



# INTRODUCTION TO THE LAWS OF SHEMA BY

### Blessings of the Shema Part 1: Introduction

The Sages established a series of blessings that are recited before and after the Shema. In the morning, we recite two blessings before the Shema and one after. In the evening another blessing is added after the Shema.

These blessings are not recited over fulfilling the mitzvah as with other mitzvot like waving a lulav and blowing the shofar. Various halachot demonstrate this. One of them relates to reciting the Shema after its designated time. In order to fulfill the mitzvah, the Shema must be recited within the first three halachic hours of the day. However, the Mishnah states that if one reads the Shema after this, they miss out on the mitzvah of the Shema but still get the benefit of reciting the blessings. The halachah is that one can do this until the final time to pray, four hours into the day. This supports the notion that these blessings are not connected to fulfilling the mitzvah of the Shema.

What are these blessings for? Some argue that they extend the themes present in the Shema, emphasizing fundamental Jewish beliefs. Others suggest that they are part of the prayer service, similar to the Shemoneh Esrei. They are incorporated into the structure of the prayer service surrounding the Shema, but are not part of the mitzvah of the Shema itself.

Why are there four entire verses about having fair weights and measurements? Why do we need to be told not only that it is a Toevah, an abomination, but that upholding the standards allows us to remain in Israel?

The Ralbag (Rabbi Levi Ben Gershon of 14th century France) lays out that the purpose of proper weights and measures that are "shleimah viTzedek" complete and correct is to draw us towards the straight path and away from iniquity.

People often disdain counting and calculations as being secondary to the purpose of doing successful and brisk business. G-d commands us to not only care about the bottom line but how we get there. Discerning business acumen and competitive spirit are fine attributes to have, but there are lines that we must not cross. The Torah repeats the call for fair dealings precisely because of the allure of making money more easily. That is also precisely why we must be firm as possible to resist the pull of our pockets and make sure to strike the correct balance of ethics and fiscal responsibility.


### **Speakers**

Rabbi Menachem Gold and Rabbanim, Askanim, and friends of Rabbi Gold from his Ner Yisrael and Congregation Bnai Torah days



Rabbi Dr. Sholom Gold was a native of Williamsburg, NY, where he attended Yeshiva Torah Vodaath. He continued his learning at Yeshivas Ner Yisroel in Baltimore and at the Ponevezh Yeshiva and Chevron Yeshiva in Israel. He received his rabbinic ordination from Chief Rabbi Isaac Halevy Herzog and from HaRav Yaacov Yitzchak Ruderman, in addition to receiving a doctorate in Talmudic Letters from Ner Yisroel. In 1959 Rabbi Gold founded the Ner Yisroel Yeshiva College and Congregation B'nai Torah in Toronto. In 1971, he accepted the position as spiritual leader of Young Israel of West Hempstead. He built one of the first eruvin in North America, which quickly became a model for communities worldwide. In 1982 the Golds fulfilled their dream of making aliyah, where Rabbi Gold was the founder and Rav of Kehilat Zichron Yosef of Har Nof, Jerusalem, and founder and dean of the Avrom Silver Jerusalem College for Adults. His memoir, Touching History, is a modern classic in the history of 20th century Jewish America.
