INTRODUCTION TO THE LAWS OF SHEMA BY

Where Does the Torah Command Us to Read the Shema?

The first paragraph of the Shema includes this sequence: We are commanded to love G-d. Then we are told that certain things we were commanded should be in our hearts. Finally, we are told to talk about those things constantly, tie them to our arms, and attach them to our doorposts.

The Sages understood that the later steps enable the earlier ones. In order to love God, we must have particular things in our hearts all the time. In order to accomplish this, we must take the other recommended actions.

Where in this sequence are we commanded to recite the Shema? According to one view in the Talmud, we aren't. There is no biblical commandment. We accept the view that there is a biblical commandment based on the requirement to talk about the "things". Reciting the Shema fulfills this requirement.

Which "things" is the Torah referring to? The plain interpretation seems to be all the mitzvot. We are required to review all the mitzvot constantly. This enables them to enter our consciousness and brings us to love God. Reciting all the mitzvot twice a day is impractical. Therefore, we recite the paragraphs of the Shema that encapsulate the basics tenets of Judaism. They include the existence of God, His unity, and a general reminder about the other mitzvot.

Why did G-d take Bnei Yisrael out of the eternally fertile and garden of Egypt with its powerful river and easily irrigated fields and bring them to Israel which is so beholden to rain?

Israel is "a land a which Hashem your G-d cares for. The eyes of Hashem your G-d are always on it, from the beginning of the year even to the end of the year" (Devarim 11:12). But what is the benefit in a land that is always watching?

If we solely desired financial stability Egypt would have been the place to live and stay. The goal of living in Israel, under G-d's observation, shifts towards connecting with G-d. We don't simply take what we need and move on, we maintain an ongoing relationship with G-d.

Relationships have their ups and downs and come with responsibility and consequences, as we see in the second paragraph of Shma. Ultimately, building that rapport is an inseparable part of what it means to be the nation of G-d. We cannot and will not give up on our relationships, with G-d, our land, and our nation no matter how much greener the grass looks on the other side.







Rabbi Dr. Sholom Gold was a native of Williamsburg, NY, where he attended Yeshiva Torah Vodaath. He continued his learning at Yeshivas Ner Yisroel in Baltimore and at the Ponevezh Yeshiva and Chevron Yeshiva in Israel. He received his rabbinic ordination from Chief Rabbi Isaac Halevy Herzog and from HaRav Yaacov Yitzchak Ruderman, in addition to receiving a doctorate in Talmudic Letters from Ner Yisroel. In 1959 Rabbi Gold founded the Ner Yisroel Yeshiva College and Congregation B'nai Torah in Toronto. In 1971, he accepted the position as spiritual leader of Young Israel of West Hempstead. He built one of the first eruvim in North America, which quickly became a model for communities worldwide. In 1982 the Golds fulfilled their dream of making aliyah, where Rabbi Gold was the founder and Rav of Kehilat Zichron Yosef of Har Nof, Jerusalem, and founder and dean of the Avrom Silver Jerusalem College for Adults. His memoir, *Touching History*, is a modern classic in the history of 20th century Jewish America.
