When I put on a shul tallit for an aliyah, should I recite a berachah?

As a general rule, one only recites a berachah upon one's own tallit. However, halachic authorities assume that a shul acquires tallitot with intent to give them to individual members whenever necessary, and therefore a member who puts on such a tallit for use during davening does acquire it and should recite a berachah. Further, some contend that each member is automatically a partner in ownership of the shul's tallit.

Despite the above, some contend that putting on a tallit solely for the honour of the Torah (as in the case of an aliyah), without intent for the mitzvah of tzitzit, may not require a berachah. This is the position of Rabbi Korobkin.

One who is concerned that a shul tallit may not be kosher, but who is not able to check it, should put it on intending only to borrow it, and not recite a berachah.

Making Shabbat

When we begin Kiddush on Shabbat day, we begin with the words from this week's Parsha Vishamru Bnei Yisrael et HaShabbat Laasot et haShabbat Ledorotam Brit Olam – The Children of Israel and will guard Shabbat and make Shabbat for generations as an eternal covenant. (Shemot 31:16) But why are we told both to guard it Vishamru and to make it Laasot? Isn't it enough to observe Shabbat how do we make Shabbat?

Rabbeinu Bahya explains that we aren't just supposed to observe the laws of Shabbat by abstaining from prohibited actions but Laasot et haShabbat means to prepare in advance what is needed for Shabbat.

This depiction of Shabbat comes right after we finished reading all about the various parts of the Mishkan, when we had spent so much energy towards preparing the Mishkan. Now it is time for Shabbat and we need to not only enjoy Shabbat itself but properly ready ourselves to appreciate all that Shabbat has to offer.




