FIRE DRILL RECAP

Almost 7 years in the making we found a suitable Shabbat along with ideal weather conditions to conduct a Fire Drill. The frequent insert of the Evacuation Plan and preparatory training of the Safety/Security Team volunteers kind of showed our hand that the drill was happening soon. Despite planning and coordination the Alarm sounded earlier than expected. This demonstrates that a Fire doesn't wait for us to plan, it happens!

The vast majority of those in attendance evacuated in record time - 6 minutes - but some ignored the alarm which in a real situation would have placed people in danger. Hence, 9 minutes to clear the entire building and for the volunteers to report their areas clear. 3rd Floor Youth leaders brought kids down exceptionally fast keeping them together holding onto skipping ropes (Great idea Leora Prutschi). Having conducted the drill and reviewing CCTV footage we are able to determine what worked and where improvements need to be made.

MIKVEH UPDATE

The Maddie Leventhal Mikveh Centre

Twenty-two years ago, the Maddie Leventhal Mikveh Centre was renovated and dedicated in the memory of the beloved Maddie Leventhal, by her family. Since that time, hundreds of women have used our mikveh each month assisted by our dedicated mikveh attendants, Mercedes Elmaleh, Deena Mammon, Simy Bitton, Denise Myerowitz and Laya Witty.



We are so excited to announce that our plans are finally coming to fruition and both the Maddie Leventhal Mikveh Centre and the keilim mikveh renovations will begin after Tisha B'Av. We are very grateful to our generous donors who have made this renovation possible and to Mikvah USA's partnership. Mikvah USA has included the Maddie Leventhal Mikveh Centre as one of the projects it will assist in funding and will oversee to ensure that the renovation goals will be met.

The Maddie Leventhal Mikveh Centre and the keilim mikveh will be closed from Monday July 31st when demolition will begin. We anticipate that the work will take 3 to 4 months to complete. We apologize for any inconvenience this work may cause but we will work diligently to minimize the time the mikveh is closed. The renovation has been planned so that all supplies required will be ready on hand to avoid any delays. The mikveh renovation committee has been working tirelessly, ensuring that every aspect of the mikveh renovation will meet the highest standards, both halachically and esthetically. Every function of the mikveh has been assessed and will be repaired or replaced. Mechanical, electrical, plumbing and design features have all been researched to ensure the running of the mikveh is cost-effective and efficient, for now and in the future. The most up to date and innovative water filtration and pump system designed and manufactured in Eretz Yisrael will be installed.

Thank you to our committee: Avital Sandler, David Vodianoi, Enny Herskowitz, Jessica Rosenberg and Zahava Yunger, to Craig Guttman for your guidance and Jesse Armogida for all your help. A special thank you to Sonya Kaplan who ensures the seamless administration of the mikveh.

May I wear new tzitzit or tefillin during the Three Weeks?

Between the 17th of Tammuz and Tishah b'Av we do not wear new clothing which would require a berachah of shehechiyanu, because of the joy involved. This includes wearing a new tallit; it also applies to wearing new tzitzit, if new tzitzit garments are uncommon and bring joy. One may purchase a new tallit without the strings attached, since it is not ready for wearing. One does not recite shehechiyanu.

Many authorities permit wearing new garments on Shabbat, until Rosh Chodesh Av; this would apply for tallit and tzitzit as well. Some specify not to recite shehechiyanu in such a case, even though it is Shabbat. One should follow communal custom.

New tefillin may be worn during this entire period. Most people do not recite shehechiyanu for tefillin. Even among those who do recite it, that is because of joy in the mitzvah, which is always permitted. The kind of shechechiyanu we avoid is the one recited because of the joy of wearing new clothing.

Why does Balak King of Moav hire Bilam to curse Bnei Yisrael? Why aren't we allowed to marry Moabite men?

Moav sees Bnei Yisrael conquer the giants of Sichon and Og and therefore tremble in fear. (Bamidbar 22:2-3) These are normal reactions that could justifiably lead the war. The words at the end of verse 3 "Vayakatz Mipnei Bnei Yisrael", "were disgusted because of Bnei Yisrael." Rashi says this is the exact same usage as when Rivka said in Parshat Toldot "Katzti Bichayay", "I'm disgusted with my life." Rivka's comment was in response to the immoral actions of the native Canaanites and how she didn't want Yaakov to marry them.

What precisely disgusted Moav then?

They were disgusted by Bnei Yisrael's morality and monotheistic practices, their steadfastly following G-d.

Their response was to curse Israel through Bilam, showing they had no desire to change themselves, they only sought to ruin Israel. In fact the Midrash explains that Moav already knew that Bnei Yisrael had no intentions of attacking them. Because of these callous and destructive actions of Moav, we are told it to marry their men much like Rivka had advised Yaakov.

Our reaction to seeing others excellence must be to see how we can rise to their level, not how to knock them down.


