• The Tattooed Torah (Animated film. Suitable for younger children & all ages) (English)

True story of a young boy from Brno, Czechoslovakia who was taken with his grandfather and other Jews from his home by the Nazis and given the job of putting numbers on the many Torahs that the Nazis had confiscated. As an adult he spent many years later searching for the small Torah from his synagogue.

Inside Hana's Suitcase (suitable for children & adults) (English & Japanese)

A class in Japan learns about the Holocaust through a suitcase sent to them from Auschwitz belonging to Hana Brady. There is also a discussion with her brother who survived the Holocaust.. Based on the book.

Nicky's Family (suitable for children & adults) (English) Documentary

Sir Nicholas Winton saved many Jewish children in Czechoslovakia by giving them false id and bringing them to England.

Witness Theatre (suitable for older children & adults) Documentary

Teens meet with Holocaust survivors over a number of weeks. They get to know each other. The teens make a play using the experiences of the survivors as the basis of their skits. The survivors are involved as well, being the narrators of the stories

Prosecuting Evil: The Extraordinary World of Ben Ferencz Documentary (English)

Ben Ferencz was the youngest prosecutor at the Nuremberg Trials. He talks about hisexperiences.

Holy Silence (English) Documentary

It's an exploration of the Vatican's reaction to the Nazi takeover of Italy and the deportation of thou sands of lews from Rome.

Chichinette: The Accidental Spy (English & French) Documentary

Marthe Cohn was 96 when this film was made. She lived in France near the German border and was fluent in both French and German. She helped refugees from Germany who came to France and was a spy for the allies in Germany.

The Night of Broken Glass (English) Documentary

Film footage and interviews about Kristallnacht

May I recite Tehillim on Tisha b'Av for people who are ill?

We are not allowed to learn Torah on Tisha b'Av, because Torah study is associated with joy. Only texts which are associated with misery and mourning, like Eichah and lyov, may be learned, and even then not in a joyous way. However, we are permitted to recite passages from Tanach as part of our normal davening, because davening is not viewed as an act of Torah study. Also, one who wishes to recite Tehillim for a person who is dangerously ill may do so at any time.

Regarding non-urgent needs, including reciting Tehillim as part of a daily Tehillim schedule, some authorities recommend waiting until after midday, or even until the next day. This is because Tehillim includes joyous passages, and because there is an element of Torah study every time we read a biblical sentence, regardless of the purpose.

What is the meaning of the word Eichah? How can there be so many ways of reading it?

In the simple sense of the word, it means how. But the emotions and context in which the word is read change everything.

In Midrash Eichah Rabbah (1,1) the understanding of Eichah changes yet again. Rabbi Yehudah explains Eichah as rebuke, citing shortly before the destruction of the First Beit HaMikdash when Yirmiyahu (Yirmiyahu 8: 8-9) chastises Israel, "How can you say 'we are wise and the Torah of G-d is with us' when you commit falsehoods and write forgeries?" Rabbi Nehemiah interprets Eichah as the manner of Kinah, lamentation. His proof text isn't Eichah itself, rather in Parshat Breishit (3:9) when "G-d calls out to Adam, Ayekah, where are you?" And Rabbi Nehemiah interprets it as Oy Lecha, woe unto you.

This week we read the word Eichah, how, whether it be in our parsha Devarim (1:12) asking "Eicha, how can I alone beat your loads, burdens, and strife", our Haftarah for Shabbat Chazon (Yeshayahu 1:21) "Eichah, how has the faithful city become a harlot" and begin Megillat Eichah on Tisha Biav "Eichah, How she sits alone." Which emotions and feelings we say it with will determine the nature of the week, 'how' we relate to the destruction of the Beit Hamikdash.




