# PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

#### Rosh Hashana Minyanim

We have heard a full spectrum of feedback about the minyanim set up for Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur. Let me take this opportunity to share the thought process about the five minyanim we have set up: Main Sanctuary, Hashkama (located in the Turk Bais Medrash), Milevsky Minyan, Perlis Hall and Tent.

We are thinking outside the box. Our goal is to raise the level of davening by trying new ideas. We ask that you be open to change. Try it, you actually may like it. And if you don't, we will be surveying the membership for feedback. I know we all love to daven where we have been, where we are comfortable. We are asking that you to try something new. We are trying to share all of the Ba'al Tefillah's where possible.

There are only so many excellent Ba'al Tefillah's and Ba'al Koreh's to go around. We want every minyan to have a strong flavour of tefillah and connecting with Hashem. The primary reason we needed to move the Hashkama Minyan to the Turk Beit Midrash is for more space. It is a popular minyan every week and on High Holy days. There was not enough room to accommodate this Hashkama minyan in any other space in the shul. This minyan will start at 7:00am, an hour earlier than the usual start in the Turk Bais Medrash. Any member accustomed to daven in the Turk Bais Medrash who does not want to start davening that early, can daven in any of the other four minyanim.

The tent has limited space. We are not adding another tent. When I first suggested we have tents this past Pesach, some people thought I had lost my mind. But I was listening to our membership. There were people who loved the experience of davening outside as much as it was for health concerns. I get that. I loved davening in my backyard during Covid. We bought the tents to accommodate our membership but we are absolutely limited to 160 people under the tent. I also want to remind everyone that Rosh Hashanah is late and the weather will most likely be very challenging. If the weather is nice, we will be able to add seats without cover.

The Milevsky Minyan is very small but accommodates 120 people. As of this writing, there is space. Grab them. The same great Shaliach Tziburs are rotating to all the minyanim where possible.

The Perlis Hall will start at 8:00am but the davening will be inspired by more song. Not over the top, but really beautiful singing is here again by our talented Ba'al Tefillahs.

And finally, the Main Sanctuary. We want to fill the entire Tanenbaum Main Sanctuary. All tefillah at all the minayanim will have proper decorum and we hope to raise our davening to a high level of Kedusha. If people want to socialize we have space for that too. Just not in shul, please.

This year for example of rotating Ba'al Tefillah's, the Rav will daven Neilah in the Perlis Hall while in the past the Rav has always davened in the Main Sanctuary. I personally have always loved hearing the Rav for Neilah. My first thought was disappointment as I will be in Main Sanctuary and then I thought, great idea. Why shouldn't our members hear the Rav for Neilah in the Perlis Hall? New idea.

I learned a long time ago, that while I love my Makom Kavuah (not where I sit now!), Hashem is with me wherever I daven.

#### Special Message about our Parking Lot

There has been a lot of chatter about the BAYT parking lot and Eitz Chaim. It should be very clear that we are completely amenable to Eitz Chaim using the BAYT parking lot for pick up and drop off. In fact, they will be using our lot for parking for their staff. However, given that there have been several close calls, certain safety measures had to be in place before the parking lot could be used for pick up and drop off this year. If you do not know me, my focus is always on safety. I run a manufacturing facility and I thank Hashem everyday that all my employees go home safe. I am not a knee jerk reactionist, but rather, I evaluate potential dangerous situations and execute a plan.

Historically, the BAYT has been fortunate with the lot, but eventually luck runs out. The point is that everyone can play Monday morning quarterback. The trick is to be better prepared on Sunday, so no one will have to play MMQ.

The BAYT and Eitz Chaim together laid out a plan to use the lot. In the end, Eitz Chaim felt that they could execute another plan for pick up and drop off. Eitz Chaim leadership knows that our lot is available should they require it. The understanding is that since school reopened everything went well with their plan.

The BAYT has received feedback that BAYT members who are also Eitz Chaim parents feel that they should be able to use the BAYT parking lot for drop off and pick up because they are members of the BAYT. In theory it sounds right and fair but the same danger has not been resolved, so the answer still has to be no. The parking lot is not safe for your children until safety measures are put in the place. The BAYT is here to help Eitz Chaim make that happen should they decide to use our space.

The safety of our children and grandchildren is the community's responsibility.

## **DIVREI TORAH & NOTICE BOARD**

Who is eligible to sit on a beit din for hatarat nedarim (the repealing of vows), which we usually perform before Rosh HaShanah?

The judges must be adult males who observe mitzvot. Normally the judges for hatarat nedarim should be well-versed in the laws of repealing vows, but for the ritual hatarat nedarim before Rosh HaShanah, and certainly where one does not recall making any particular vow, the popular practice is to accept judges who understand the basic concepts of hatarat nedarim. At least, the judges must understand that the person before them wishes to repeal a vow, out of regret for having made the vow at all.

The judges may be related to the person performing hatarat nedarim, but may not be married to that person. Some contend that the judges may not be related to each other.

#### Additional notes:

- 1. The person reciting hatarat nedarim must understand the words; saying the text in English is fine.
- 2. To repeal a specific vow, one must specify to at least one of the judges what the vow was. Some add that one must also explain the reason for the vow.
- 3. Normally, one may not act as an agent to do hatarat
- 4. nedarim for others. However, married women may assign their husbands to perform hatarat nedarim for them;
- 5. other women do hatarat nedarim themselves, and some just rely on Kol Nidrei.
- 6. The judges should be seated, while the person reciting
- 7. Hatarat nedarim stands. Hatarat nedarim may be done at night.

Why are we commanded to not charge interest to our fellow Jew, yet there is also a Mitzvah to charge interest to non-Jews? (Sefer HaChinuch Ki Tetzei Mitzvahs 572, 573) Isn't that discriminatory?

Financially it makes perfect sense to charge interest.

Someone is using your money, so just like they pay to rent your field or use your item it is entirely reasonable to charge for it. We are specifically commanded not to charge interest to our fellow Jew as a kindness, a Chesed, to our Jewish brethren.

The Sefer HaChinuch points out that the Mitzvah to charge interest to those who are not our brothers highlights just how unique and special the charity that we perform for our Jewish brothers and sisters is.

We often go above and beyond for family. The Mitzvah to not charge interest reminds us that every Jew is family.
