

# NOTICE BOARD

## PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE:

As soon as the slate was announced, several people approached me and said, "as soon as you're President, you will open the front doors" or "as soon as you're President, you will open the gate entrance on Clark". I think there's a real story to be told and I hope to address these two major sticking points with many of members.

Dana Prutschi, Chair of the Security Committee, has an excellent understanding of the Security issues and we reviewed the matter, in detail. Our membership has to buy into that security is of the highest priority for our members. Not empty words, but facts.

Security advisors from Federation have been adamant that the BAYT can only have ONE entry point for safety of our members and guests. Plain and simple. Personally, I do not like playing Monday morning quarterback. I have been involved with Health and Safety in a dangerous factory environment my entire life and have much experience in this matter. The security team is not waiting for an event to occur and then react. We all recently saw in Uvalde, Texas, what could happen if a door is left opened. It can be catastrophic.

Our main exit doors have to remain available to exit for emergency purposes but as you know they have been taped off. This has been for the safety of our members. The interlocking at the bottom of the stairs are not level and present a very real danger at the present time, should we have an emergency. That is why the board recently approved the budget of \$27,000 to repair the interlocking. The tape will be removed as soon as the landing is completed. Reopening the doors for entry is another issue and will remain closed for the time being because of security. (Even if we could open the front doors for EXIT ONLY, that would only be possible if we have 20 more volunteers step forward to assist with Security at the doors.)

The same is true for the gate on Clark. One access point. In an ideal situation, we should invest at least \$100,000 and have a beautiful perimeter gate to the entire property to create a layer of protection. It is well known that the better the perimeter is secured, the less likely an event will occur. But since we do not have the funds to do that, we have to do the best we can and that means we remain vigilant about one access for cars and people. The second and just as important issue is that we create the safest environment for the Eitz Chaim kids getting to school via our property in the safest manner possible. (We did have several close calls this year). It should be proudly known that as a friendly neighbour to Eitz Chaim who have requested to use our property for parking, drop off and pick up, elevates the risk of injury, G-d forbid, on the BAYT property. We are working on creative ways with Eitz Chaim to prevent harm to anyone. Obviously, the easiest way to eliminate harm would be to deny Eitz Chaim access to the BAYT lot, but that is NOT an option. So we keep one entry point open while we explore other possibilities with our Security Team and with Federation, and educate our stakeholders why there is only one entrance for cars and people.

On another security matter, people have been asking why the hours of the door being manned changed to start at 9am and not early morning davening. There are non members who can't get into the building for davening now, now that you need a fob to get into the building. True. Why the change? The answer to both questions is security. 9-12:30 is the time when many unknown people are in and around the building. Catering Traffic. Vendors. Clients. Potential Clients. Deliveries. Non Members.

We are searching for personnel to man the doors for early zmanim. Daytime is the priority.

I plan to discuss fob security in a future message. It's a story in itself.

**If I finish saying shemoneh esreih and someone directly behind me is not done, may I answer kedushah?**

One may not pass within seven feet in front of a person who is reciting shemoneh esreih, and so one may not step back. However, one who is up to "oseh shalom" may respond to kedushah and to all berachot; some even permit reciting Baruch Hu uBaruch Shmo. Indeed, some views even permit Torah study at this point, until the repetition of the amidah begins.

Some are lenient to allow stepping back in a case of need, if the person who is reciting shemoneh esreih is knowingly blocking an aisle.

(Shulchan Aruch Orach Chaim 122:1; Mishneh Berurah 122:4; Aruch haShulchan Orach Chaim 102:13; Tzitz Eliezer 9:8:2; Ishei Yisrael 32:20; and see Rivivot Ephraim 1:72)

## D'VAR TORAH BY RABBI METZGER

**Why specifically is the test for worthiness of Aharon and his sons done with a Mateh, a Staff?**

Rabbi Shimshon Raphael Hirsch points out that Mateh מטה doesn't only mean staff, it can also mean tribe. Every single tribe branches out from a common stem, so Mateh is the best word and item for the test.

Each tribe inherited and transmitted to its members some characteristic specialty within the common character of the nation. Each formed a special Beit Av, character of household, within the nation, Bnei Yisrael. Each unique characteristic is represented by a staff. The test determines whether each is entirely equal, or whether each is unique and one tribe, in particular, is fit to be chosen. R' Hirsch says that all of the Matot, the staffs and the tribes, placement before G-d to decide shows it is not a personal issue, but a question for the betterment of the collective. The choice of speedy flowering, budding, and ripening of the Shaked, almond, is no accident as the Leviim were chosen for their quick and decisive actions in responding to Moshe's call מִי לֵה' אֵלַי, who is for G-d, be with me' after the sin of the Golden Calf.


