I encourage anyone who has thought of starting Mishnah Yomi (or Daf Yomi) but for whatever reason didn't, to start now. It's always a great time to start learning. There are many shiurim available online with various degrees of depth and duration to suit your capability and schedule. My favourite app is AllMishnah by OU. The app is easy to use and includes the Mishnah with Hebrew and English translation. If you do begin, contact Dr. Lazer Friedman who has a WhatsApp group and join the chevra.

There are some wonderful opportunities in our community for chizuk and I encourage you to participate. It is critical that you participate for your own well-being. The stress is immense at times, but always remember that we have each other to lean on. We as a community must come together and build our strength to go forward. We are the support for the Jewish people in Israel and we cannot lose focus on assisting our mishpacha. Friday night, we are hosting an Oneg Shabbat in the Simcha Suite for anyone who has family in Israel, especially those with children who are serving, studying, or living in Israel, and those who have children whose studies were cut short by the War, sponsored by the Dishys and the Guttmanns.

Tehillim continues to be said between mincha/maariv daily and three additional perakim are recited after maariv. I urge you to attend.

On November 4, a congregational kiddush will be held in memory of our founder of the BAYT, Joe Tanenbaum z"l. I greatly appreciated him coming to spend Shabbat with us and most importantly, he brought his family. Rabbi Mann provided a Shabbat full of chizuk. The Friday night Oneg Shabbat graciously hosted by David and Naomi Elmaleh with Rabbi Mann (and Rabbi Korobkin, Rabbi Leshner, Rabbi Stein) was packed and filled with amazing divrei Torah and ruach. It was one of many events over Shabbat which helped recharge me to take on the week. We look forward to welcoming other Rabbis from the BMZD in the near future.

A beautiful video was sent to the BAYT by three soldiers who received one of the duffle bags Roberta Newman and many others arranged to send to Israel in a moments notice. In the video they express their appreciation for the medical supplies and hoped that they will not be needed. Yashar Koach to all who participated in this important mitzvah.

The first two parshiot are so rich with content, all leading up to Avraham Aveinu. The purpose and the existence of the Jewish people are captured by Avraham's first test (three in one) in Lech Lecha. Some call it blind faith, but it's not. While Hashem is not visible to us, we feel him everywhere. You just have to search. We have been davening and doing many acts of chesed and giving tzedakah, Hashem is answering our prayers. INTRODUCTION TO THE LAWS OF SHEMA

Laws of the Shema: Juxtaposing Redemption and Prayer

In both the morning and evening, we recite the Shema and its blessings just before the Shemoneh Esrei. This is done deliberately so that the blessing right after the Shema, that discusses the redemption from Egypt, can come right before the petitions in Shemoneh Esrei. The Talmud Yerushalmi compares discussing the redemption to approaching and knocking on G-d's door. It's a way of recalling and focusing on our millennia-old relationship with G-d before launching into requests for our needs.

We are much stricter about making this juxtaposition in the morning than the evening. This could be because the redemption from Egypt happened primarily in the morning, or because Maariv is fundamentally a voluntary prayer.

The more relaxed obligation in the evening manifests in several ways. Firstly, we include other prayers such as yir'u einenu and Kaddish between the blessings of the Shema and Shemoneh Esrei. Secondly, other obligations, such as praying together with the minyan, override the need to have this juxtaposition. To this end, Shulchan Aruch rules that if one arrives late to Maariv and finds the minyan about to start Shemoneh Esrei, one should recite Shemoneh Esrei together with the minyan and recite the Shema and its blessings afterwards. However, if one can attend a later minyan without great difficulty, it's praiseworthy to do so.

Why does Avraham react so harshly to the King of Sodom? What is so bad about saying "give me the souls, and take the wealth for yourself" (Breishit 14:20)?

Rabbi Mordechai Breuer in Pirkei Breishit points out that it is not just about this phrase; rather it is in contrast to Malkizedek the King of Shalem. Malkizedek praises G-d, and recognizes the miracle of G-d delivering Avraham's enemies into his hand. The king of Sodom is simply thinking of the value of having subjects and property.

Avraham did not go to war with the Four Kings for the sake of money or honor. Avraham risked his life to save his nephew who had been taken captive. He made sure to return everyone who had been captured, and their possessions as well.

The king of Sodom speaking up now, referencing spoils, means that his reputation and wealth are what he cares for, not his constituents.

The Mishnah in Pirkei Avot (5:10) says that the trait of Sodom is "mine is mine and yours is yours." We cannot be like Sodom, caring only for ourselves and ignoring others. Instead we must act like Avraham, and save our fellow brethren.

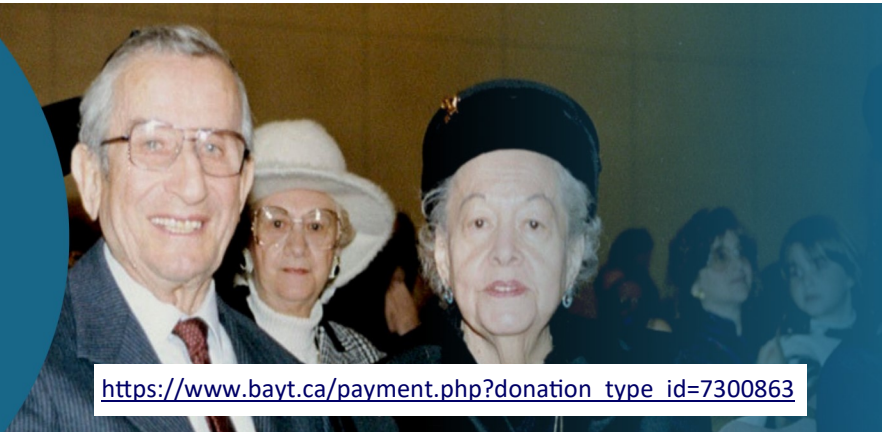

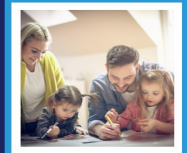

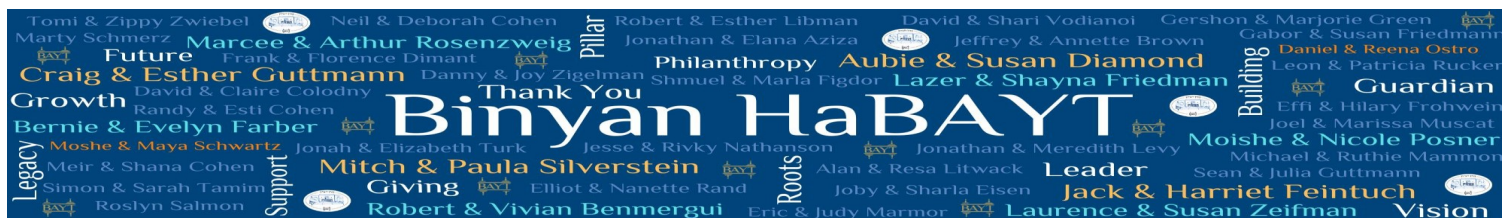
