Trust Your Leadership

June has certainly been an amazing month, with many smachot in the shul and around town. The other thing I have noticed is charities are returning to have dinners to honour key philanthropists for their endeavours. What has been most inspiring is seeing who in our community is involved in the amazing charities that provide assistance to our community and communities in Eretz Yisrael. A few weeks ago, Emunah held their annual dinner themed "Inspire" Family in Israel, honouring the new up and coming young women in our community.

Emunah supports such amazing causes in Israel like children's villages, counselling centres, interventional facilities and daycares, women and children's shelters, pet therapy, Birthday Room and much more. Our own Marissa Muscat is the National Director and other BAYT members sit on their board, like Elaine Genesove, Alina Mayer, Roberta Newman and Zippy Zwiebel, so a huge yishar koach for all you do.

And it was fascinating to hear them speak about the work they do once a year riding in the MDA ambulances saving lives in Israel. A week ago, CMDA hosted in our shul, "The First 7 Minutes" by Raphael Herbst a Senior Paramedic and it was very well attended. I heard our members really gained a lot from it and we hope to host another such event in the future.

I would like to take this opportunity to wish our permanent assistant gabbai for life, forever, never ever retiring even if he thinks so, Shloimie Romberg who is recuperating from running around finding people to daven every Shabbat. Refuah Shlema and hoping to see you back in shul soon.

Is it just me, maybe my age or is the music by bands and DJ's getting louder and louder? Don't get me wrong, there is a time for loud music, like at a Rush concert, but at wedding, bar mitzvah or sheva brachot? It seems to me that ear plugs should be handed out, or how about just lower the volume. It makes it virtually impossible to hear the person sitting right next to you and I cannot understand why this is done, especially when dinner is served. One thing seems to be clear to me, is that people are so happy to be back at smachot and fundraisers, but loud music prevents people from socializing and I think people want to socialize now more than ever. (My wife called me an "old fogey" for writing this.)

Last week, we kicked off our Binyan HaBAYT campaign for 5784 and it took three minutes for the first member to join! Thank you to those who have signed up already. While there is time to join, we ask that you join sooner than later. Thank for your support. General membership renewal will follow shortly.

We have been blessed this month with many amazing Scholars in Residence. A huge thank you to our Adult Education Chairs, Elaine Genesove (stepping down this week) and Mark Mietkiewicz. This coming Shabbat will be no different, except we will have three amazing speakers throughout Shabbat. Please plan your Shabbat accordingly.

A few thoughts on the fire drill we had this past Shabbat. It has been over ten years since we last had one. For many reasons, this is unacceptable. Fire drills should be held annually. When we had a medical event about eight weeks ago, it became glaringly obvious that we need to have a safety evacuation drill. There is never a "good" time to have a drill. It will inevitably disturb a minyan, given that we have seven or eight minyanim going on concurrently weekly, including in the middle of leining or Shemona Esrei, but pikuach nefesh takes precedence over all.

The primary focus of the drill is to see how fast we can evacuate the building, especially the children. While I do not have a report from the Security Committee yet, preliminarily, we feel we did a good job. There are always opportunities to improve. We also discovered a "dead" zone where the alarm cannot be heard. Yes, our MPP Laura Smith was in the building, but that was not a reason to postpone the drill. We postponed the drill four weeks ago because it was pouring outside, so further delaying it was not an option. By the way, I was not involved with this drill and did not even know it was happening. The drill is coordinated between the Security and Safety Committees and the office.

A member mentioned that we should carry out the drill in the summer when the kids are away and the shul is less disrupted. We need the kids in the building to see how our staff get our children out of the building safely and in a timely manner. That's the whole point. We also need the members to pay very close attention. Think about a Shabbat that has visitors in the building for a simcha or we are hosting Chai Lifeline or Yachad. Then, we would have many other people not familiar with our building and we have to assist getting them out quickly and efficiently. So it's not just about you, but the people around you.

Another member remarked that drill preparations will no doubt save at least one life, so don't stop practicing. Many angles, many opinions. Stop complaining. Thank Hashem it was a drill and not the real thing.

Professor Chaim Sukenik is the President of the Jerusalem College of Technology. Professor Sukenik established the Center for Nanotechnology and Advanced Materials and held the Edward and Judy Steinberg Chair in Nanotechnology at Bar Ilan University, where he chaired the Chemistry Department and was Dean of Exact Sciences. He was cited by the Israeli Government in 2014 as one of the most influential olim of the preceding 25 years. He has published over 130 peer-reviewed papers and 12 patent applications. Since his appointment as JCT's president, Prof. Sukenik has established himself as a vocal advocate for the central importance of Torah and academic excellence in the modern State of Israel. Under his stewardship, the Mada Toratecha Institute (a Torah and Technology think-tank) has been established.

Why do some people recite birkat hamazon with a cup of wine (or grape juice) on Shabbat?

The Talmud mentions a practice of concluding birkat hamazon with a berachah upon a cup of wine. This honours the mitzvah of birkat hamazon. There is debate as to whether this practice is obligatory, as well as whether it is meant for individuals or only for mezuza groups of three or more. The cup is known as a kos shel berachah ["cup of blessing"]

Contemporary authorities tend to rule that use of a kos shel berachah is an ideal way to honour birkat hamazon, but it is optional. Certain authorities specifically oppose use of a kos shel berachah by one who is reciting birkat hamazon alone, for mystical reasons.

Some people specifically use a kos shel berachah on Shabbat and Yom Tov. One reason is that we tend to have an appropriate beverage at the table on those days. Also, there is greater honour in performing this practice on a day when people are not rushed.

Why did the incense pans of Korach and his followers get turned into a copper coating for the Mizbeach? Weren't the pans part of the sin and therefore abominable? Why does Bnei Yisrael accuse Moshe and Aharon of killing Korach and his followers?

Rabbi Moshe Alshech (16th century Israel) explains that Bnei Yisrael got the mistaken impression that Korach and the 250 men who followed him were right. They saw that their arguments had validity and that Moshe could have responded otherwise to prevent their deaths.

G-d commands that the "Machtot HaChataim", "incense pans of the sinners" be made into a covering for the Mizbeach. Not only did they sin but they sinned to the extent that G-d determined they deserved death. The placement of the pans as a copper cover is to serve as a sign and a reminder for Bnei Yisrael that only Kohanim can offer Ketoret, incense, before G-d and so no one will be like Korach and his followers who demanded to be Kohanim. (Bamidbar 17:3,5) The pans have sanctity but that doesn't mean G-d approves of its owners' actions.

In an age of narratives, people often mistake elements of truth or reasonable plausibility with being factually correct. In the time of Korach, G-d made sure to punish them publicly for their sins so that the rest of Bnei Yisrael can learn not to emulate their divisive behavior. Clever cover arguments can coat an already holy copper altar, but cannot alter reality or create holiness.


