If someone receives scholarship assistance for school tuition, are they obligated to give 10% of that amount to tzedakah?

We separate ten percent of our income and give it to the needy; this is the practice of "maaser kesafim". "Income" includes wages, gifts, government payments, dividends and returns on investment. However, discounts are not viewed as income. Therefore, one need not give 10% of a tuition discount to tzedakah.

One who receives money that is directed to be used only for tuition need not separate masser kesafim, if they are not free to use those funds for any other purpose. This includes government and private subsidies. The money was never truly the property of the beneficiary; it went from the donor directly to the school, and the beneficiary is only the conduit. However, one who is able to redirect the gift for other purposes is considered a recipient of a gift, and is required to give masser kesafim from that gift.

# D'VAR TORAH BY RABBI METZGER

What is so problematic about Bnei Yisrael's actions after the completion of the Golden Calf? From the simple sense of the text they woke up early to offer Olot (burnt offerings) and Shelamim (peace offerings) to G-d, what is wrong with that?

In the continuation of the verse (Shemot 32:6) they sit down to eat and drink before they get up and play. This seems innocuous until we hear the words of G-d two verses later (Shemot 32:8). G-d reveals their true intentions to Moshe that they have veered off the path delineated by G-d, choosing to bow and worship the Golden Calf, claiming that the calf is their god that took them out of Egypt.

Now when we reread the beginning of the chapter it is clear that Bnei Yisrael didn't get up early to serve G-d, rather they awoke to prepare idolatry. Their sacrifices were idolatrous, their eating and drinking gluttonous, and their playing incongruous.

Actions in the wrong direction, with misplaced focus, can be disastrous. We can rise early, but we need to do it on G-d's terms, not simply to play. We must ensure that our energies and zeal are directed towards the service of G-d, not simply to ourselves.
