If I eat an appetizer before washing for bread, should I say a separate berachah acharonah (after-blessing) for the appetizer before washing? (Part 2)

Last week, we said that food eaten before a bread meal normally requires its own berachah acharonah. However, we said it does not require its own berachah acharonah if the berachah recited before eating the pre-meal food also covers food eaten during the meal. This can happen if one eats fruit before a meal. Fruit eaten during a bread meal, but not actually with bread, requires its own borei pri ha'eitz. So if one recites borei pri ha'eitz on fruit before a meal, planning to have some during the meal itself, then the pre-meal snack is considered part of the meal and it is all covered by birkat hamazon.

We also said that food eaten before a bread meal does not require its own berachah acharonah if the food is halachically part of the meal. This happens with meals on Shabbat, if one eats a course between kiddush and netilat yadayim. Since kiddush must be recited with a meal, everything consumed after kiddush is considered part of the same meal. Therefore, one does not recite a berachah acharonah on a course eaten before washing for hamotzi.

Zion says to start our Haftarah that "G-d has abandoned me, G-d has forgotten me" (Yeshayahu 49:14). How can Zion, representing Israel, say that? Doesn't she know about reward and punishment?

The second paragraph of Shma, Vihaya Im ShaMoa, which is in our Parshah, Eikev, lays out how our success or failure is tied to our observance of G-d's commandments. Doesn't Zion realize her sins are the cause of the destruction which she laments?

Bnei Yisrael feel destitute. G-d has seemingly turned his back on them.

The Beit HaMikdash lies in ruins and they are exiled to far away lands. How could they not feel abandoned and forgotten?

Bnei Yisrael may or may not not intellectually understand reward and punishment, but first their emotional reaction must be addressed.

G-d explains through Yeshayahu that our punishment comes out of G-d's love for us, like a parent for a child. Once we recognize that G-d truly loves us, then we can be comforted and begin to return to Him.






