Women's Mikveh:

Back in February, Lisa Berman and Sonya Kaplan, approached our Rav to see if the BAYT Fundraising would be interested in doing a Mikveh Campaign. We had a meeting to discuss how we could raise the funds to renovate the Maddie Leventhal Mikveh led by the generosity of a group of donors.

The Fundraising Committee has many things on its plate, including the Binyan HaBAYT campaign which launches next week before the annual membership drive, but the mikveh is an incredibly important project which is such a vital part of our community. Furthermore, Maddie, z"l, meant so much to our community including our family. Maddie was to deliver our fifth child, Max, but Maddie tragically passed a few weeks before. My father passed away a few days after Maddie, so I did not have the opportunity to visit the shiva house. So the Maddie Leventhal Mikveh has a very personal meaning to me as I'm sure it does to many inside the BAYT and the greater Toronto community.

The one day mikveh matching campaign will be launched in honour of Tu b'Av (how fitting) and we hope to secure the funds to renovate the BAYT mikveh so women can truly experience an environment that will be spiritually uplifting, as it should be. We are extremely fortunate to have donors who have stepped up for us to match up to \$100,000. We hope to raise \$300,000.

We are very excited to have our project led by our co-chairs Alla Volfson and Shari Vodiano and committee members Ashley and Lisa Berman, David and Sonya Kaplan, Avi and Rena Deutsch, Michelle Otis, Judy Cohen, Lindsay Salmon and we hope that more people will step forward to assist with this wonderful meaningful project for our community.

We also have the full support of the Rabbi's and Rebbetzin's of the many surrounding shuls who will be helping us with this very important community project. Many people outside of our community make use of our mikveh and it is gratifying to know that they will be assisting us with our fundraiser.

It will be exciting to revitalize the Mikvah hopefully in time for Maddie's 25th yahrzeit early next year.

Why specifically is the test for worthiness of Aharon and his sons done with a Match, a Staff?

Rabbi Shimshon Raphael Hirsch points out that Match מטה doesn't only mean staff, it can also mean tribe. Every single tribe branches out from a common stem, so Match is the best word and item for the test.

Each tribe inherited and transmitted to its members some characteristic specialty within the common character of the nation. Each formed a special Beit Av, character of household, within the nation, Bnei Yisrael. Each unique characteristic is represented by a staff. The test determines whether each is entirely equal, or whether each is unique and one tribe, in particular, is fit to be chosen.

R' Hirsch says that all of the Matot, the staffs and the tribes, placement before G-d to decide shows it is not a personal issue, but a question for the betterment of the collective. The choice of speedy flowering, budding, and ripening of the Shaked, almond, is no accident as the Leviim were chosen for their quick and decisive actions in responding to Moshe's call 'מי לה' אלי, who is for G-d, be with me' after the sin of the Golden Calf.

Why does Moshe send spies to the city of Yazer? Weren't spies the cause of 40 years of wandering in the desert?

Rashi explains that these spies were different; they committed themselves to not behave like the previous ones. They believed in the strength of Moshe's prayers to support them in battle. And they actually single-handedly conquered Yazer.

When the ten wicked spies saw the giants living in the land of Israel, the spies viewed themselves as but grasshoppers and therefore were the grasshoppers in the eyes of the giants (Bamidbar 13:33). The spies mission this week comes between the battles against two giants: Sichon and Og. They rely upon G-d and believe in themselves, and actualize their potential, defeating Yazer as if it was just a grasshopper.

Each of us has the ability to turn our dreams into reality. Living in the land of Israel is just a few steps away, we just need to appreciate our capabilities and make that plan come to fruition.

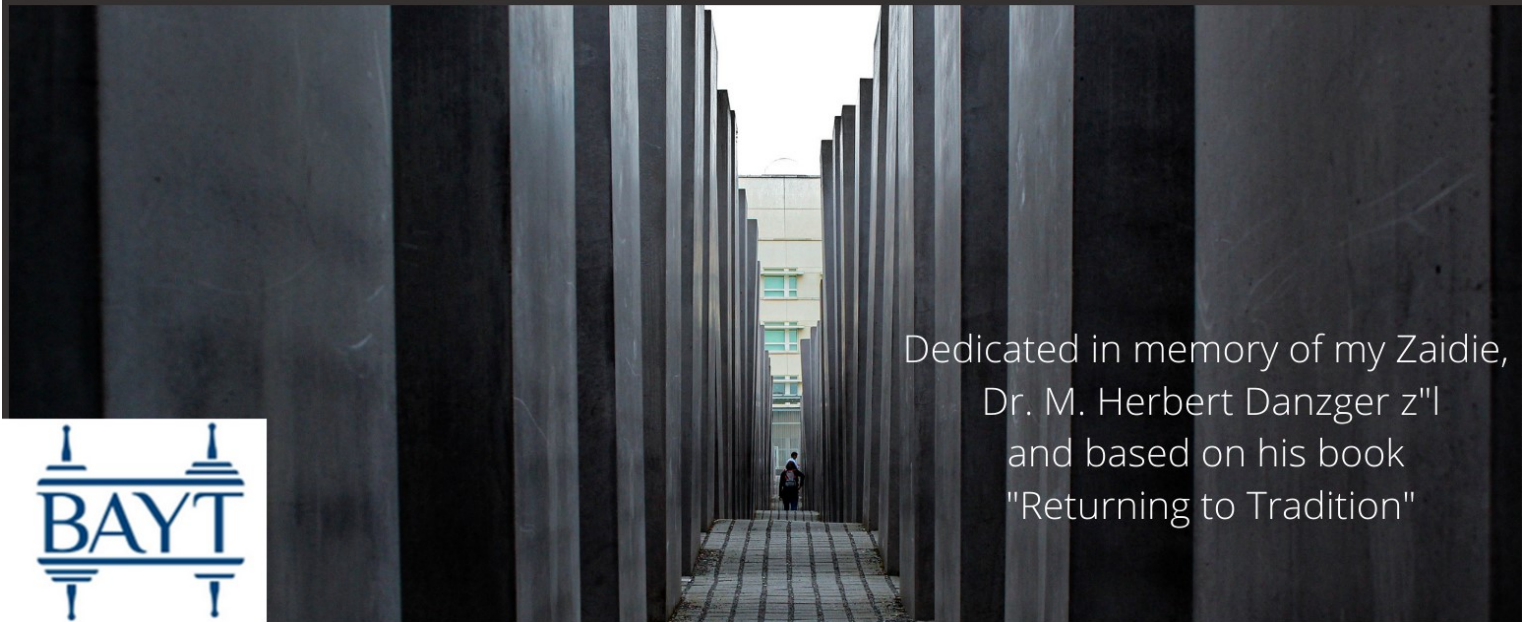

rabbi emeritus in 2014. Author of "Evolution of An Unorthodox Rabbi" (2015), Rabbi
Moscovitz has written for a number of publications. He is now writing a memoir of his
leftist days in which Tom Hayden, among others, figures prominently.
