V'Yomer, Emor, V'Amarta

Esther and I arrived in Eretz Yisrael a week ago Friday morning and spent Shabbat with my brother Avraham and his wife Reva in Yerushalayim Ir HaKodesh. There is no escaping BAYT members. On Shabbat morning, we walked into shul at Nitzanim in Baka and in the back row, sitting by himself with a Gemara open learning Menachot, was our very own Manfred Leventhal. Manfred, his children and the rest of the mishpacha had just commemorated Maddie's 25th yahrzeit two days earlier. It was great to wish him in person that Maddie's neshama should have an aliyah and bring him up to date on how we are progressing with the mikvah renovation. And we are close to making a formal announcement. Lisa Berman and David Lithwick are finalizing key details.

A week ago Sunday, on the 3rd of Iyyar, was my father's 25th yahrzeit. Menachem Mendel ben Shmuel z"l was a founding member of the BAYT and a Holocaust survivor. It is eerie to commemorate his yahrzeit in Israel knowing two days later is Israel's 75th Anniversary. But of course, before the celebration, we mourned our brave soldiers (fathers, mothers, brothers, sisters, and on) and terror victims on Yom Hazikaron, when we went to Binyanei Ha'uma for the World Zionist Organization's tekes. It was an incredibly powerful event. At times, I felt like I was gasping for air, and wondered when the feeling would be over. I needed oxygen.

The pain was so intense and tears kept coming. It would be impossible for me to convey the feeling in the auditorium, but the event started with Rabbi Leo Dee whose two daughters, Rina and Maia, and his wife, Lucy, were brutally murdered two weeks prior. He talked about his interview with CNN during shiva condemning the news network for calling the terrorist attack a cycle of violence. He challenged them wondering how three innocent people driving on a road and having gun fire upon them forcing them off the road can be characterized as a "cycle of violence". But that was not enough, so the murderers had to circle back turning the car around and ensuring the women's demise. "CNN are the terrorist network", he said. Racheli Fraenkel followed. The painful story of OUR three boys, reliving it all over again. How the parents decided almost from the moment they learned of the kidnapping at three in the morning that they were going to rally the entire country which quickly became a world event until they found the boys murdered.

And then there was Yossi Ron. Yossi was orphaned when both his parents were murdered in the famous battle of Kfar Etzion on May 13th, 1948, the 4th of Iyyar. After the tekes, he led maariv for their yahrzeits. After the tefillah, I gave him a warm hug, wishing his parents' neshamas should have an aliyah. It felt so inadequate. Then there was Reena Meir who at the age of seventeen witnessed the murder of her mother Dafna. Dafna bravely held the knife the terrorist had plunged into her belly in place, preventing the terrorist from removing it and trying to do harm to her five children in the house. It took a year for Reena to return to society. Then there was the One Family's shidduch of Ayelet Dikstein and Aviatar Gavish. Seventeen years earlier, in two separate terror attacks, they each witnessed the murders of their parents and siblings. They first met at One Family's orphans division and have known each other for many years, attending workshops, seminars and meetings. Both overcame huge challenges and chose to focus on life and not dwell in sadness. Then, the mother of Eli Kay, 26, killed in a terror attack in Jerusalem on November 21, 2021, spoke beautifully. And unfortunately more. Many many more tragedies were told. An evening never to forget.

The next morning, we went to Har Herzl and our group was taken to the Dakar monument (Israel's Dakar submarine was sailing from Britain to Haifa and disappeared on January 25, 1968 carrying 69 sailors. In May 1999, the Dakar was found. It lies undisturbed 9,500 feet beneath the Mediterranean Sea between Crete and Cyprus.) for the 11 o'clock sirens which bring the country to a complete silent standstill for an emotional two minutes in memory of the men and women who have been killed defending the land of Israel. At the exact precise moment of the end of two minutes, four Israeli fighter jets roared over the mountain of Herzl, one separating, commemorating our lost soldiers. The lone soldier formation, never to be forgotten.

In the afternoon, we visited with Malki Natanel, the mother of Yonaton (26) z"l who tragically was killed in Gaza in 2009 by friendly tank fire. Yonaton had become a father a month earlier. As Malki told us about Yonaton and shared the family albums, I came across a letter written by the Natanel family to the four soldiers who were in the tank that tragic day. I share it with you today. Thank you to Charly Piwko for his accurate translation.
A Letter to the Tank Crew

Yoni's father Amos (is writing) in the name of Yoni's mother, Yoni's wife Ziona and their daughter Mayan; as well as in the names of Yitzchak, Sheri and David – Yoni's siblings
To the crew.... to the platoon....and to the regiment....

Those who make days like nights out of bravery and devotion for the people and the land:
We know that our son יוני fell during a fierce fire campaign of our forces and we felt a deep inner need to tell you all, from the bottom of our hearts, that we love and hug you tightly. Being hit by the fire of our own forces is an inseparable part of all of Israel's wars and our ability to defeat the enemy on the battlefield, and with that in mind, Yoni went to this war, and we as parents sent him to these battles. You didn't hit Yoni! Yoni died on קידוש ה' at the time when heaven destined him to live on earth while you were his pure angels to carry out this mission.



PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

It is comforting for us to know that your pure hands hit him and not the impure hands of the enemy - the wicked of the earth - because no impure hand could defeat Yoni. It is important for us to tell you that we love you with all the warmth of our heart; you are like our children and many children who are in the middle of battles.

We ask you to please carry on the same spirit that Yoni had, a spirit of faith, bravery, courage, and love and that's how we will know that Yoni continues to live among you...

Our last request, please come to us during the battles so that we can hug you tightly and tell you how much we love you. We pray for you strongly, Amos, Malki, Ziona and Mayan; Yitzchak, Sheri and Davi.

A few hours later, we are dancing with Shlomo Katz in Gan Hapa'amon for tefillat Maariv (many more BAYT members and their children), and then onto Sultan's Pool where the IDF's choir, some originals of the Miami Boys Choir and their children and Ishay Ribo performed for Yom Ha'azmaut. Just like on Pesach when we eat the bread of affliction and the bitter herbs and recount the extreme hard labour of Pharaoh, we rise up as a free nation in control of our own destiny eating bread, barbecuing, celebrating all that Hashem has granted us knowing that the Jewish people for thousands of years continue to rise up. While we do not understand much in this world, we know that Hashem always walks with us.

The next two days, we attended Mizrahi's World Orthodox Israel Congress. We were blessed to hear Ministers of the government, many important leaders of the Jewish world today, like Rabbi Hershel Schechter, Rabbi JJ Schacter, Rabbi Doron Perez, Rav Yosef Zvi Rimon, Chief Rabbi David Lau, Rabbi Carmel, Natan Sharansky, Rabbanit Shani Taragin, Rabbanit Rachelle Fraenkel, Miriam Peretz and many many more. So many words of Torah and chizuk. Even though we left the conference extremely exhausted by the long fourteen hour day, we were energized. We just needed some sleep.

This week's parsha has the triple lashon of conveyance, Hashem said to Moshe, v'yomer, and emor, to say to the Kohanim and v'amarta, to tell them. Esther and I were blessed to hear the cries of Yom Ha'zikaron, the cheering of Yom Ha'azmaut and an extraordinary amount of divrei Torah in our Holy Land.

Lucy Dee, was also an organ donor. On Tuesday, her remaining two daughters heard their mother's heart beating in the chest of the woman their mother has just saved. No matter how dark the situation, no matter how much evil there is in the world, the light of goodness will always prevail.

Over the thousands of years and in particular the past seventy-five years we have experienced much pain, but we have so much to be grateful for as we experience the beginning of the Redemption, may it come speedily in our days. Never lose hope. Never give up. Just keep pushing forward and try to spread as much light as you can.



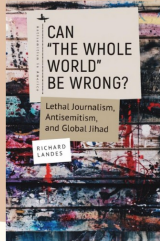

EVACUATION PROCEDURE FOR SHABBAT/YOM TOVIM



Reasons for Evacuations could be -

- Fire
- Power Outage
- Moving People to Safety

Although we would ideally want to have "wardens" appointed to guide everyone out the building, unlike schools or offices where the core group is static our shul with the multitude of minyanim particularly on a Shabbat we are dealing with a fluid situation.

The evacuation model we are working with is as follows

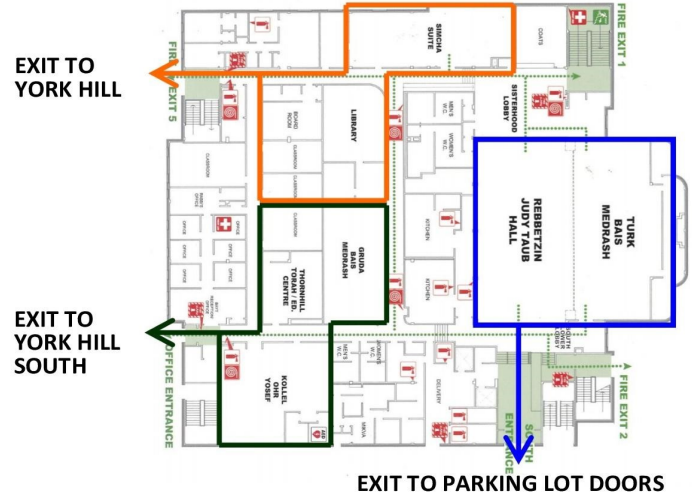
Everyone's cooperation is necessary to Evacuate safely and speedily. Safety-Security Members are to take charge of the area they are in and guide persons out the area. Once an area is CLEAR the Safety-Security Members should proceed to exit the building and make sure that all others have done so as well. As the last persons exit the building advise the **Evacuation Leader** who will be standing by the island at the Parking Lot Entrance Doors

- When a **Fire Alarm** or **Instruction to Evacuate** is heard everyone should move quickly to the **nearest designated exit point** - do not run or push - proceed down/up the stairs to exit the building and then move to the **Safe Evacuation Areas** along the east side (601 Clark) and south side (Eitz Chaim) of the parking lot **DO NOT CONGREGATE IN FIRE LANE**
- DO NOT use Elevators
- DO NOT gather your belongings
- DO NOT try locate your children - the Youth Department will take care of children in designated Youth programs
- When a Fire Alarm is pulled ALL Exit doors unlock
- The first persons reaching a door leading to an exit should hold open the door and stand clear to speed the exit of those behind them until relieved by a Safety-Security Team Member
- Once Safety-Security Team members reach the door they should take over from the lead persons that were first at the door
- Once everyone has safely evacuated the area Safety-Security Team Members should report to the **Evacuation Leader** to indicate that the area they left is CLEAR
- Persons needing Assistance should move to the closest stairwell landing and remain there until assistance can be provided - advise the Safety-Security Team member who will report details to the **Evacuation Leader** to arrange for assistance
- Re-Entry to the building will be determined by the **Evacuation Leader** in consultation with the Authorities (Fire Department, Police etc)

UNLESS There is Smoke or Heat from a Fire, or you are advised otherwise by Security Team Leaders, the suggested exit routes that will reduce congestion are as follows

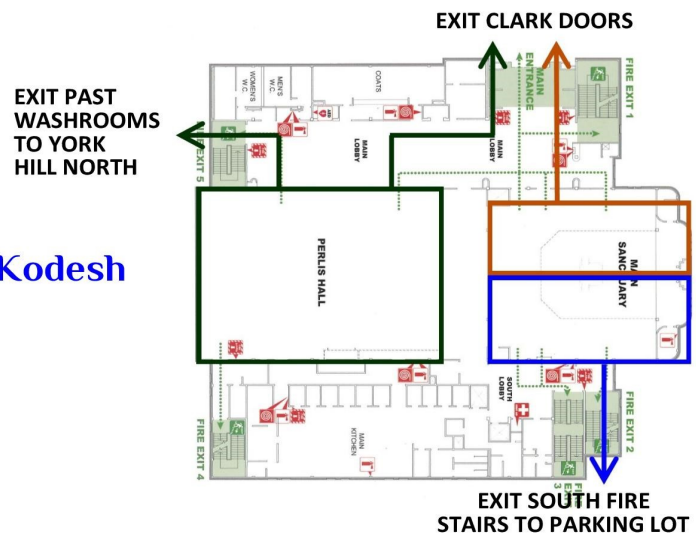
LOWER LEVEL

- **Rebbetzin Judy Taub Hall (RJTH) & Turk Bais Medrash** -- Right Hand Doors out through Parking Lot Entrance Lobby
- **Simcha Suite, Speisman Board Room, Classroom 6** - North-West corridor to Exit to York Hill
- **Milevsky/Kollel, Gruda Beis Medrash** - South-West corridor past Offices to Exit to York Hill



MAIN LEVEL

- **Main Sanctuary Men's Left of Aron Kodesh (North)** exit via Clark Entrance Doors
- **Main Sanctuary Men's Right of Aron Kodesh (South)** exit via Fire Stairs directly out to Parking Lot
- **Perlis Hall** - exit past washrooms down stairs to York Hill OR through Clark Entrance Doors



THIRD LEVEL

- **Main Sanctuary Women's Left of Aron Kodesh (North)** exit via North-East stairs out to Wedding Garden
- **Main Sanctuary Women's Right of Aron Kodesh (South)** exit via South-East stairs out to Wedding Garden
- **Youth Classrooms** - Exit via South West stairs out to York Hill

We need an eruv tavshilin this Shavuot to permit cooking on Friday for Shabbat. May I designate an eruv tavshilin in advance if it will remain edible until Yom Tov, or must I designate it on Erev Yom Tov?

The Talmud (Beitzah 15b) records a debate as to why we make an eruv tavshilin:
To ensure that there will be good food for both Shabbat and Yom Tov, lest Shabbat be forgotten in the rush to prepare for Yom Tov;
To ensure that people remember that they may not cook on Yom Tov for a mundane day.

Rabbeinu Asher (Rosh to Beitzah 2:1) says that according to the first view we need to prepare the eruv tavshilin on Erev Yom Tov, so that it will be fresh and good for Shabbat. But according to the second view, one could prepare the eruv tavshilin far in advance.

In practice, we prepare the eruv tavshilin on Erev Yom Tov, where this is at all possible. (Shulchan Aruch Orach Chaim 527:14)

D'VAR TORAH BY RABBI METZGER CMETZGER@TORONTOTORAH.COM

Why is the time period we are in, between Pesach and Shavuot, called the Omer? What is an Omer?

The Omer is called as such because it begins the day after the first day of Yom Tov of Pesach when we have the Mitzvah to bring a Korban Mincha, a barley offering made from an Omer of barley. The Omer is a volume measurement that is a tenth of an Eifah (Shemot 16:36).

The Sefer HaChinuch explains that the reason behind the commandment to bring an Omer offering is because we need to understand the great kindness G-d does for us every year when a new crop of grain is ready. We specifically bring the offering in the Beit Hamikdash and start counting on the second day of Pesach so we can thank G-d, understanding the great suffering we came from in Egypt.

It goes deeper than that. The first time an Omer is mentioned in the Torah is in the context of receiving the Manna. Each and every member of Israel received an equal portion consisting of one Omer from G-d.

As we count the Omer we thank G-d not only for our physical freedom, or prosperity independently, but we remember our connection to G-d and all he has done and will continue to do for us.

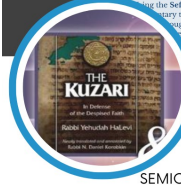
