyceum in Sandomierz where my father and about 30 people were taken after the "cleanup" of Opatow. From there they were assigned to a number of munition factories and agricultural plants that were controlled by "Managers" who had been brought in from Germany.

This was the first time that any Jews entered the Sandomeirz Lycium since it was used as a "worker dormitory" 80 years ago. Walking the halls of the school where my father was first held by the German Nazi's was very emotional.

Next, it was onto a train station in Jasice, where the Jews of Opatow were marched between October 20 and 22, 1942. By road, Jasice is 19 km from Opatow (BAYT to King Street Subway Station)

We organized ourselves in groups of 5 across, and began the 1 km walk from where the highway connected to the road to the Jasice train station.

The stone ramp where 19 of my relatives were marched to the cattle cars that took them their deaths in Treblinka, still exists, but it is now overgrown with weeds.

While waiting for the livestream to begin, so others in Israel, US, Canada and around the world could participate in this ceremony, we explored the tracks that lead to Treblinka. By rail, Treblinka is 247 km from Jasice (BAYT to Kingston Ontario)

We also explored the new Jasice commuter train platform, where at some point in the near future a plaque will be mounted that will tell the story of what happened at the Jasice train ramp 80 years ago.

Each of us were carrying carnations to which a ribbon was attached. Each ribbon had the names of our ancestors who were marched to Jasice and were murdered in Treblinka.

Instead of laying the carnation on the stone ramp, I attached the carnation to the tall standing weed, by wrapping the ribbon of commemoration around it. Many others on our trip did the same thing.

As we read out the names, I could not help but think of all of the 2nd, 3rd and 4th generations who are now named after relatives who

were taken to their deaths from this exact location.

I was honoured to recite Kel Maleh Rachamim for the entire group and then lead the recitation of Kasish for those who were sent to be murdered in Treblinka from the stone ramp in Jasice.

MESSAGE FROM A MEMBER

Part 3-80 Years Later in Opatow

The anniversary commemorations of the 80th anniversary of the liquidation of the Opatów Ghetto, to which we were invited to, were organized jointly by: the Society of Friends of the Opatówska Land (TPZO) and the City and Commune Office in Opatów

We arrived in Opatów at around 12:15 and had an hour to walk around on our own. We were not invited to join a mass at Opatów's St. Martin collegiate church which was dedicated to the Jews of Opatów who did not survive the forced deportation from the town.

After the mass concluded, the descendants of the Jews of Opatów, met a number of local residents at City Hall, where a multi-part ceremony was about to begin.

Opatów's mayor reminded all of he audience that during World War II, Jews constituted more than half of the city's population. He stressed that they died in the "tragic circumstances of extermination" and the only thing we can do today is to remember them and thus pay homage to

them.

Afterwards, the streets of Opatów were closed to allow a multifaith community to walk through the streets of the town. We passed two streets that were nicknamed by the Opatów Jewish Community as the Brighta Gass (Wide Street) and the Shmuleh Gass (Narrow Steet) and ended up at the site of the old Jewish Market.

Three plaques were mounted on the "Scale Building" of the old Jewish Market. They now serve as a permanent reminder of what happened there 80 years earlier. (See photograph)

We then walked to Park Miejski, the site of the Jewish Cemetery where not a single matzevah is standing today. The cemetery was destroyed during World War II, and the gravestones were looted by locals for construction and sometimes decoration of their homes.

In this place, where the market place was situated, on October 22nd 1942 (11 Cheshvan 5703), about 6,500 Jews from the Opatow Ghetto were assembled and taken on foot, by the German occupying forces, to the Jasice train station Those who stumbled on the way, were shot to death. The rest were transported to their death in the gas chambers of the german extermination camp Terblinka, May their memory be blessed.

In 2020, a project was initiated by Poland's Museum of the History of Polish Jews to collect the looted gravestones and return them to their original location.

Thanks to Global Warming, and the dropping of river levels across Europe, some fragments were discovered in the receding river. More fragments were discovered in other public spaces, while others were discovered with the tombstone writing facing away, making them harder to locate. The oldest fragments of Jewish tombstones found came from the beginning of the 17th century.

There is a small border around the 200 fragments separating the "Lapidarium" from the rest of he park. The townspeople of Opatów came to hear Krzysztof Nitkiewicz, the Bishop of Sandomierz, and Fr. prof. Miroslaw Wrobel, the director of the Catholic-Jewish Relations Center of the Catholic University of Lublin.

Susannah Heschel, the Great-Great grand-daughter of Rabbi Avraham Yehoshua Heschel, the Apter Rebbe (Ohev Yisroel), also attended the ceremony.

Sheldon Salcman, former President of Toronto's Shaarei Shomayim, brought earth from the Mount of Olives, which we took and spread throughout the "Lapidarium" so that we could answer, in some small way, the prayer of those buried in unmarked graves, "L'Shana Haba B'Yerushalayim.

We formed the first Mincha minyan in Opatów in 80 years so that Sheldon Salcman could say a Kaddish on the Yahtzeit of his father, a survivor of Opatów.

The day ended at a local restaurant where a Kosher dinner was catered in from Warsaw, and concluded with a Shlomo Karlbach concert for the Opatów community, lead by Symcha Heller and his band of musicians.

After a very special day, we left Opatów and headed to Lublin.

Although there was much more to experience in Poland, I and many on the trip, felt that the highlight of the trip was already achieved.

May I say Kiddush Levanah if I see the moon during the day?

The berachah of Kiddush Levanah celebrates the growth of the light of the moon in the first part of the month, associating it with our own national growth. Therefore, one should only recite Kiddush Levanah when the moon's light is prominent. This is after nightfall.

Some authorities allow Kiddush Levanah right after sunset, where one fears missing the opportunity for Kiddush Levanah by waiting. In particular, some are lenient if the moon's light is strong enough that it casts a visible shadow on the ground.

Why are there 67 verses devoted to the search for Yitzchak's wife and Yitzchak and Rivka's marriage, yet only 27 relating to Sarah and Avraham's deaths and burial?

Why is G-d only mentioned once in the context of Sarah's death and burial, by the non-lewish Hittite residents of Chevron, while He is mentioned over 20 times relating to Yitzchak and Rivka's marriage?

The Torah is showing us models of how to relate to the meaningful and weighty lifecycle events of death and marriage.

When someone passes away and his family members are in mourning it is exceedingly difficult if not impossible to see G-d because of the extreme sadness and emotions they are experiencing. In the first verse after Sarah's burial (24:1) "Avraham is blessed by G-d in everything" because only after the grieving process and its various stages do we have the opportunity to look back and appreciate all the travails and events that led to this point.

On the other hand, during the exciting, fast paced, (sometimes stressful) and rapidly developing period of dating and marriage there are times to turn to G-d for help and to acknowledge His aid. It doesn't always go smoothly, but there are points for reflection and comprehension.

By being mindful of these lessons we can hopefully greater appreciate G-d presence in our lives, in good times and challenging ones.


